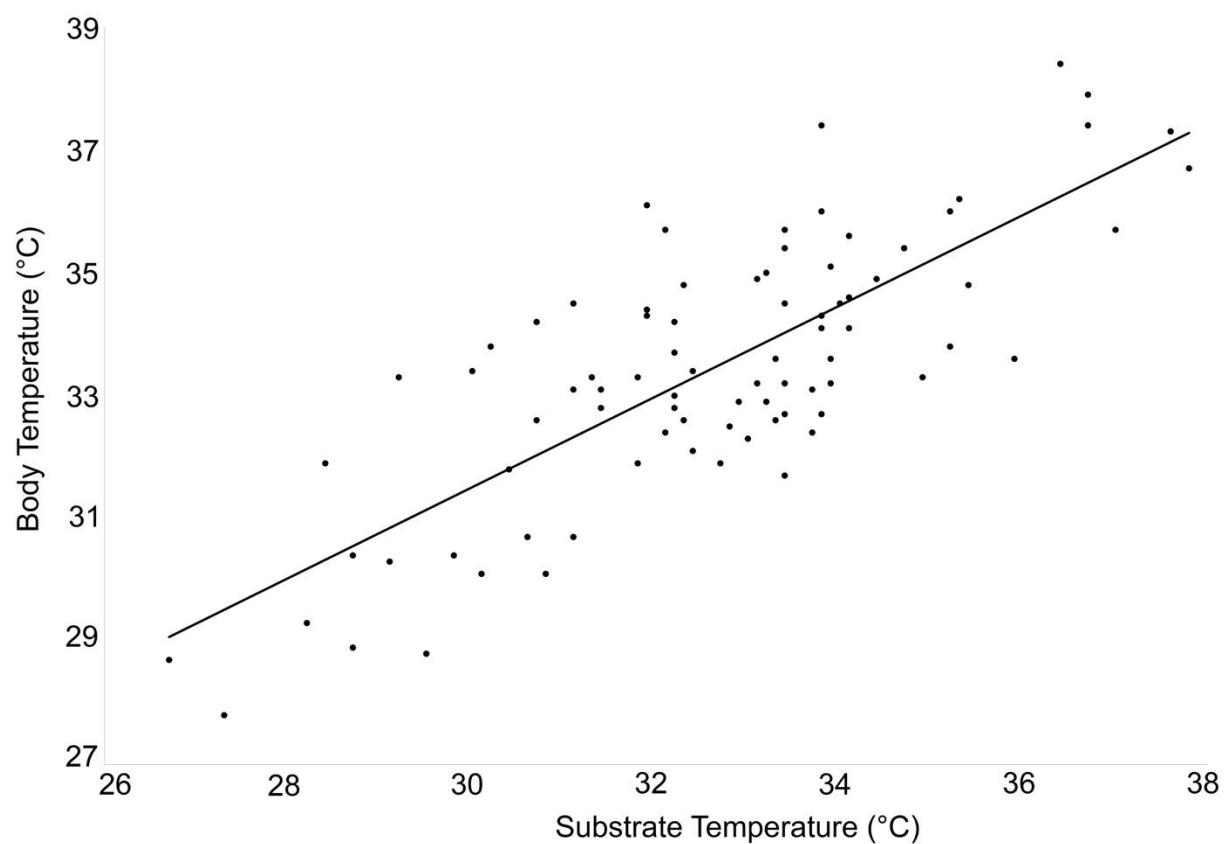


Sexual Dimorphism in Dynamic Body Color in the Green Anole Lizard

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Supplementary Figure 1. Body temperatures of adult green anole lizards are correlated with the surface temperature of substrates on which the lizards were perching.



Supplementary Figure 2. Green anole habitat exposure, defined by the average ($\pm$ SE) distance from the occupied perch to the nearest available perching location, is higher for males than females.
