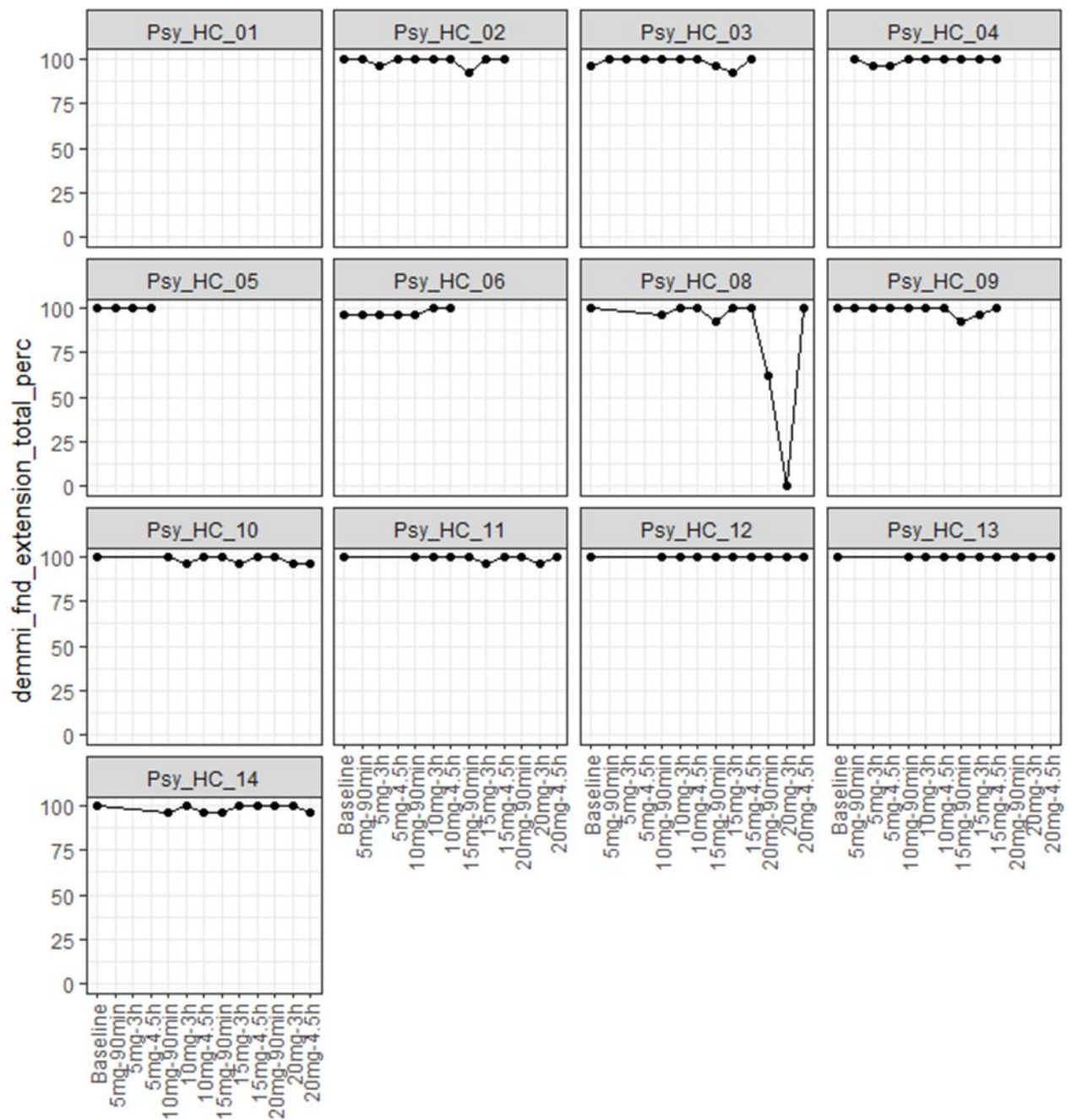


Figure S3.1: Individual profiles for demmi_fnd_extension_total_perc.

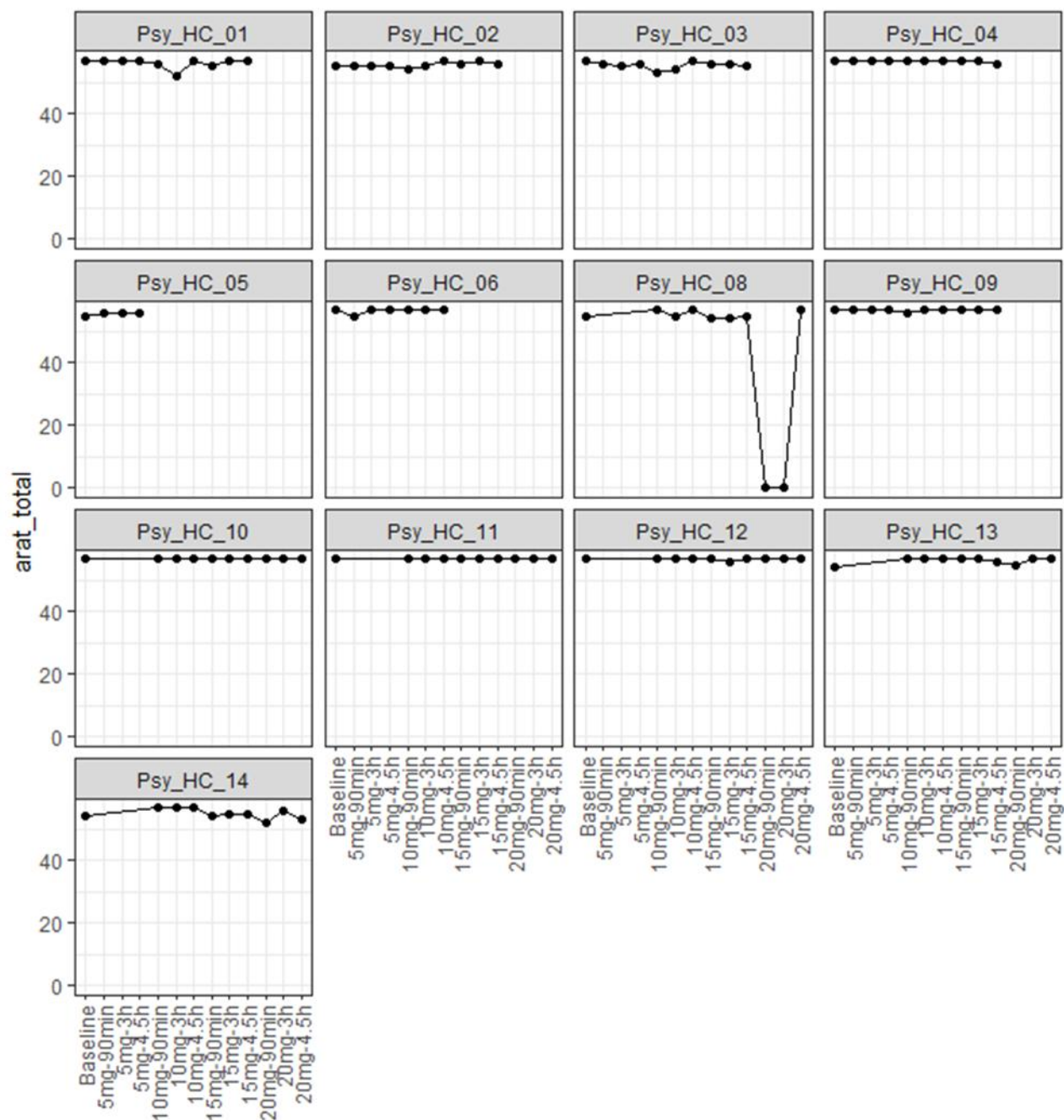
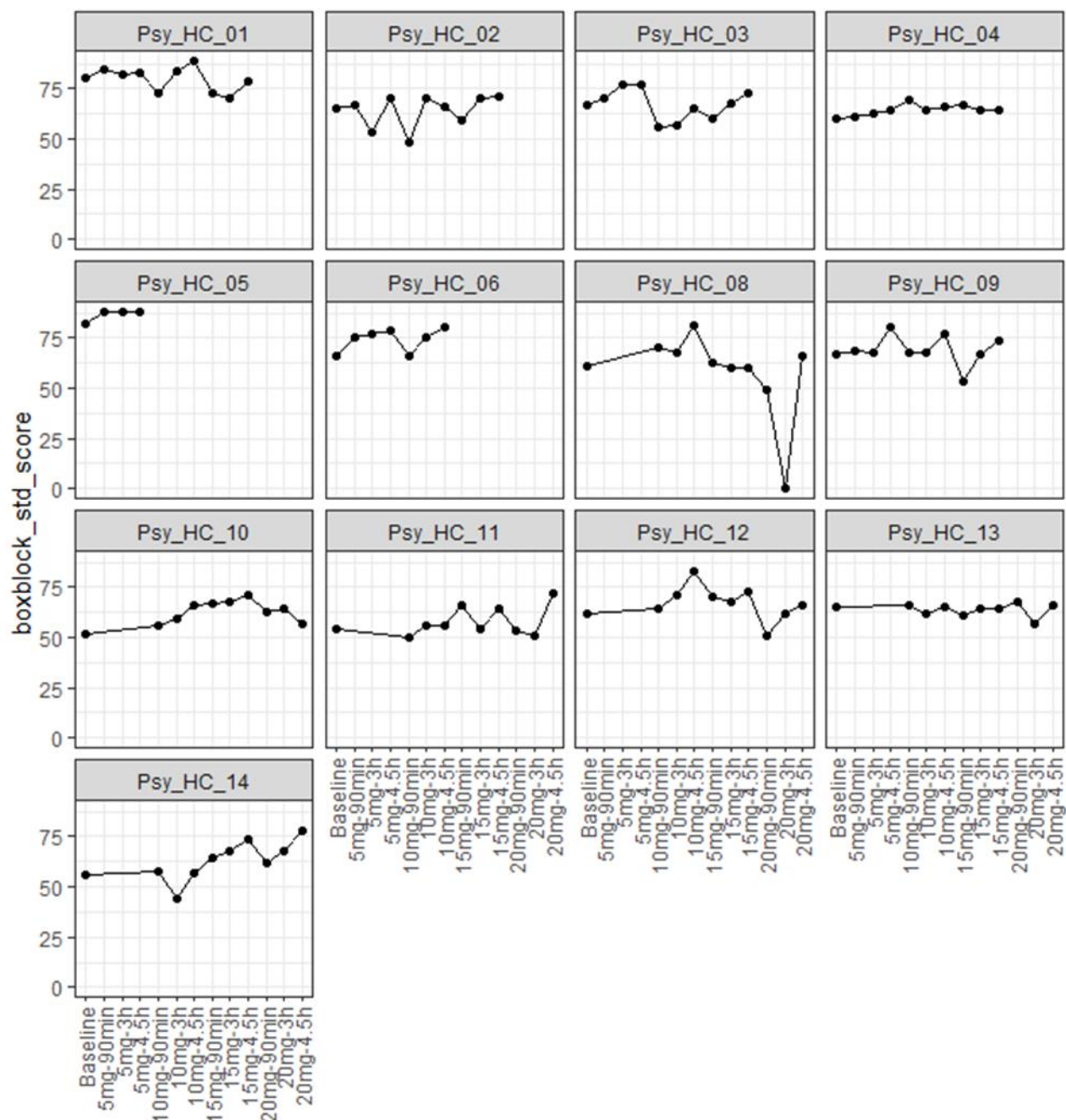


Figure S3.2: Individual profiles for *arat_total*.

