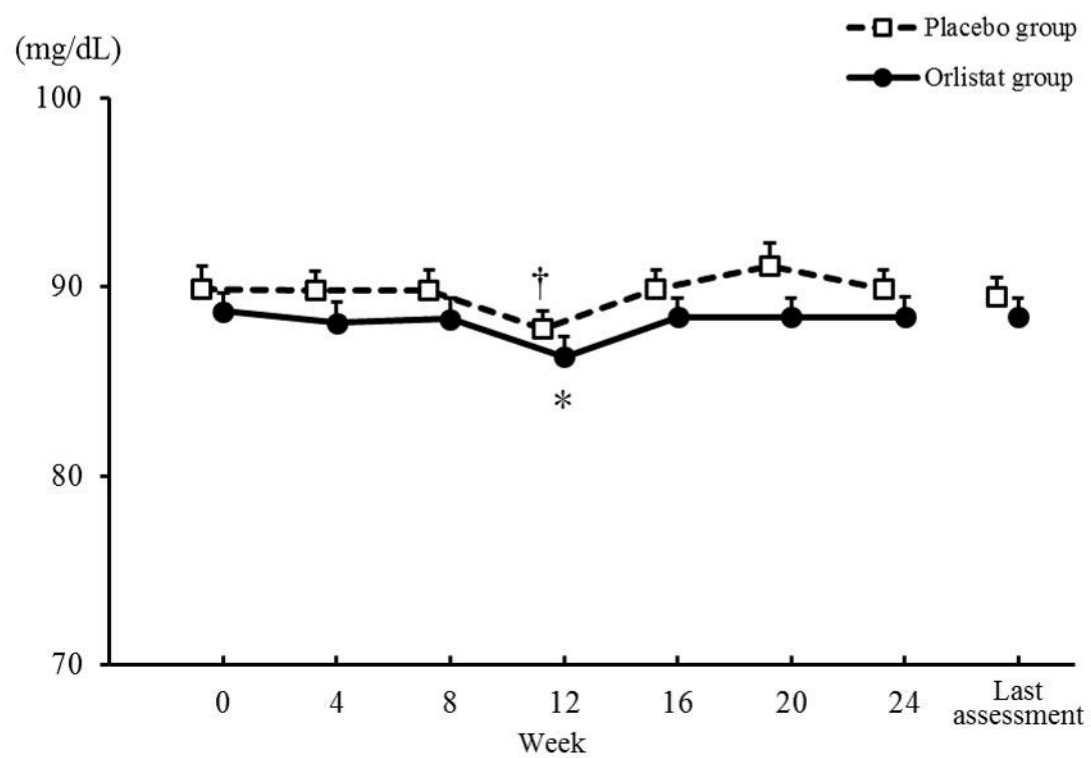
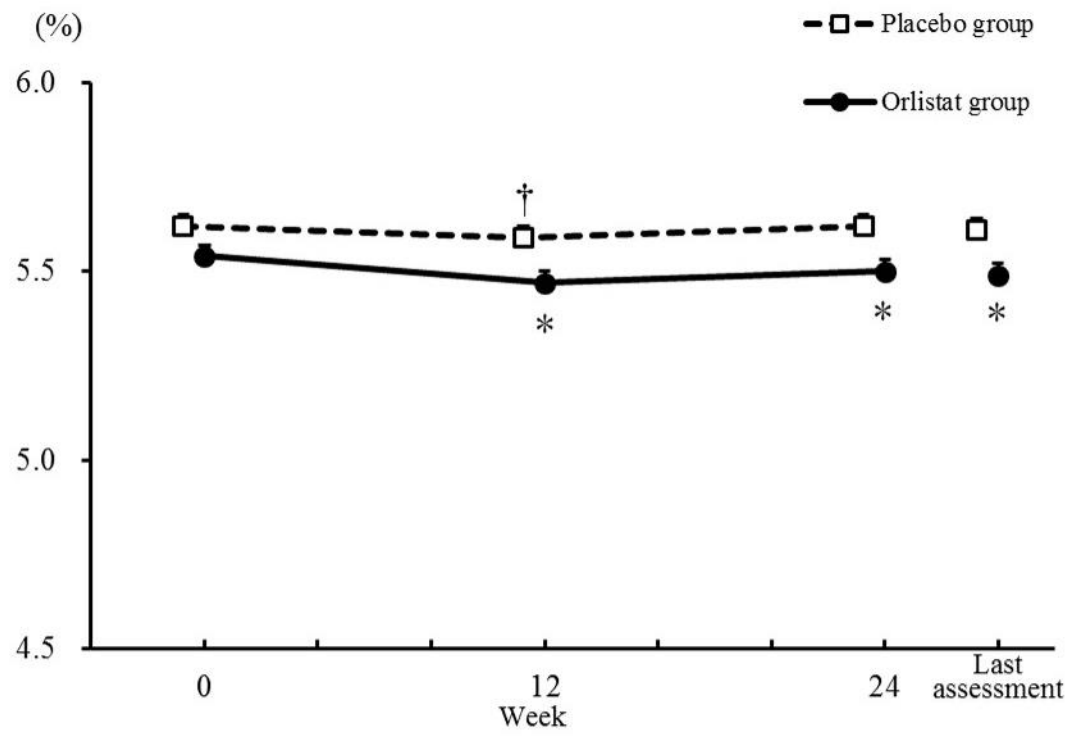

