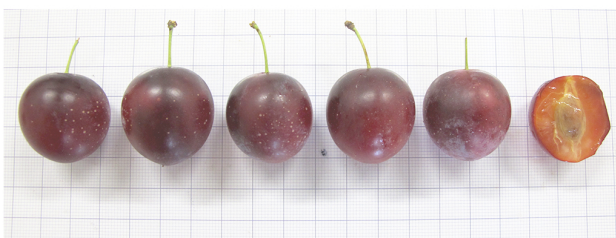
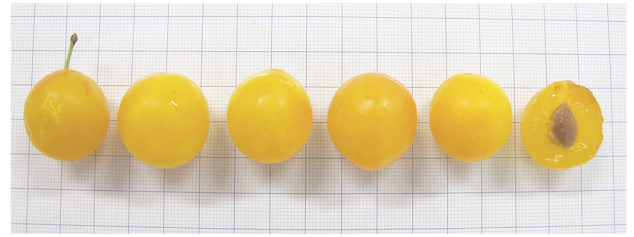
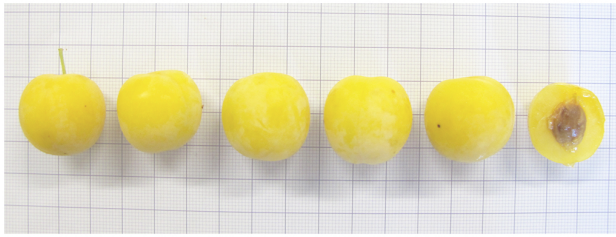


Figure S1a and S1b: Colorful fruits of several *Prunus cerasifera* Ehrh. accessions maintained in the SPGB collection.

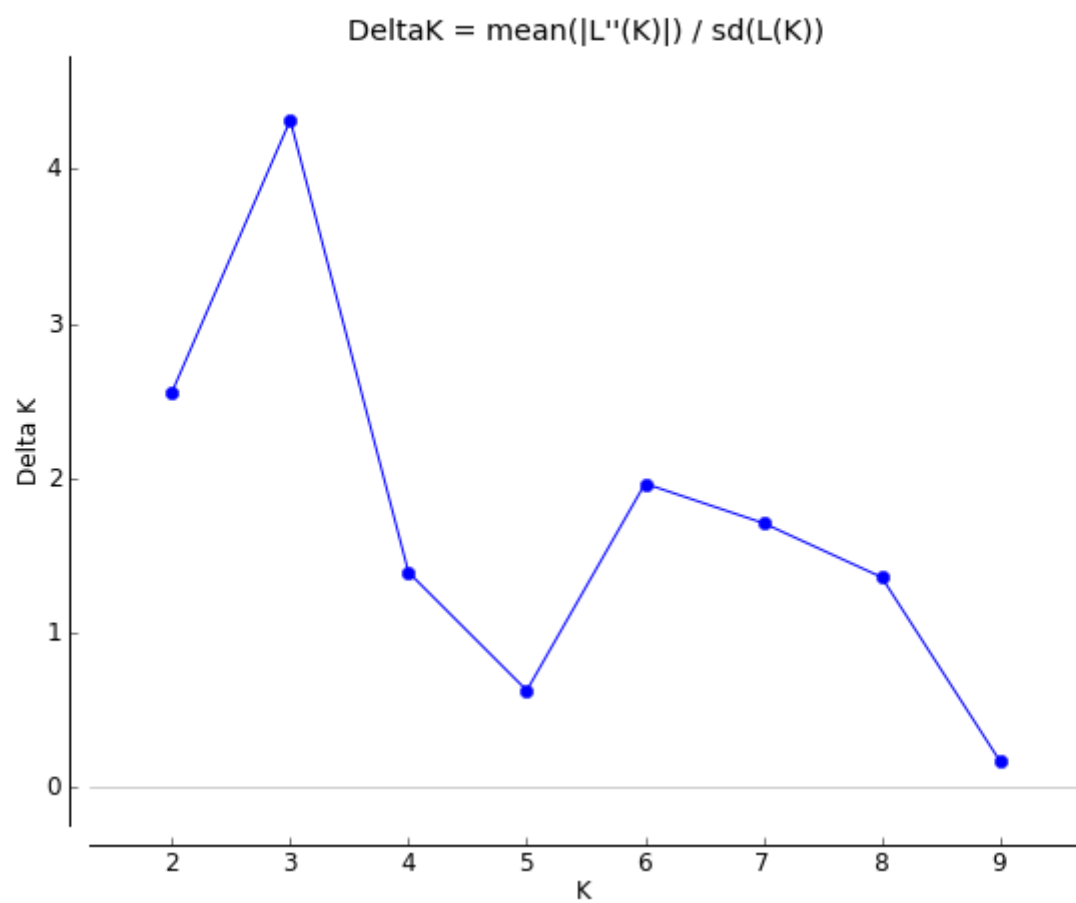


Figure S2: Graphical method, allowing the detection of the number of groups K using ΔK (Evanno et al, 2005).