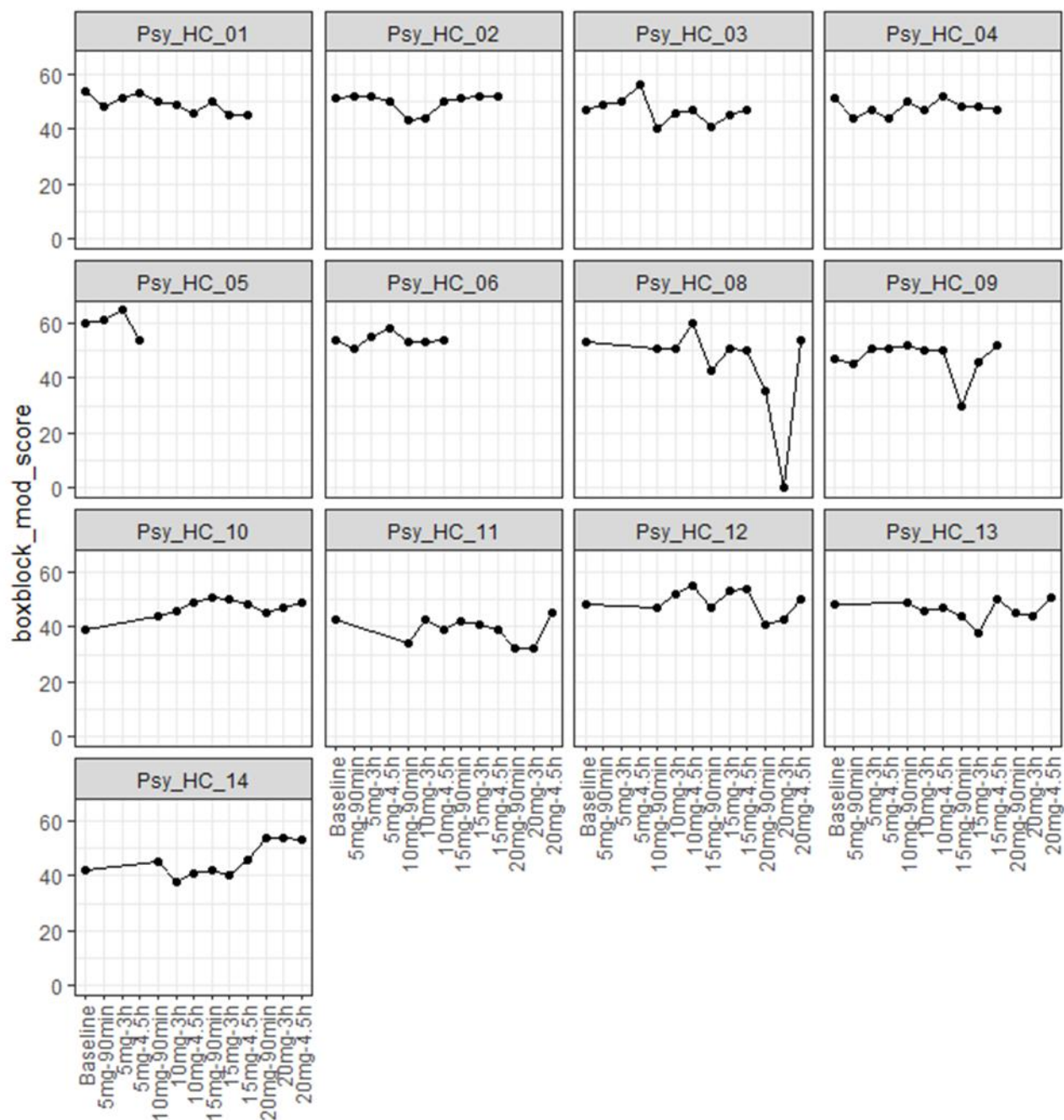


Figure S3.4: Individual profiles for boxblock_mod_score.

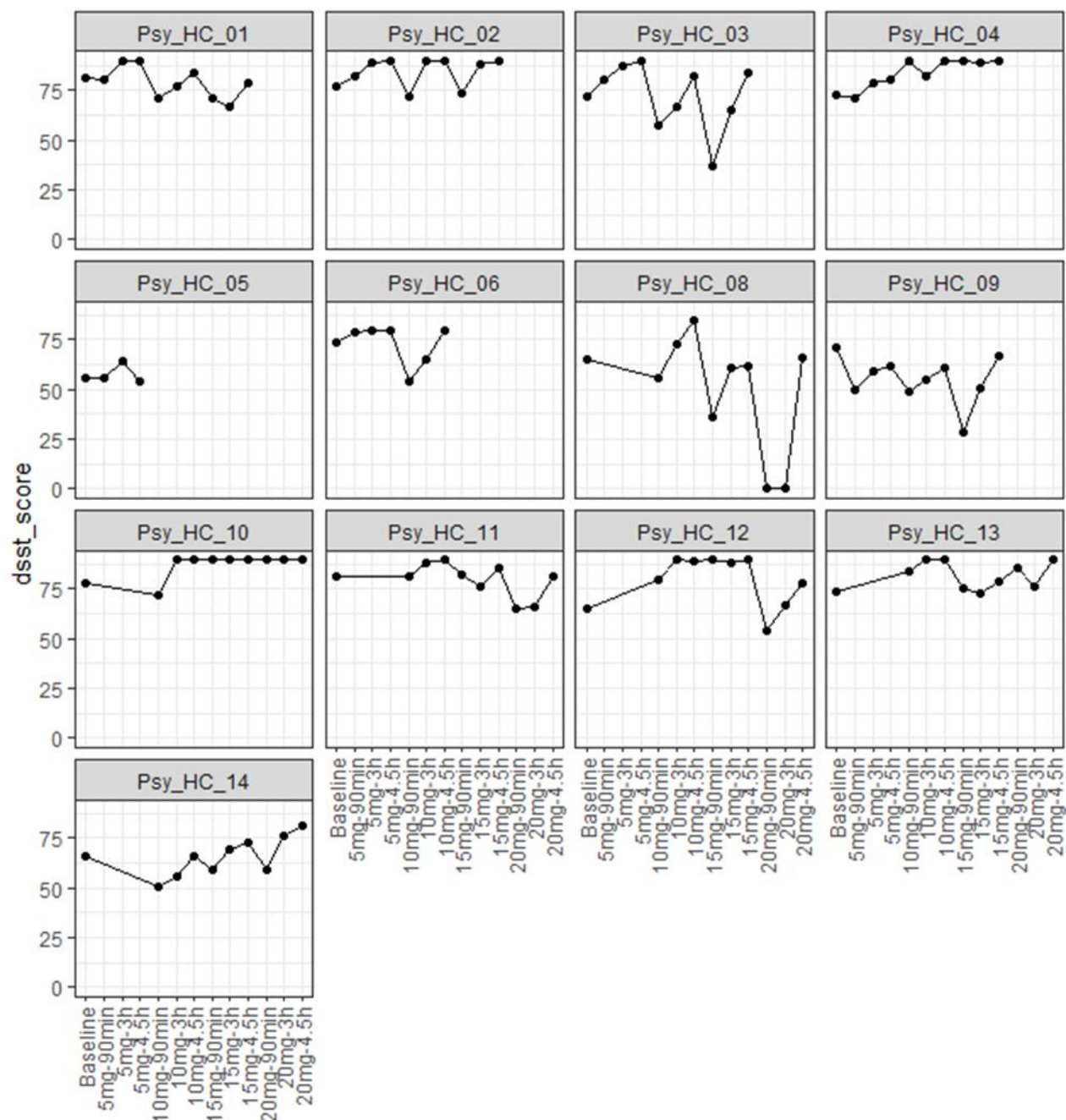


Figure S3.5: Individual profiles for dsst_score.

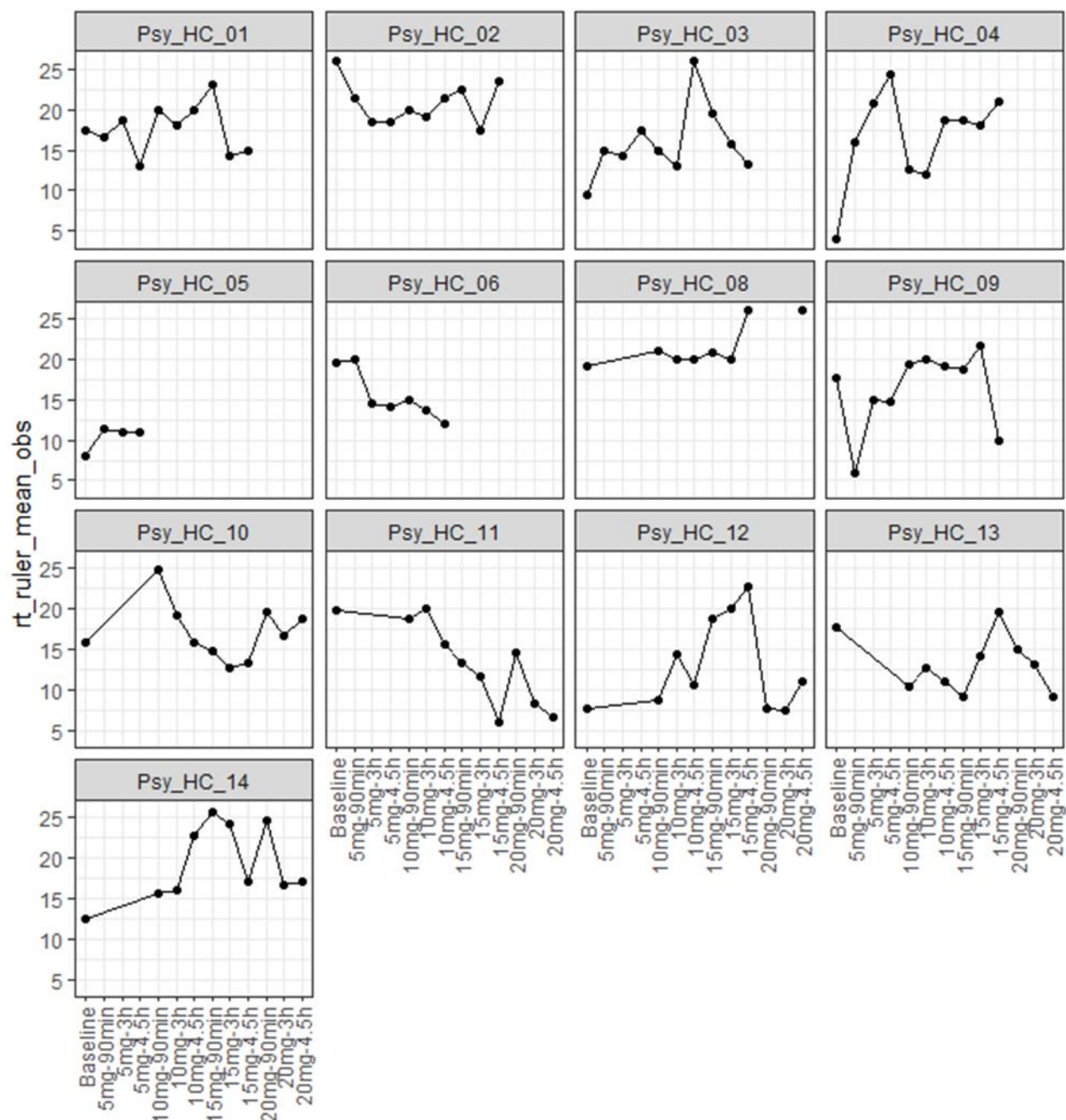


Figure S3.6: Individual profiles for *rt_ruler_mean*.

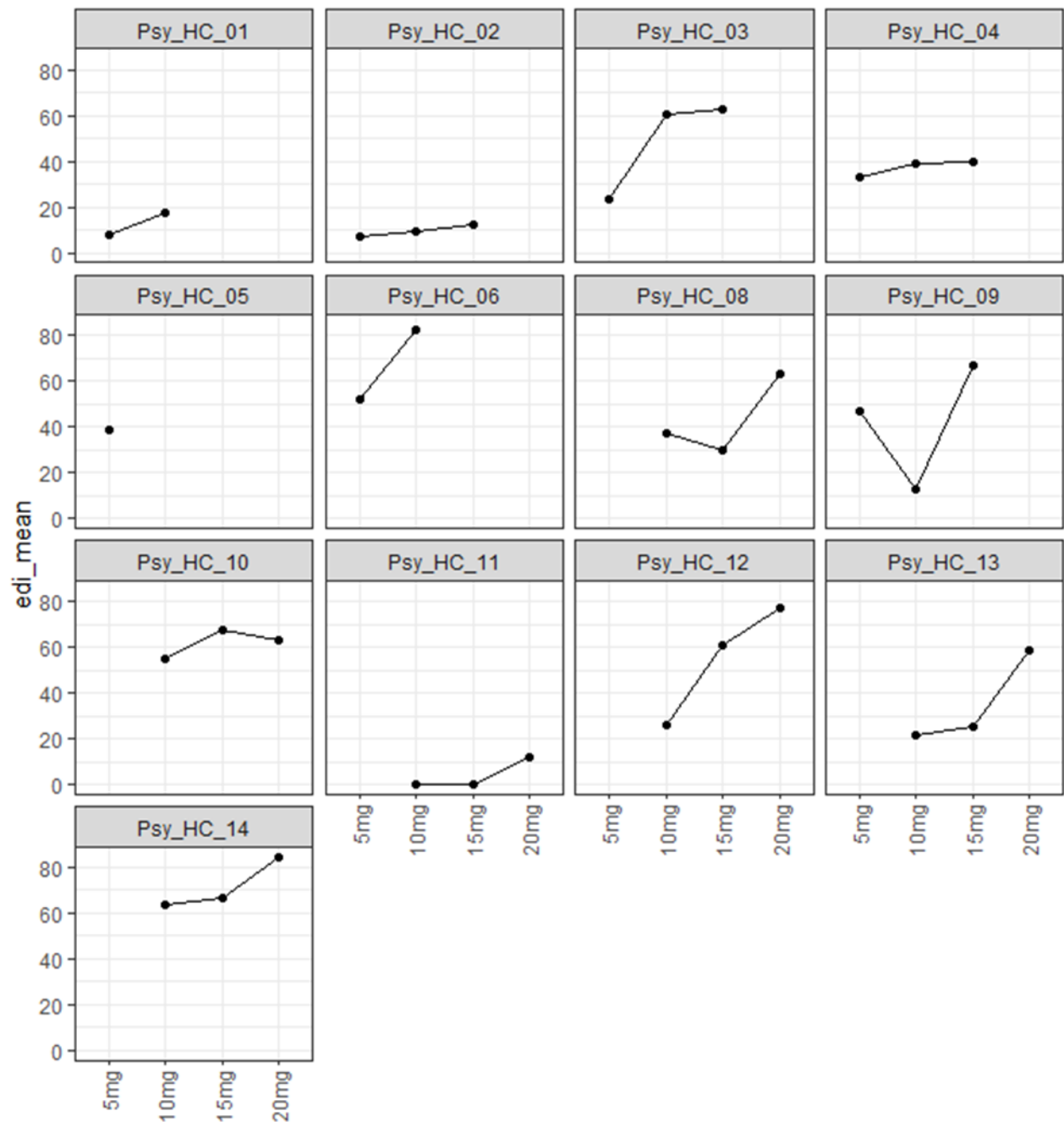


Figure S3.7: Individual profiles for edi_mean.

