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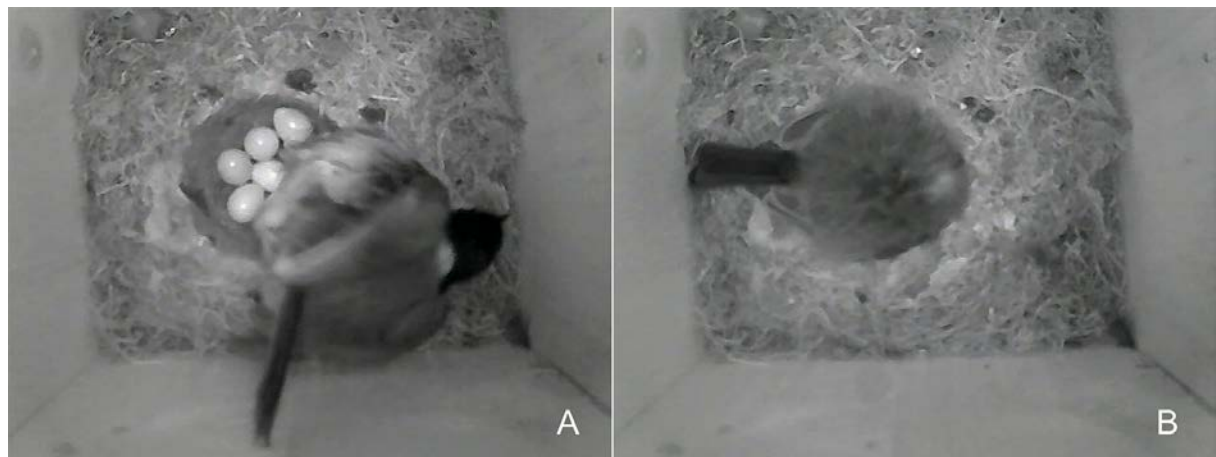


Figure S1 Female great tit (nest box 102) in (A) active and (B) inactive posture during night.
