Invitation was sent to same 33 farms than in the case of interviews, and to four farms from another [project] project which from two new farms participated (n=14).	Invitation to group discussion regarding research findings was sent to 8 farmers (timing was challenging for gathering a larger group due to the sowing season), who participated in all data collection and expressed their willingness to continue in research (n=8).