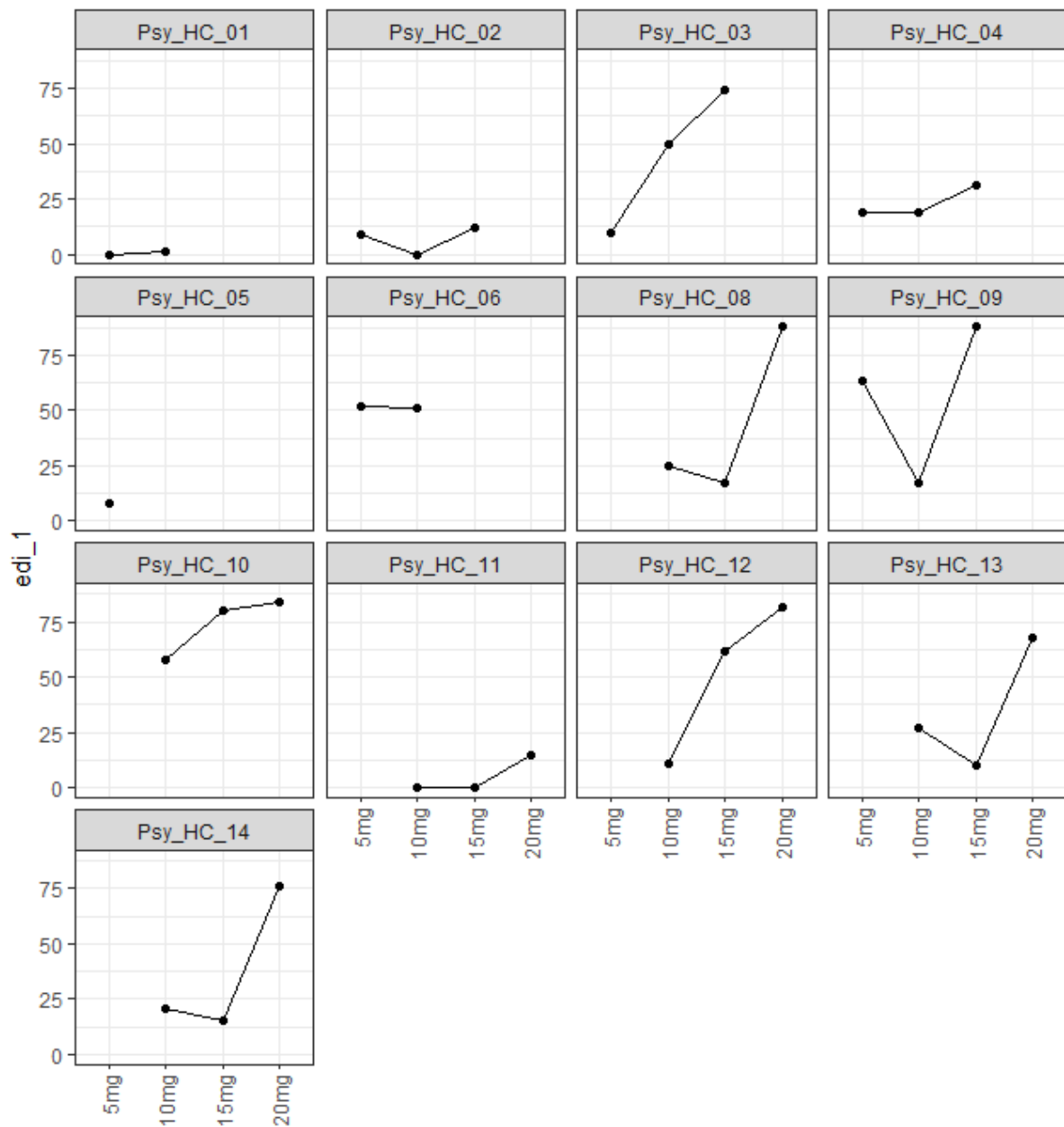


Figure S3.8: Individual profiles for *edi_1*.

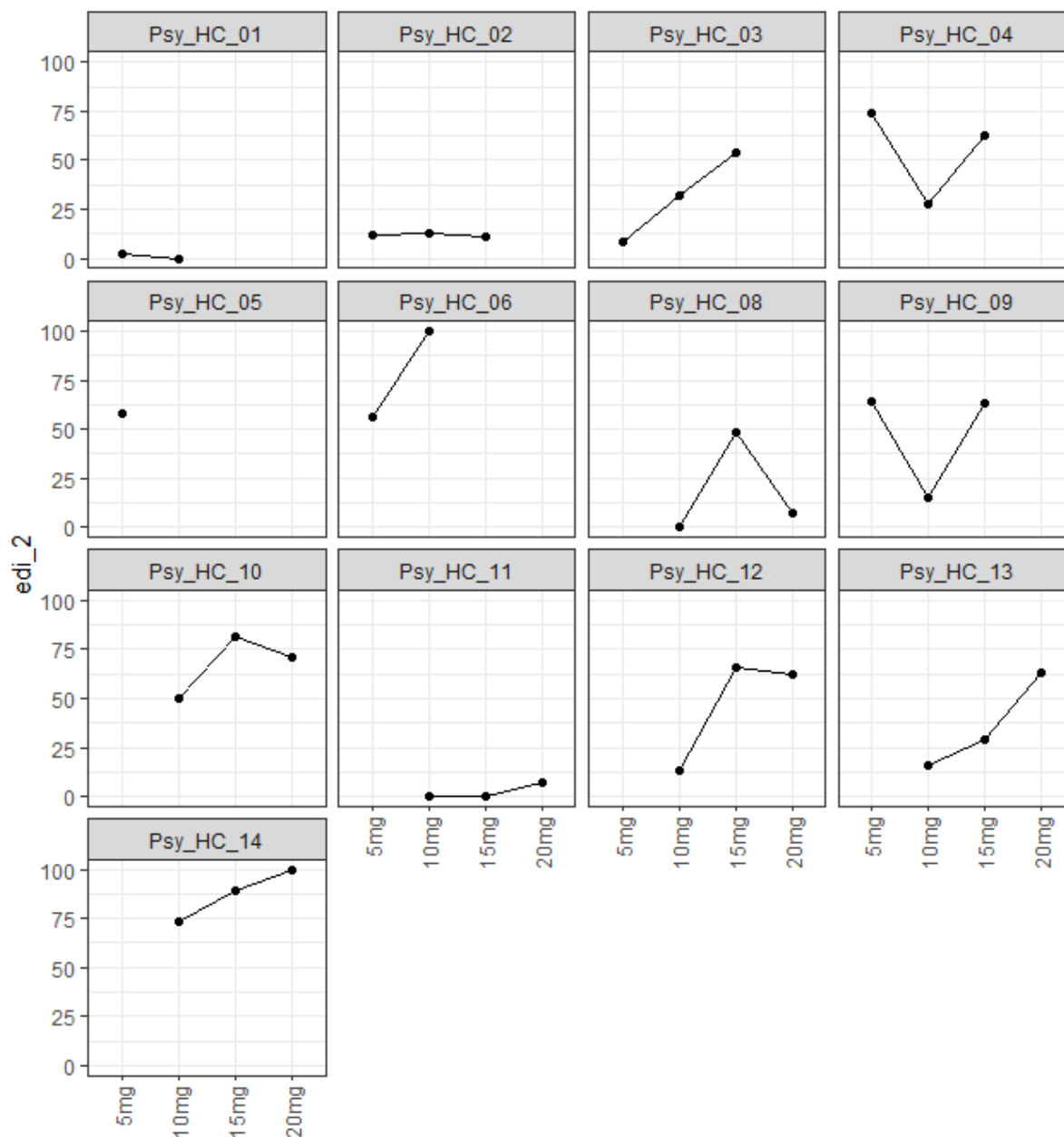


Figure S3.9: Individual profiles for *edi_2*.

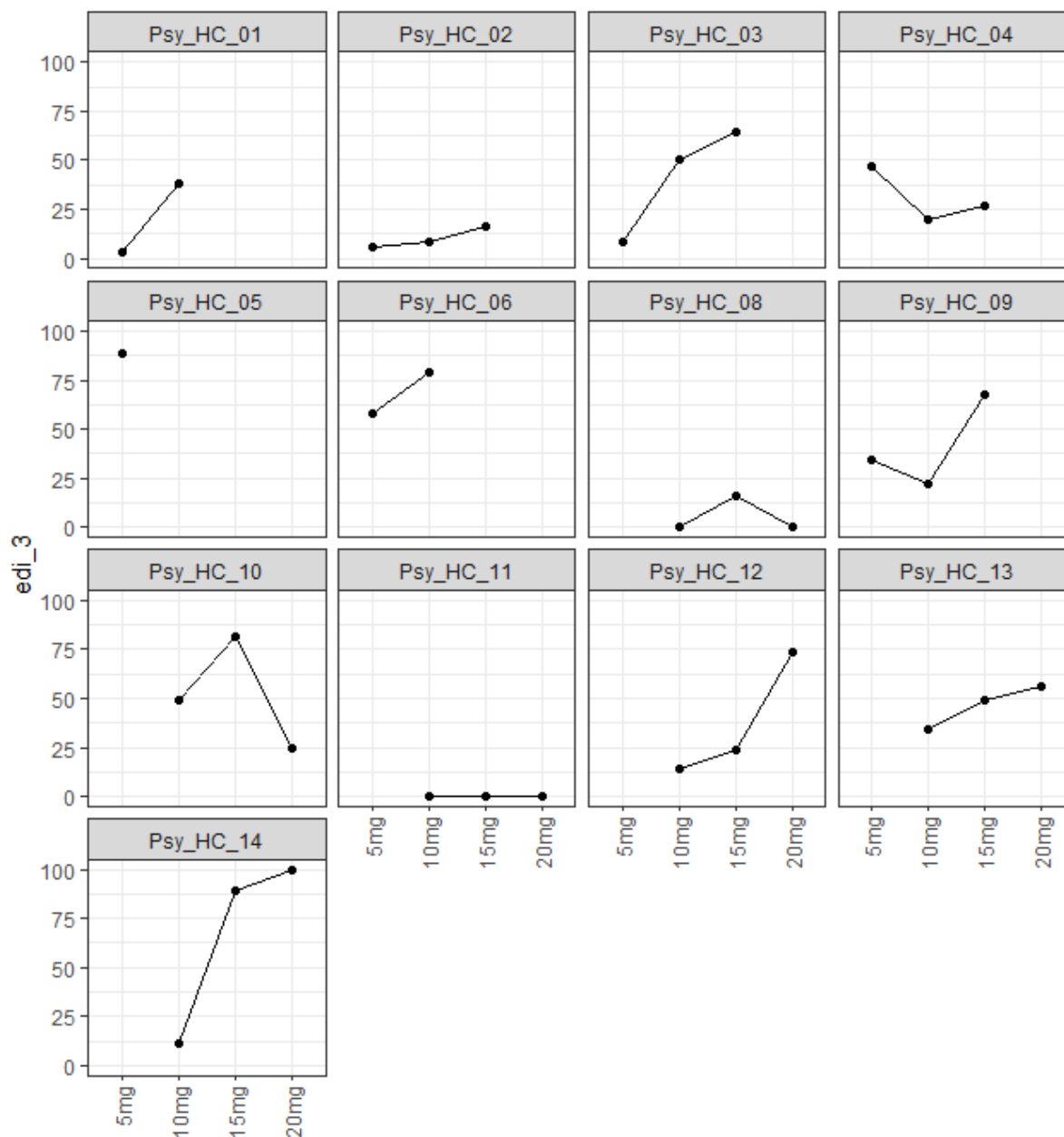


Figure S3.10: Individual profiles for edi_3.