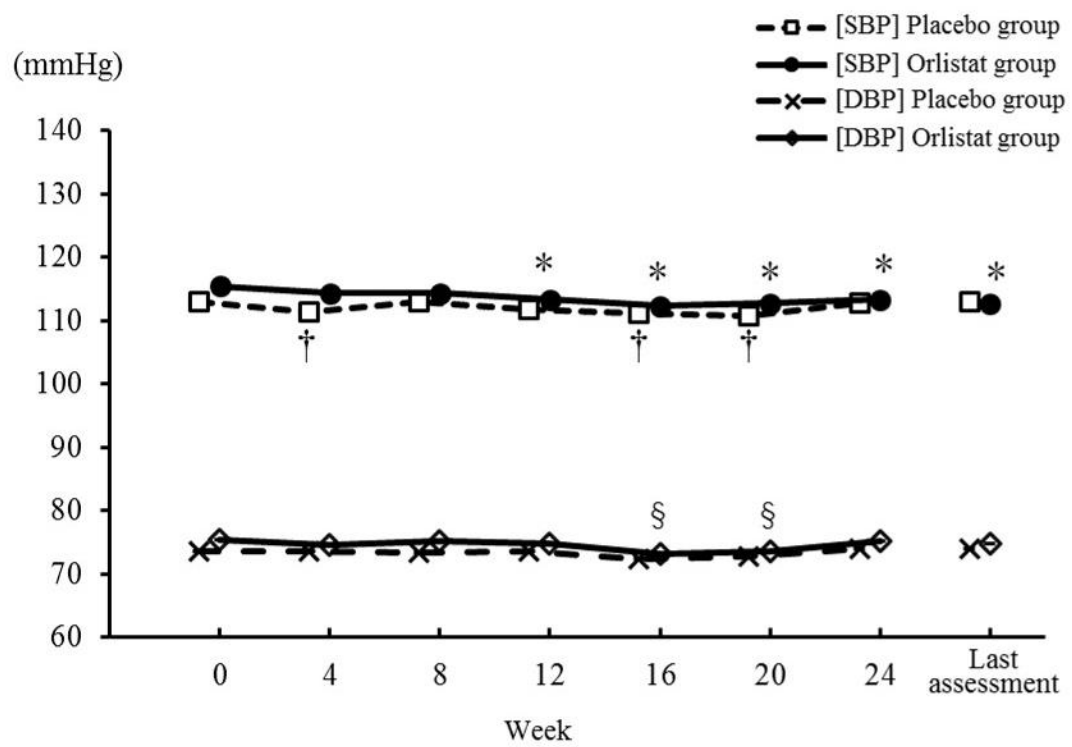
(a) Blood glucose



(b) HbA1c

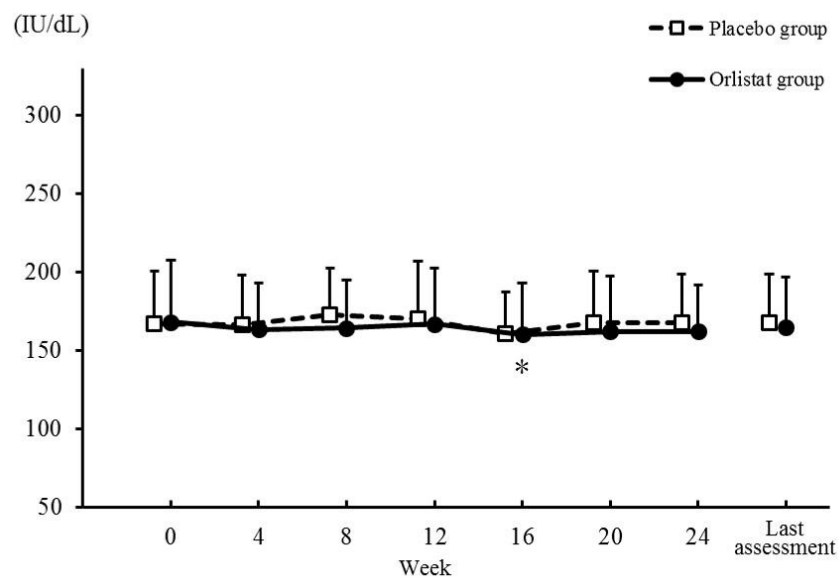


(c) Systolic blood pressure and diastolic blood pressure

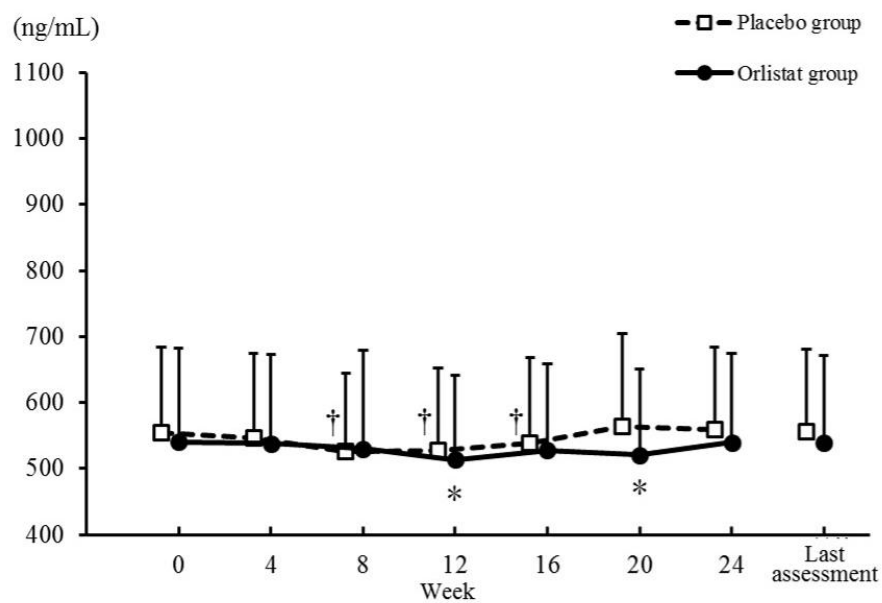


(d) Vitamin A (retinol).

