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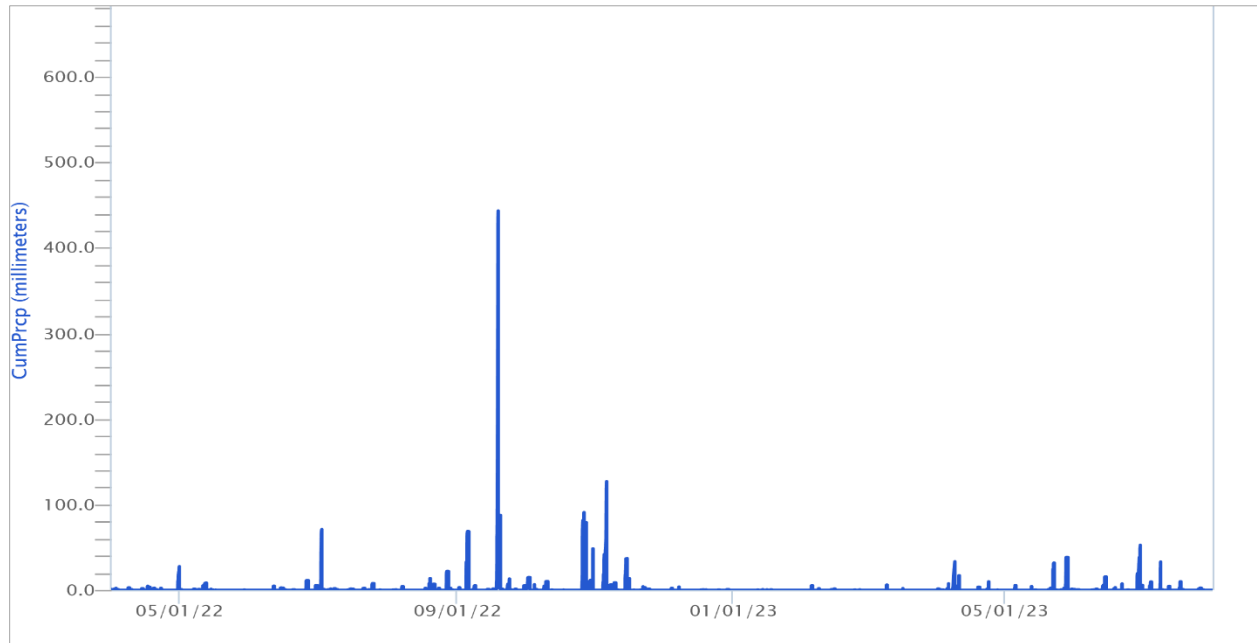


Fig. 1 Graph of cumulative precipitation (millimeters) in Jobos Bay during the study period (April 2022-July 2023).