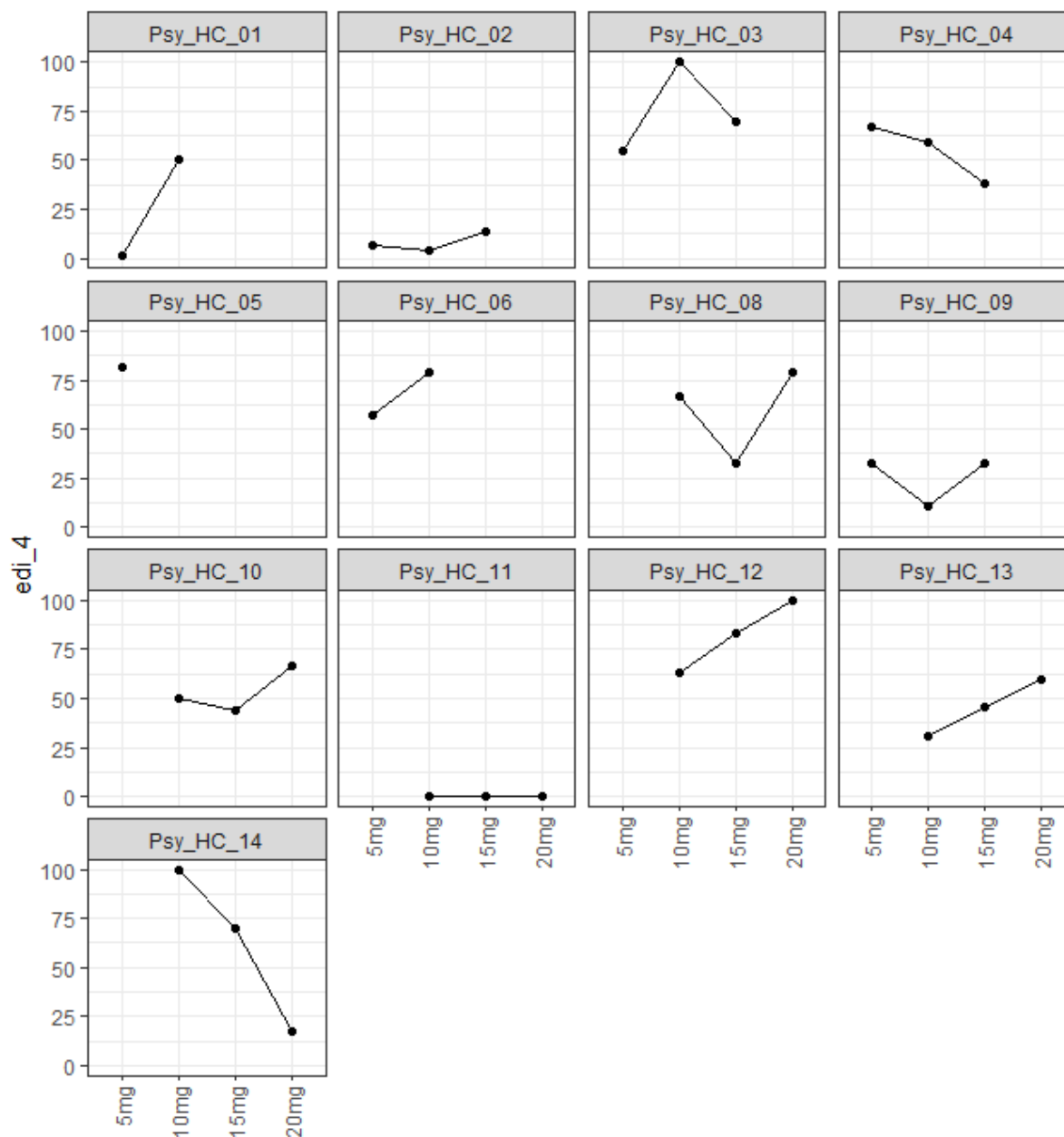


Figure S3.11: Individual profiles for *edi_4*.

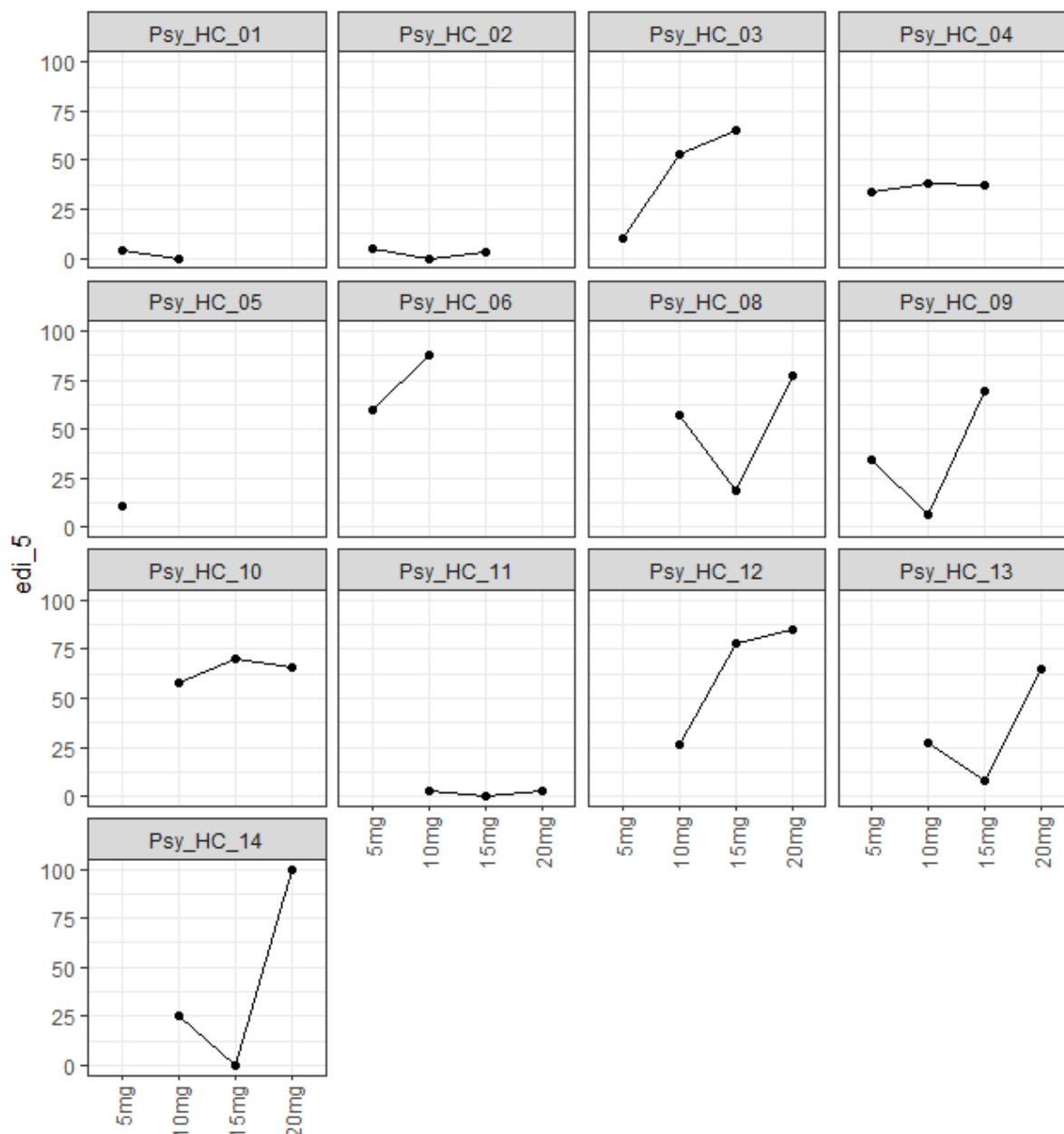


Figure S3.12: Individual profiles for *edi_5*.

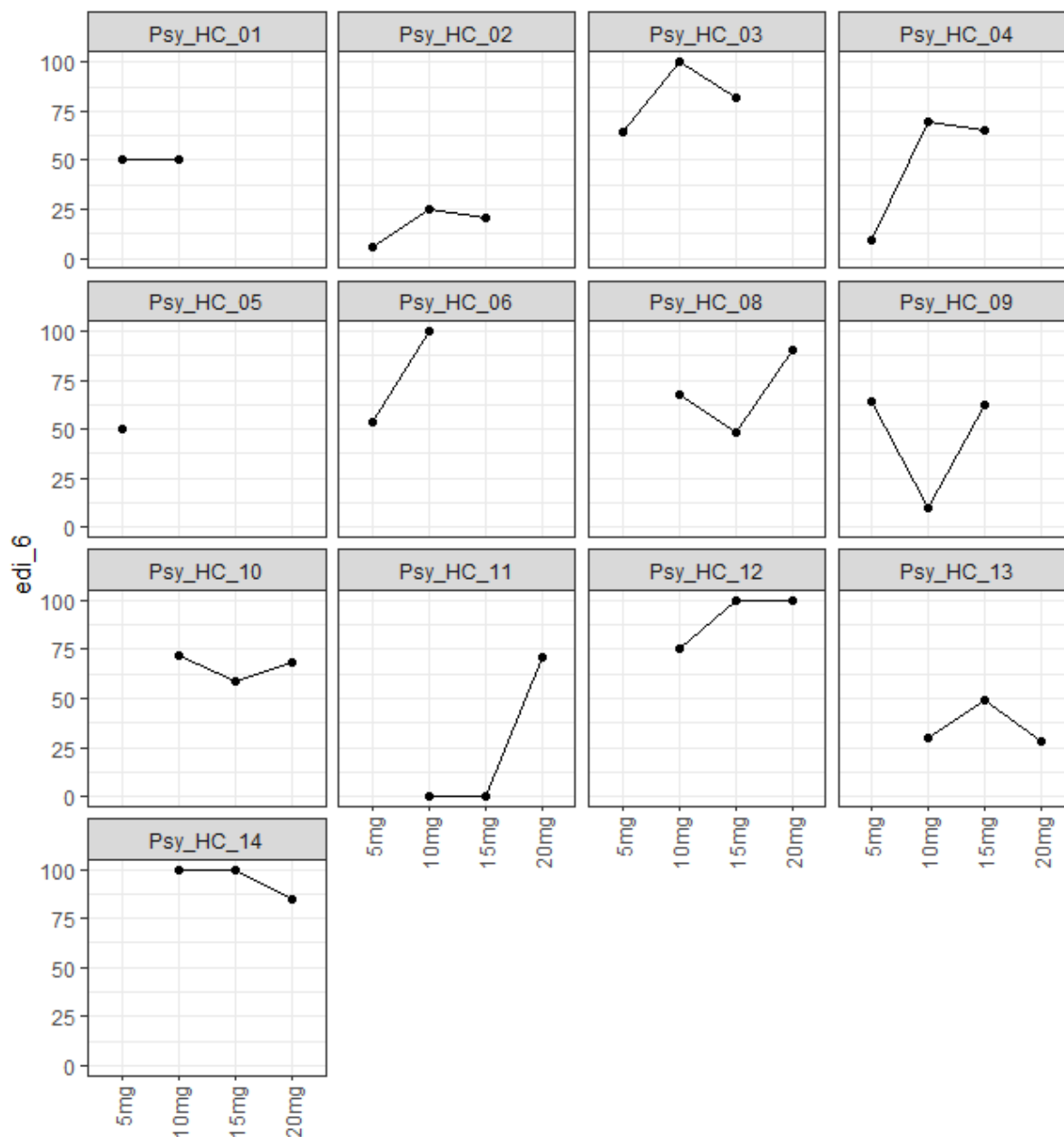


Figure S3.13: Individual profiles for *edi_6*.

