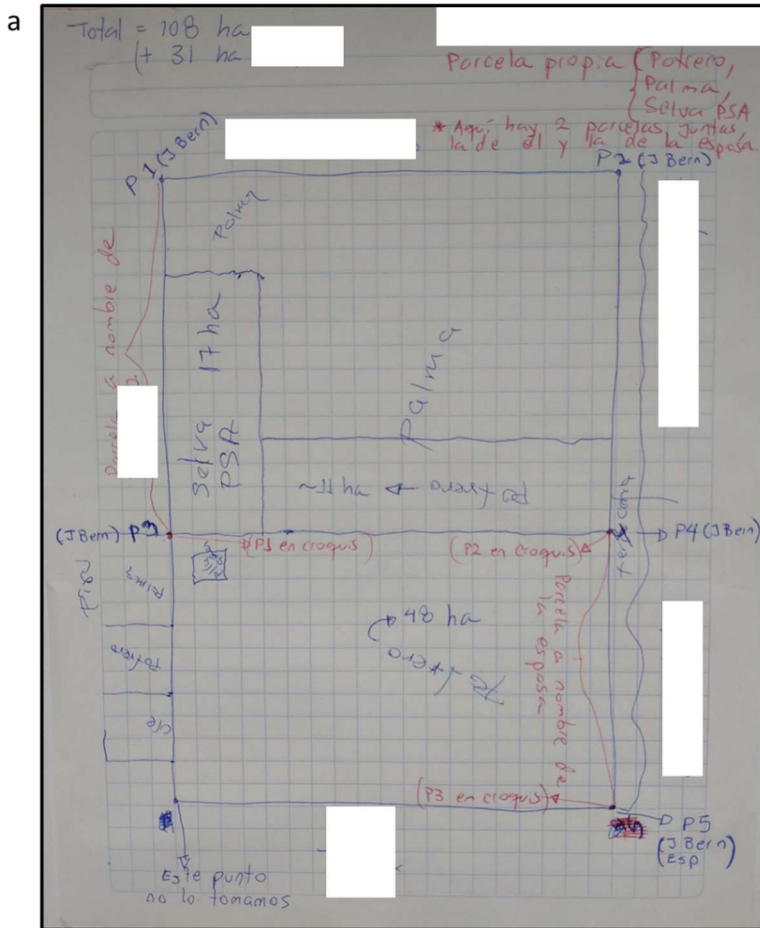


Smallholder Land-Use Decisions in a Tropical Agro-Forest Frontier in Southern Mexico

Farm sketches sample

As part of the data collection methods, the interviewees were asked to sketch a map of their farm, delimiting each plot and respective land-uses (fields) during the guided farm visits. We show two samples of these sketches done in the field, one for each studied community, Chajul and Loma, with Spanish handwritten notes by the interviewees and the first author. Landowners' names were removed for confidentiality.



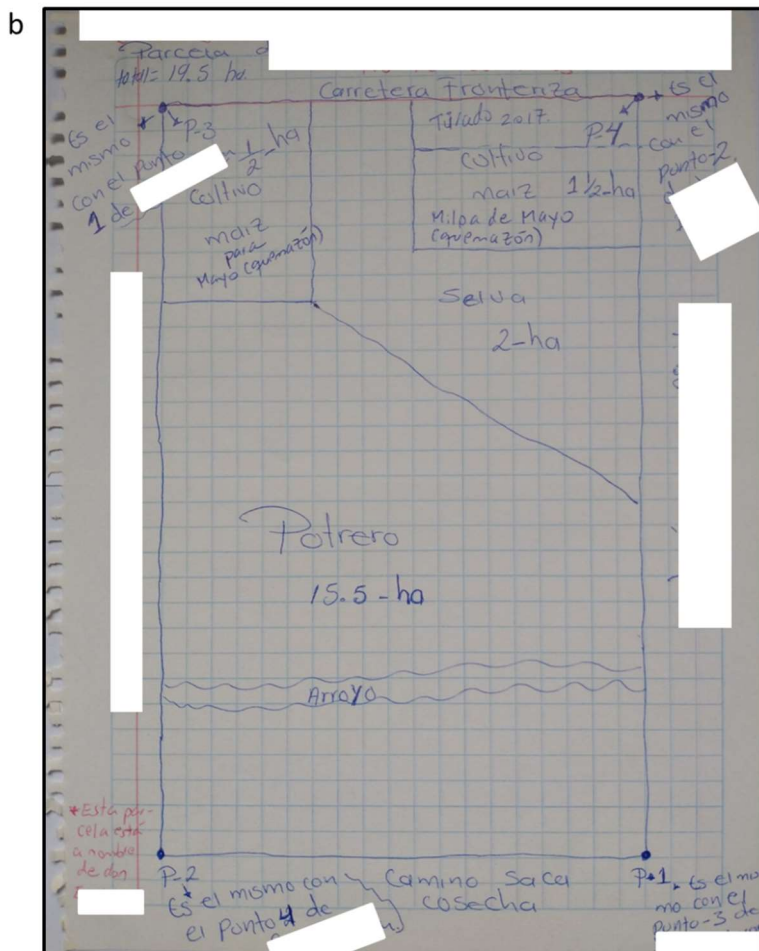


Fig. 1 Farm sketches done by interviewees in Chajul and Loma. a: Chajul farm plot (139 ha) with the following land-use fields: primary forest (*selva* in Spanish) under PES, oil palm (*palma*), pasture (*potrero*), and rubber (*hule*). b: Loma farm plot (19.5 ha) with the following land-use fields: agriculture (*cultivo*), primary forest, and pasture