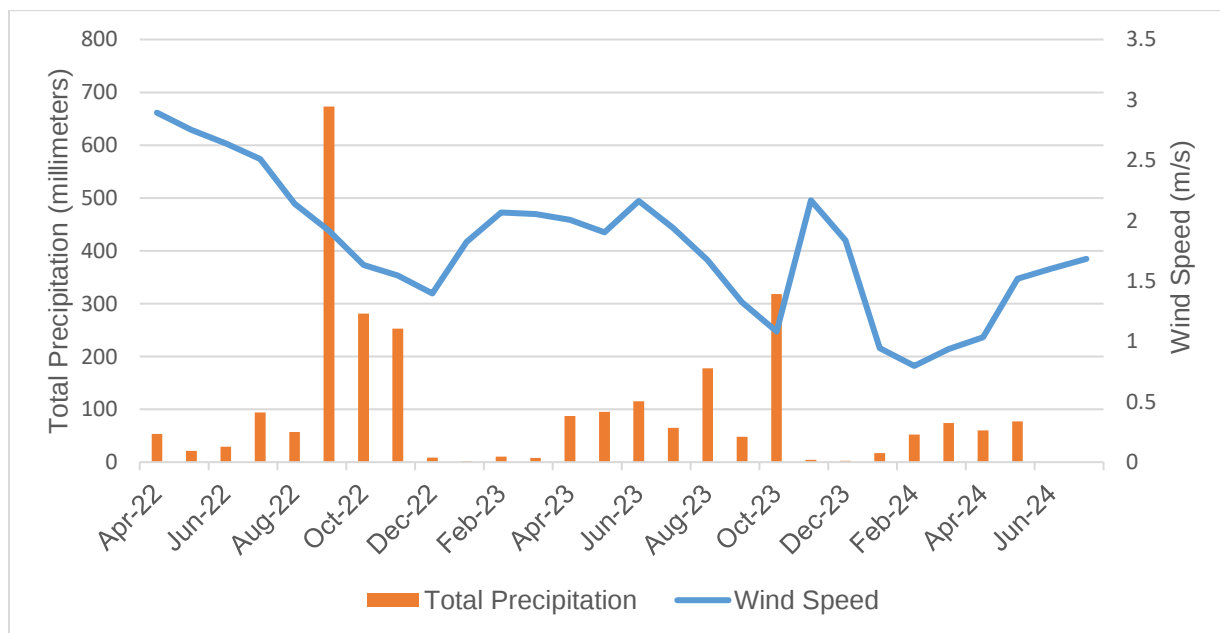


Fig. 2 Graph of monthly total precipitation (millimeters) and average wind speed (m/s) during the study period (April 2022-July 2023).

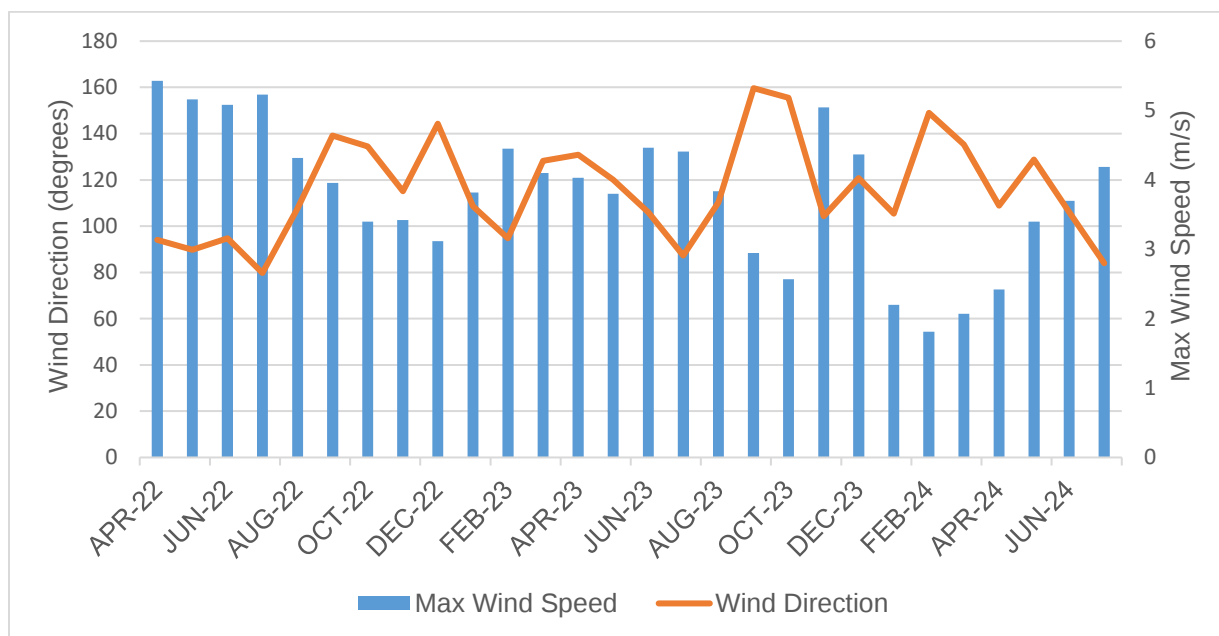


Fig. 3 Graph of average monthly maximum wind speed and average monthly wind direction during the study period (April 2022-July 2023).