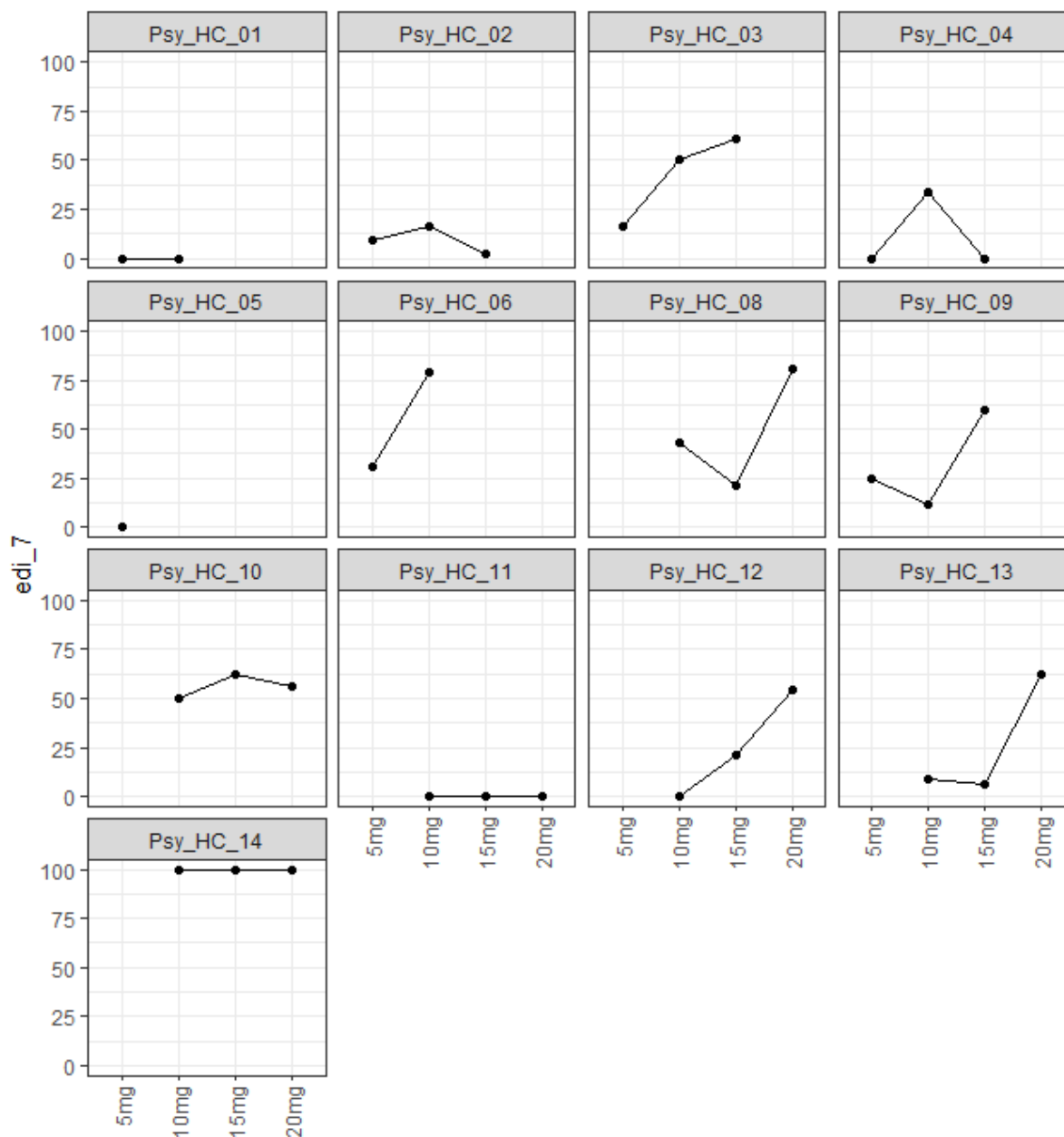


Figure S3.14: Individual profiles for *edi_7*.

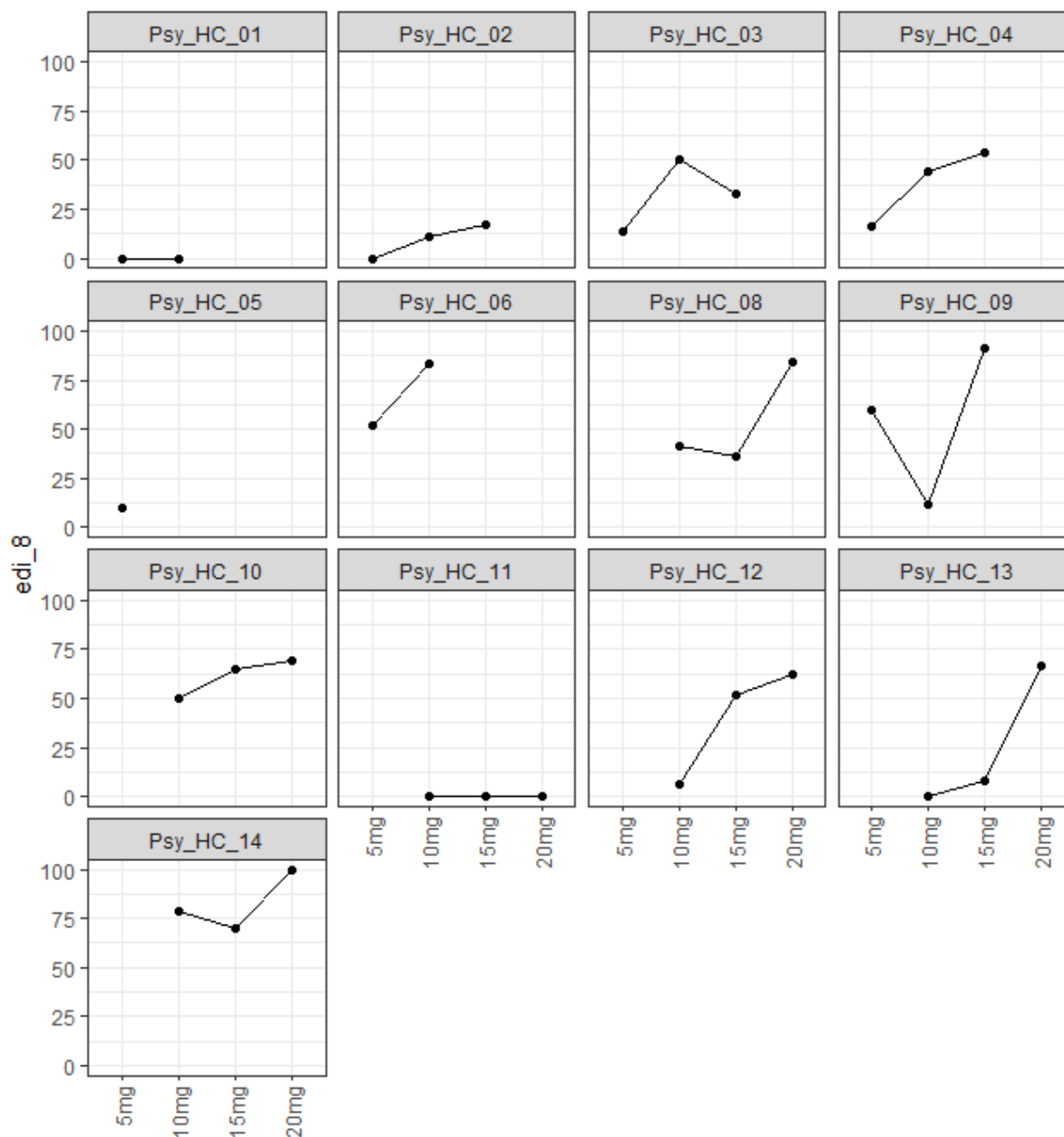


Figure S3.15: Individual profiles for *edi_8*.

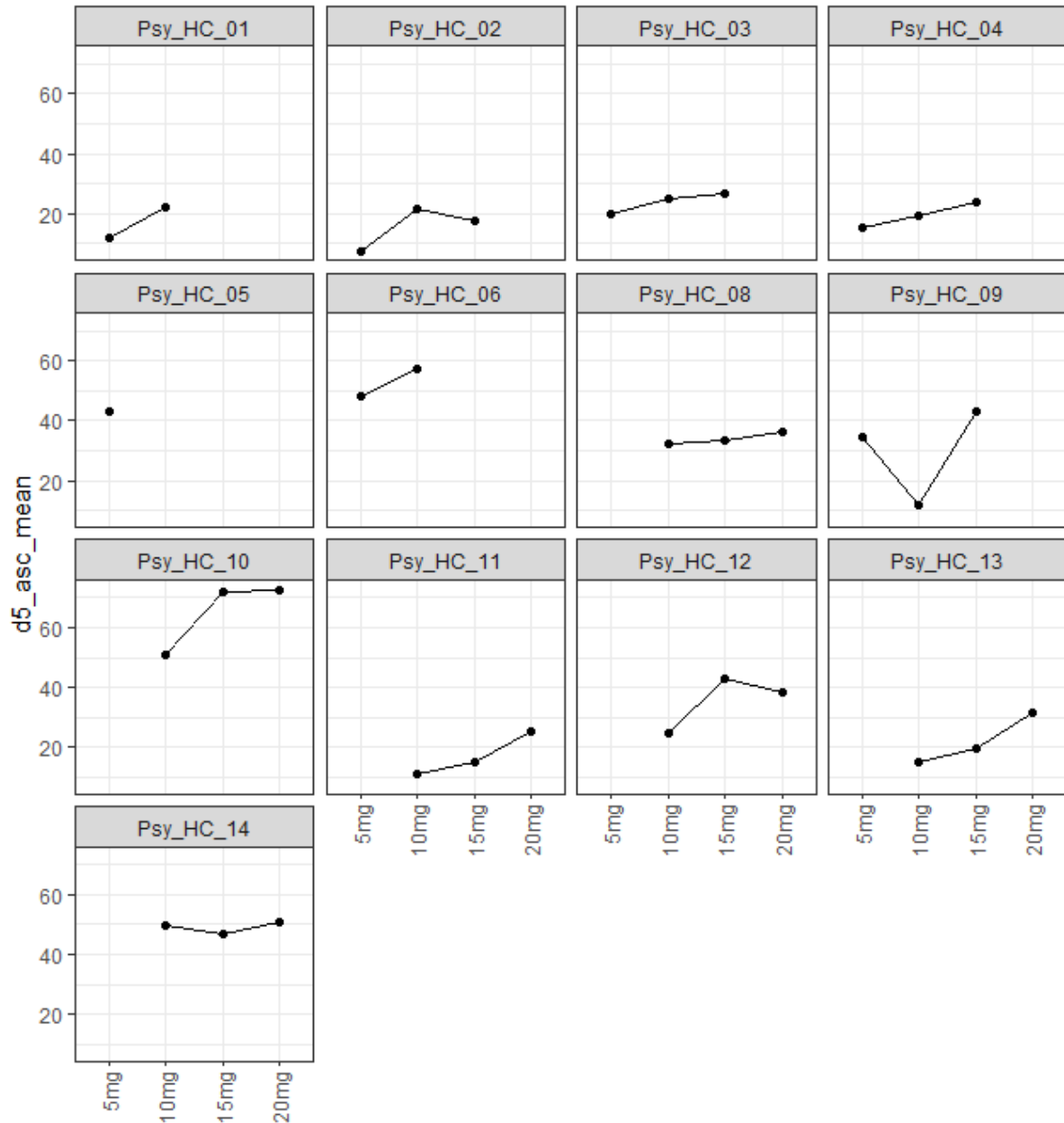


Figure S3.16: Individual profiles for d5_asc_mean.