(i) Study site with normal range: 431/1041 ng/mL (*n*: Orlistat, 80; Placebo, 80)

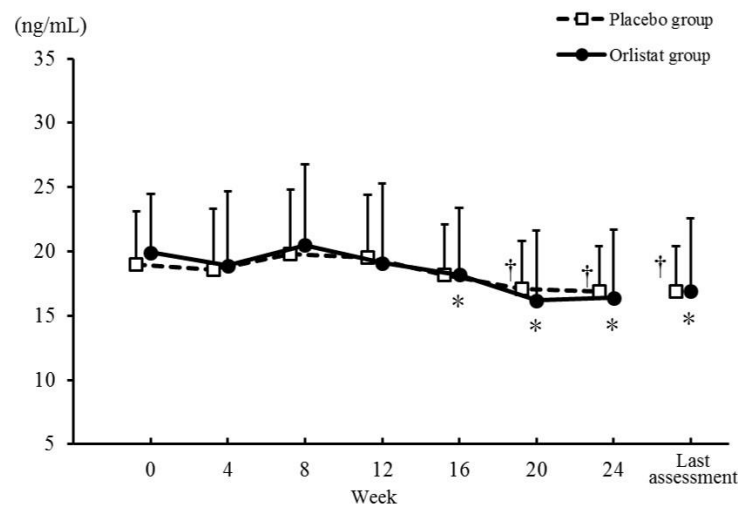


(ii) Study site with normal range: 97/316 IU/dL (*n*: Orlistat, 20; Placebo, 20)

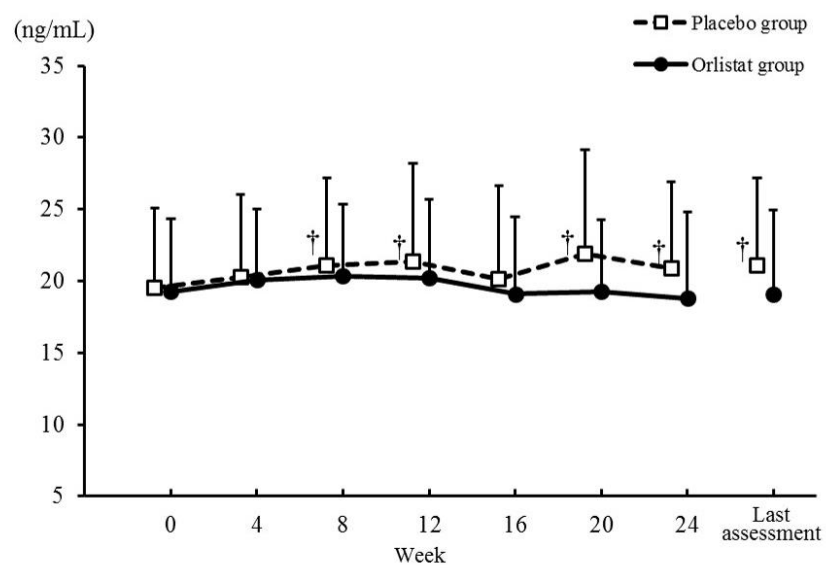


(e) Vitamin D (25-OH vitamin D)
