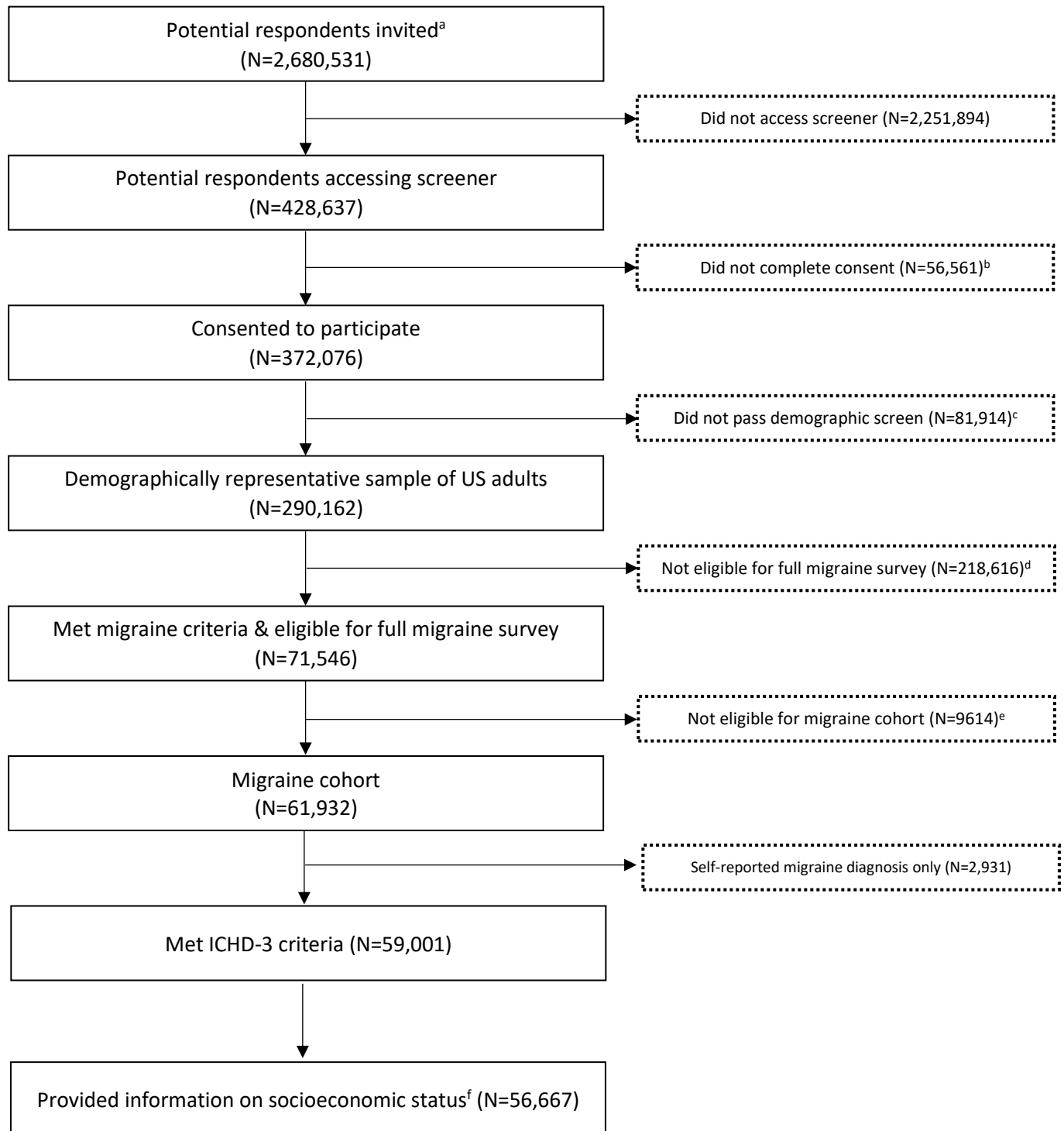
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Supplemental Figure 1: Consort diagram for OVERCOME (US) 2018-2020 (all cohorts)