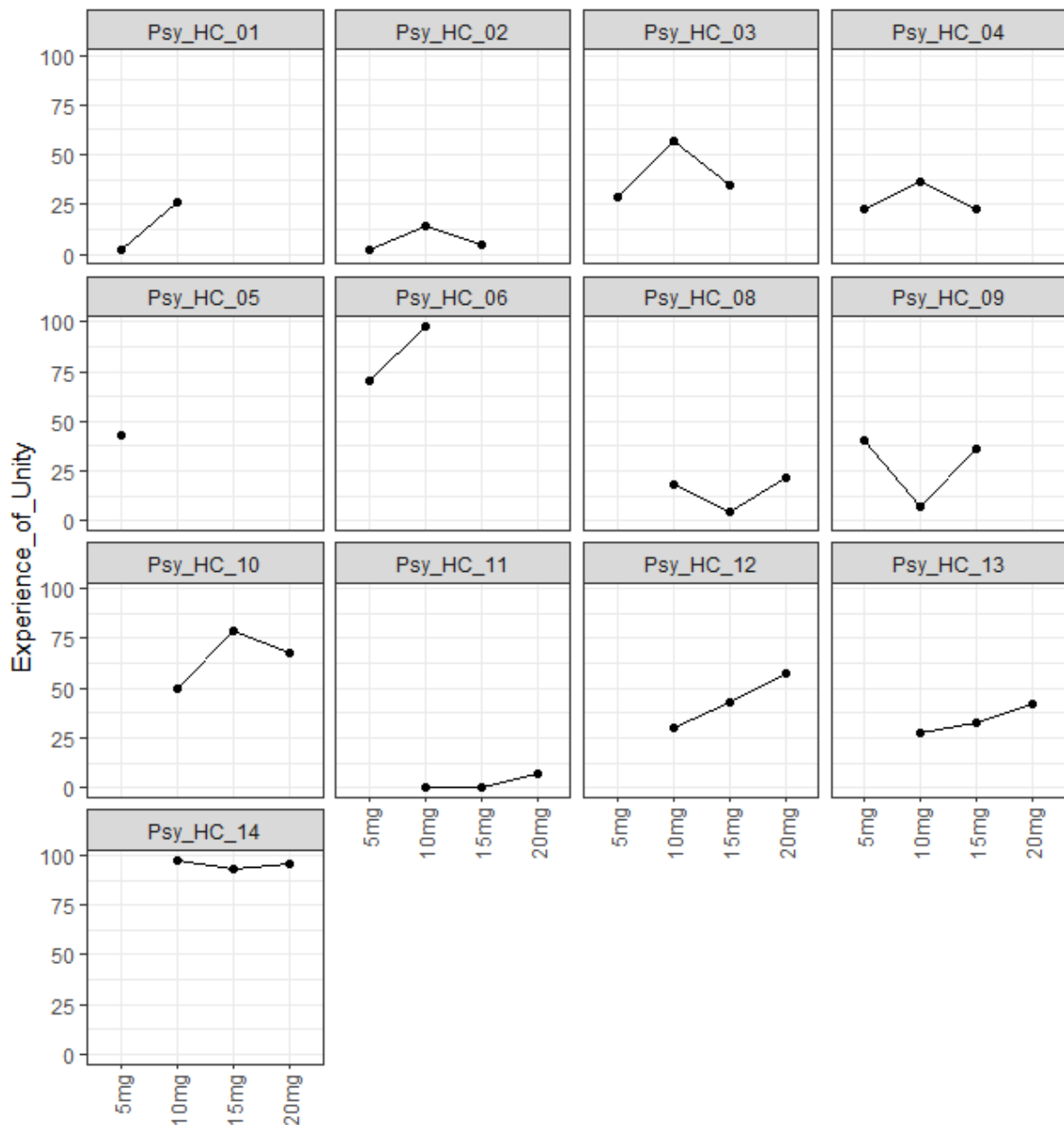


Figure S3.17: Individual profiles for Experience_of_Unity.

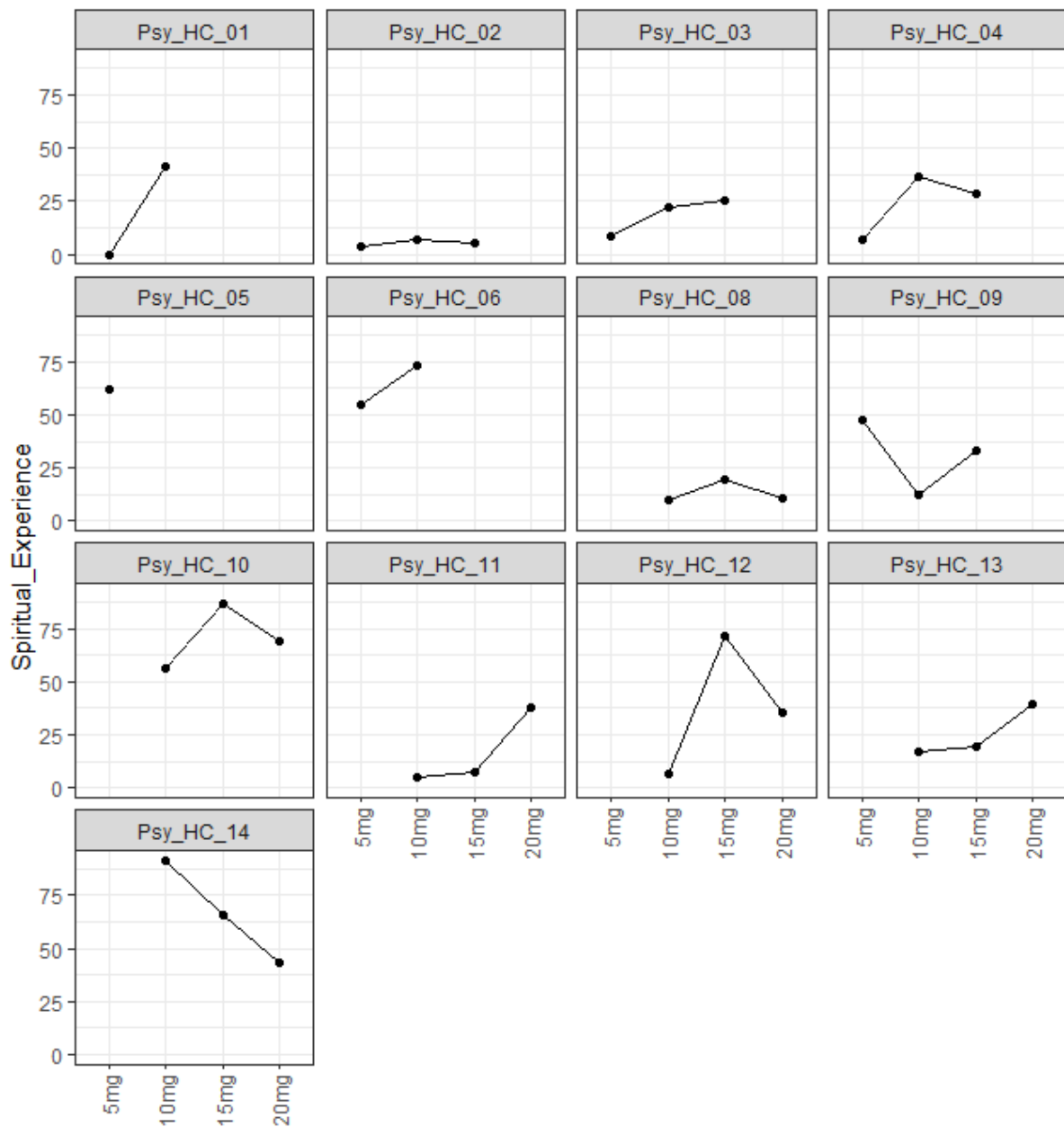


Figure S3.18: Individual profiles for Spiritual_Experience.

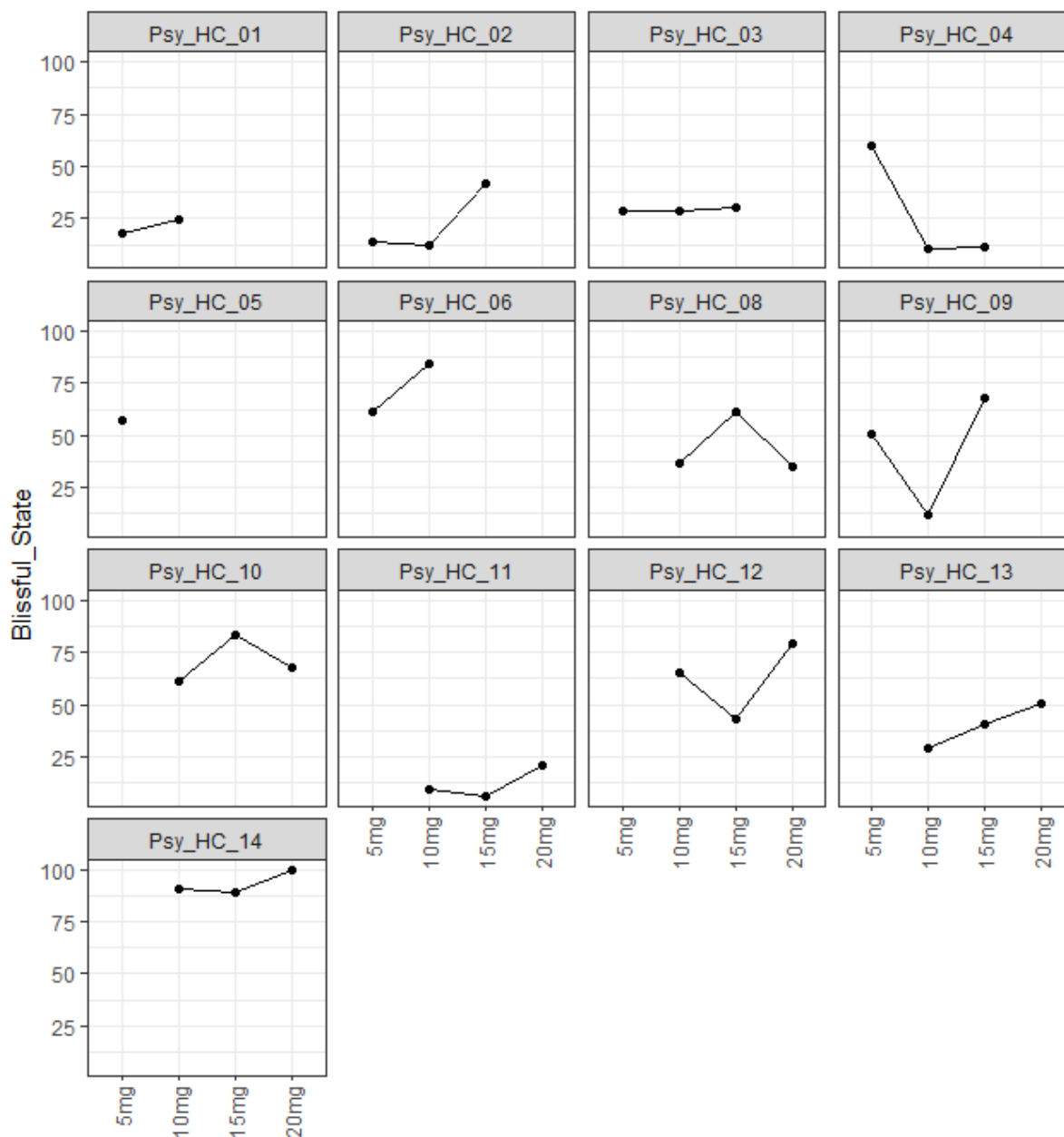


Figure S3.19: Individual profiles for *Blissful_State*.

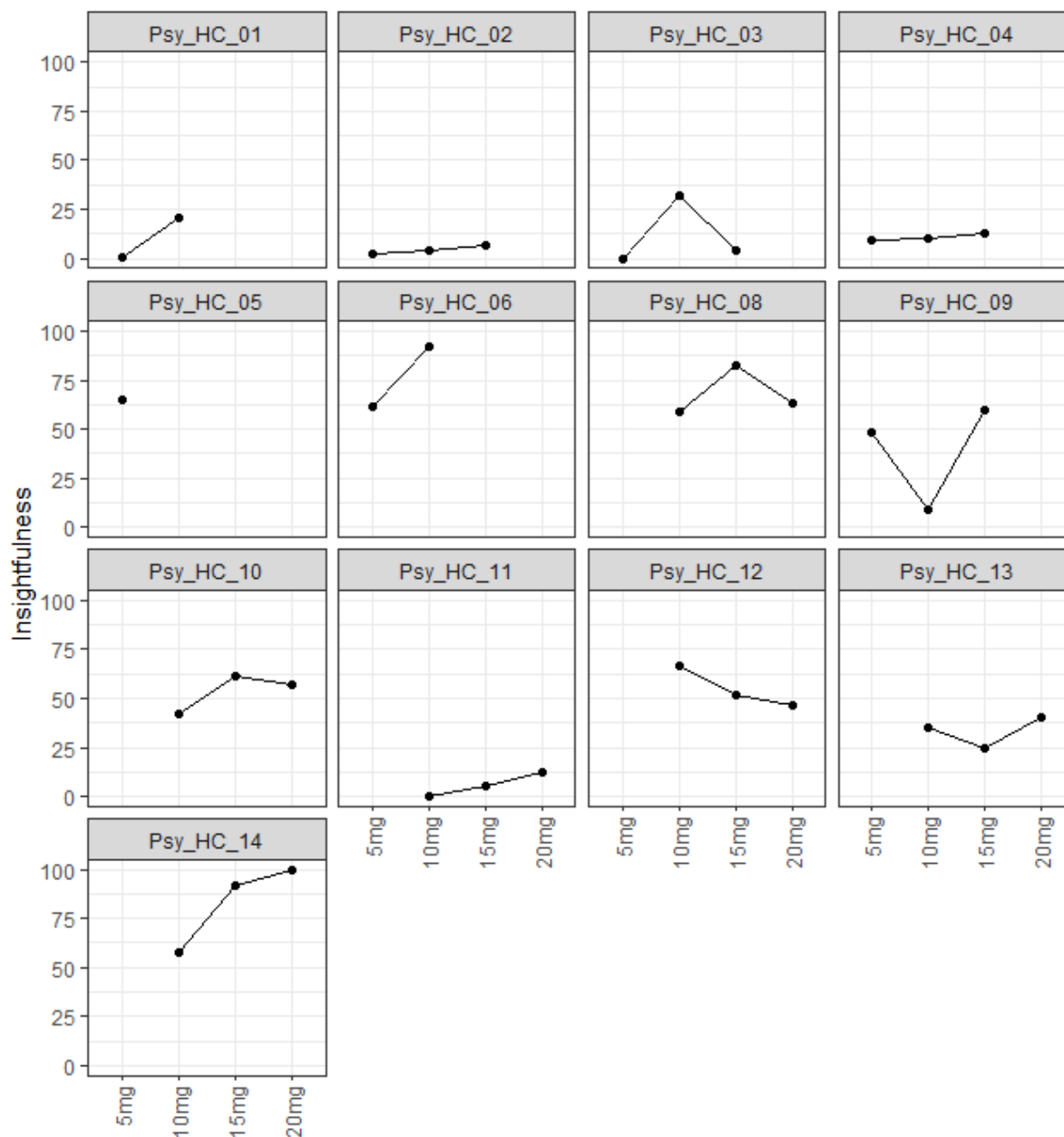


Figure S3.20: Individual profiles for Insightfulness.

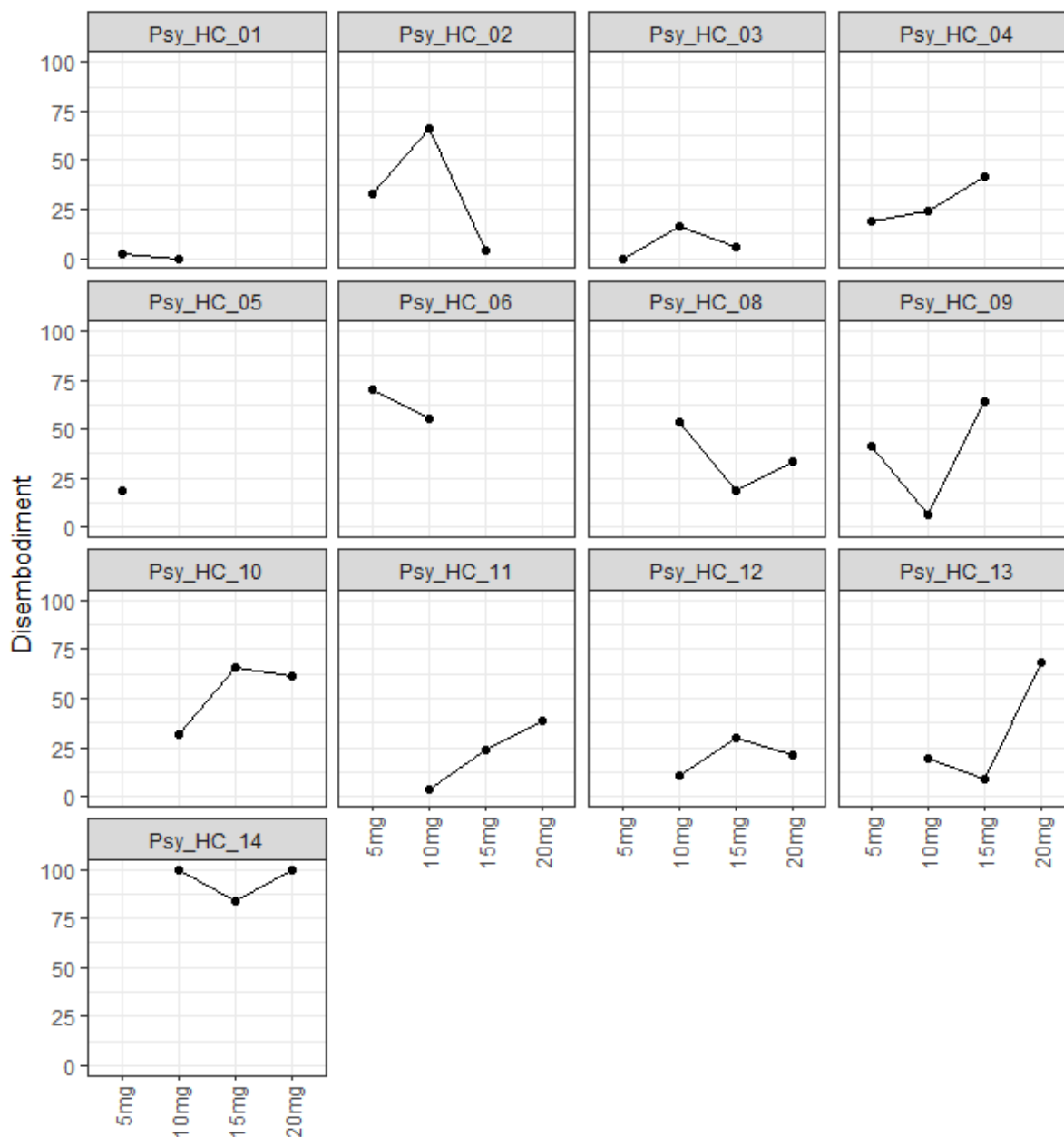


Figure S3.21: Individual profiles for Disembodiment.

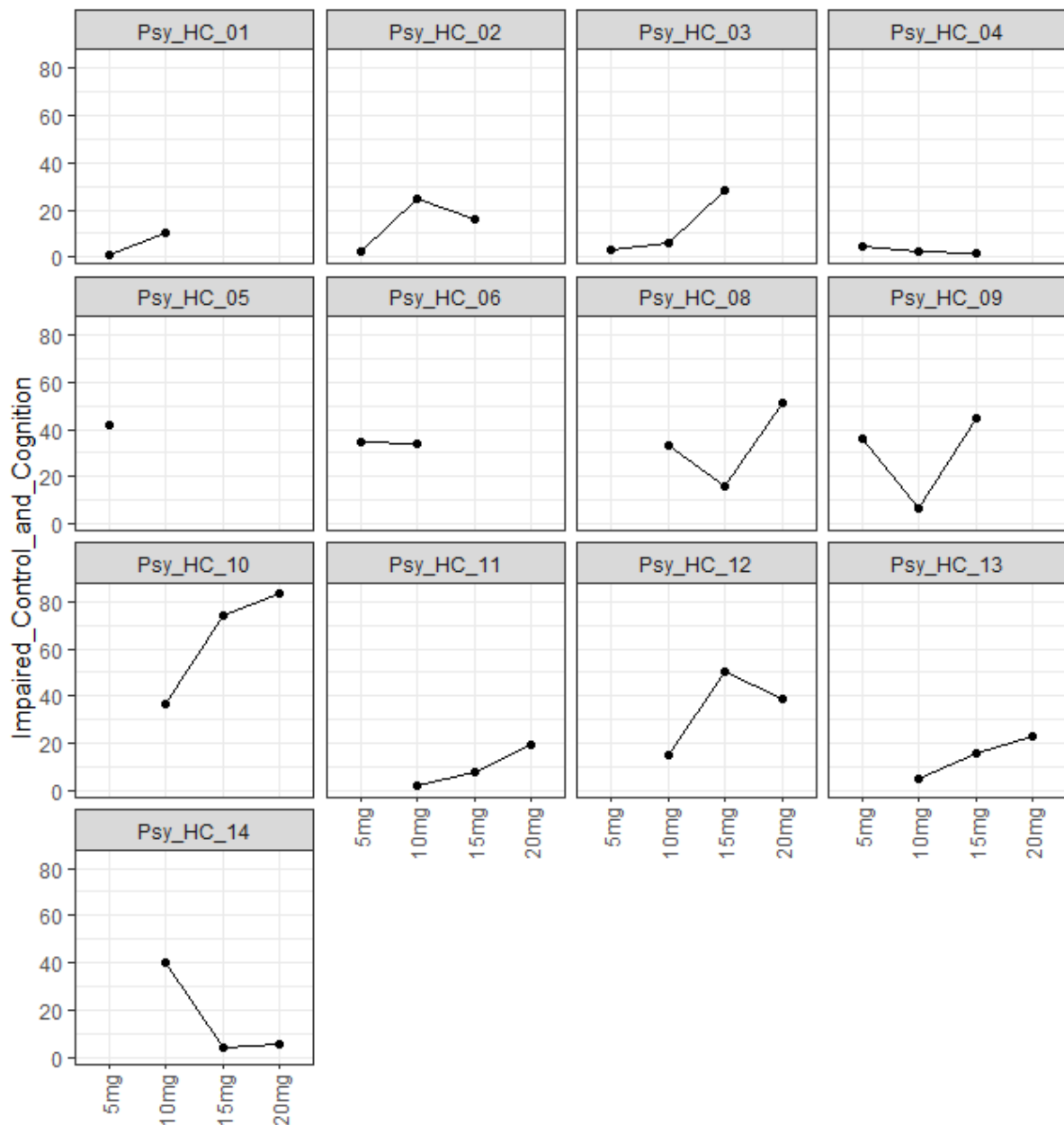


Figure S3.22: Individual profiles for *Impaired_Control_and_Cognition*.

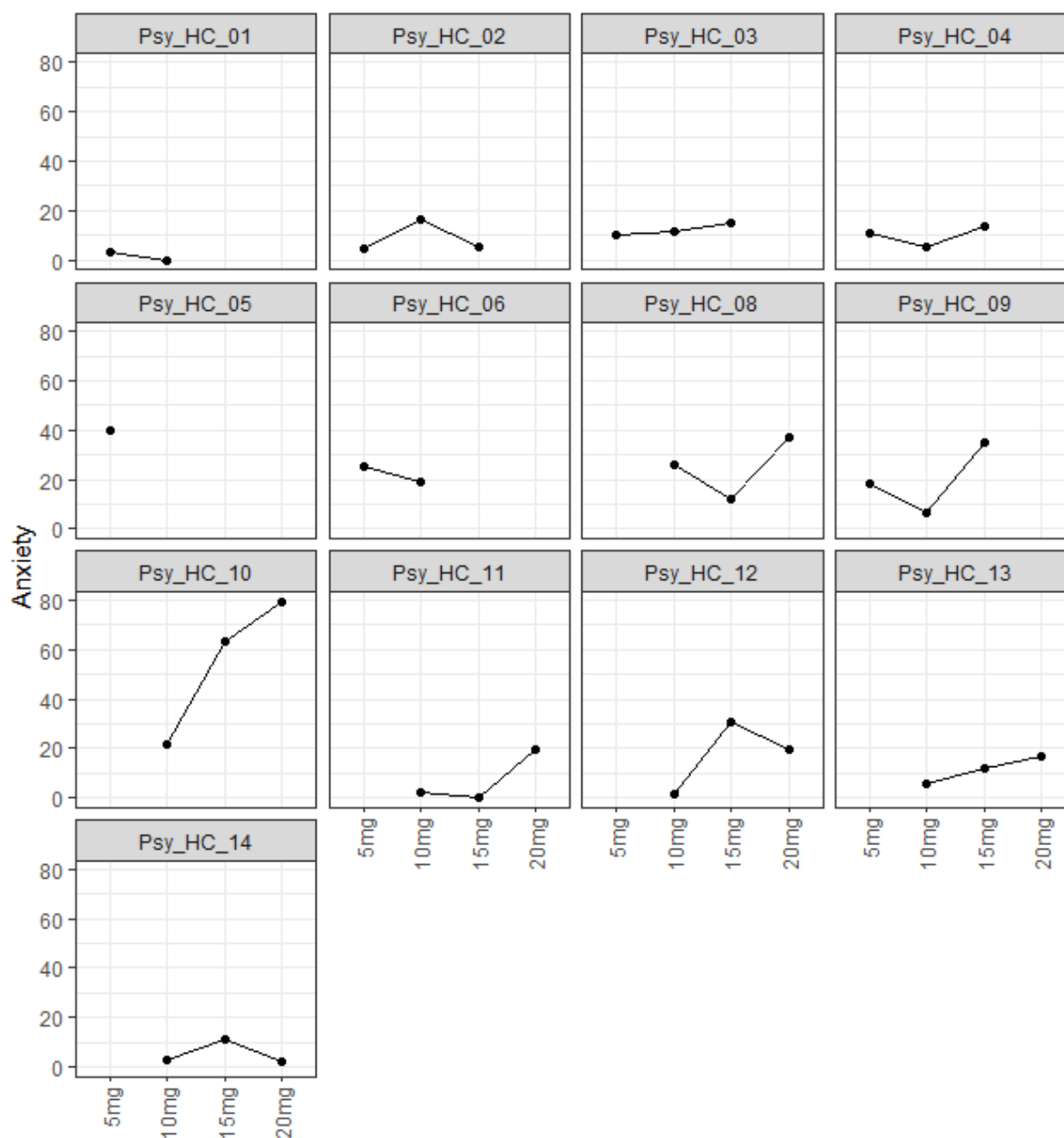


Figure S3.23: Individual profiles for Anxiety.

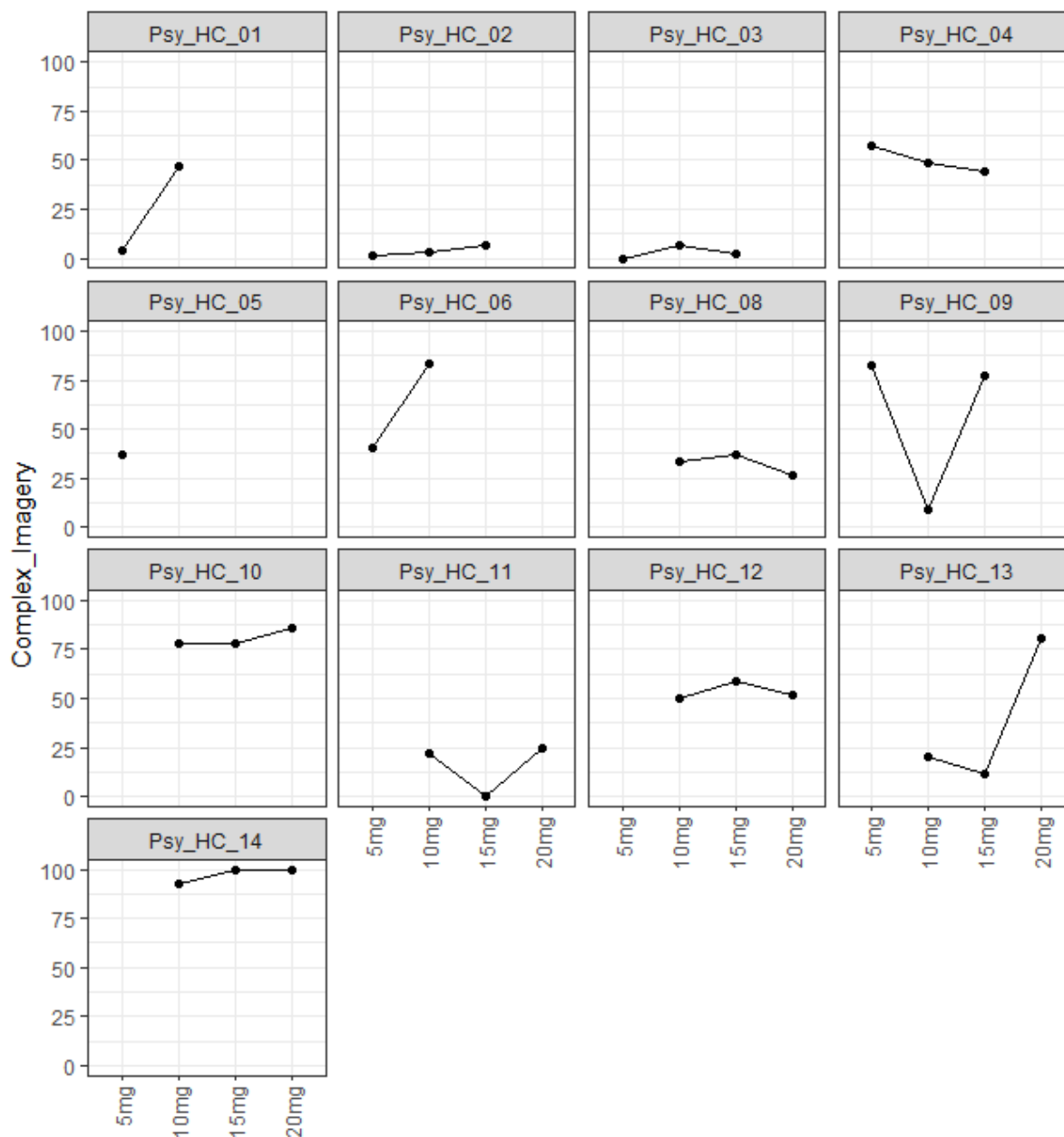


Figure S3.24: Individual profiles for Complex_Imagery.

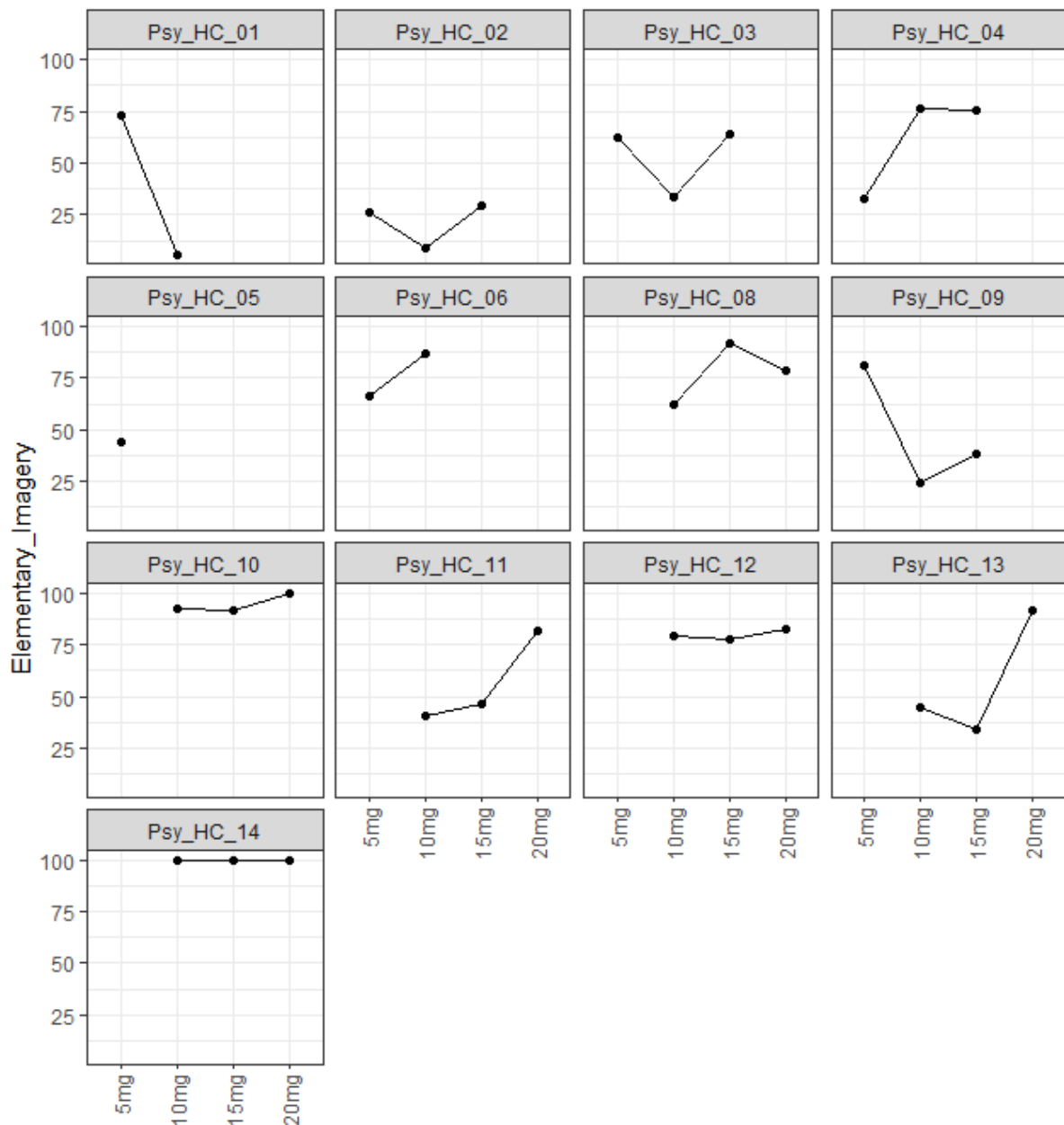


Figure S3.25: Individual profiles for Elementary_Imagery.

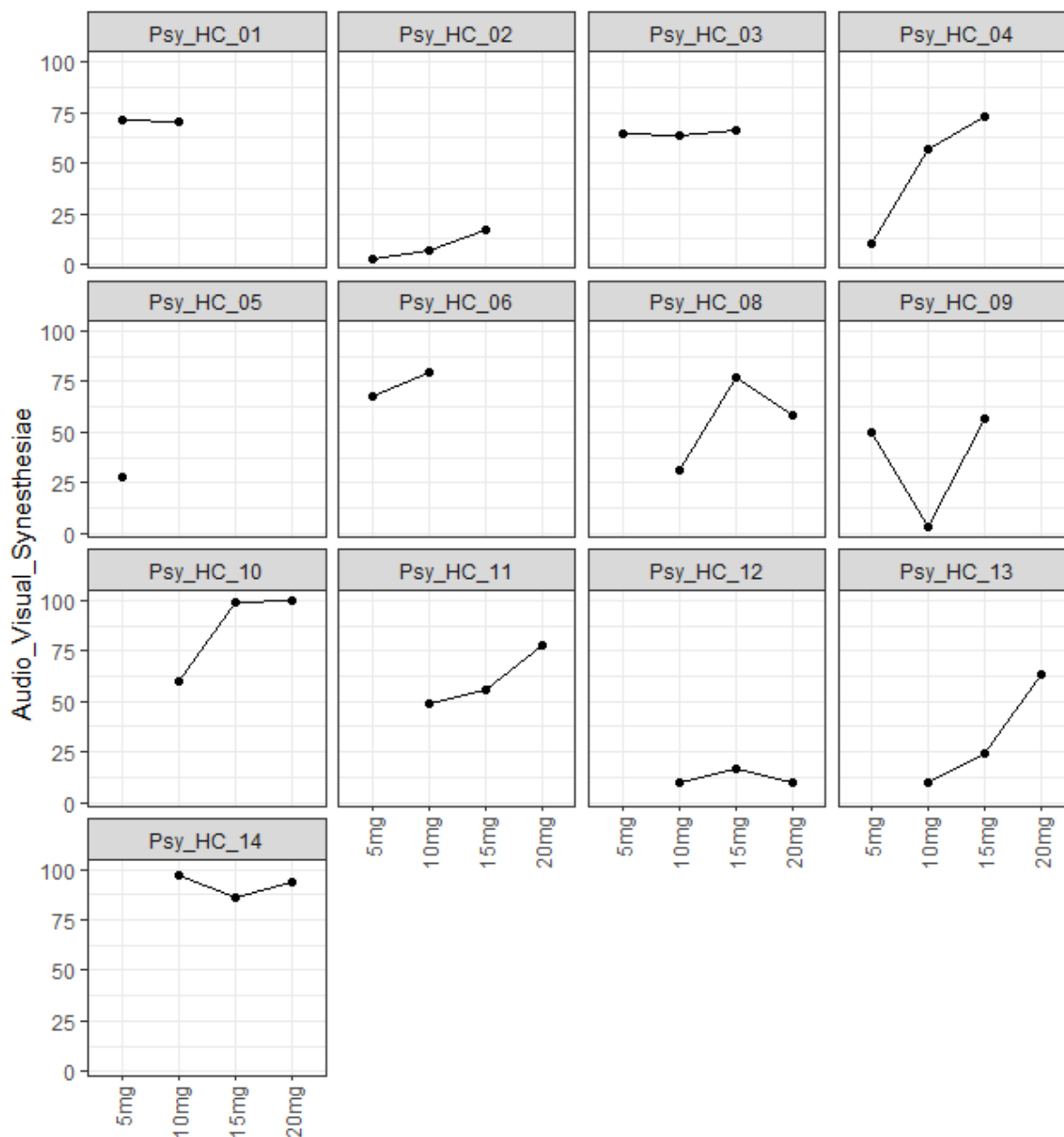


Figure S3.26: Individual profiles for Audio_Visual_Synesthesiae.

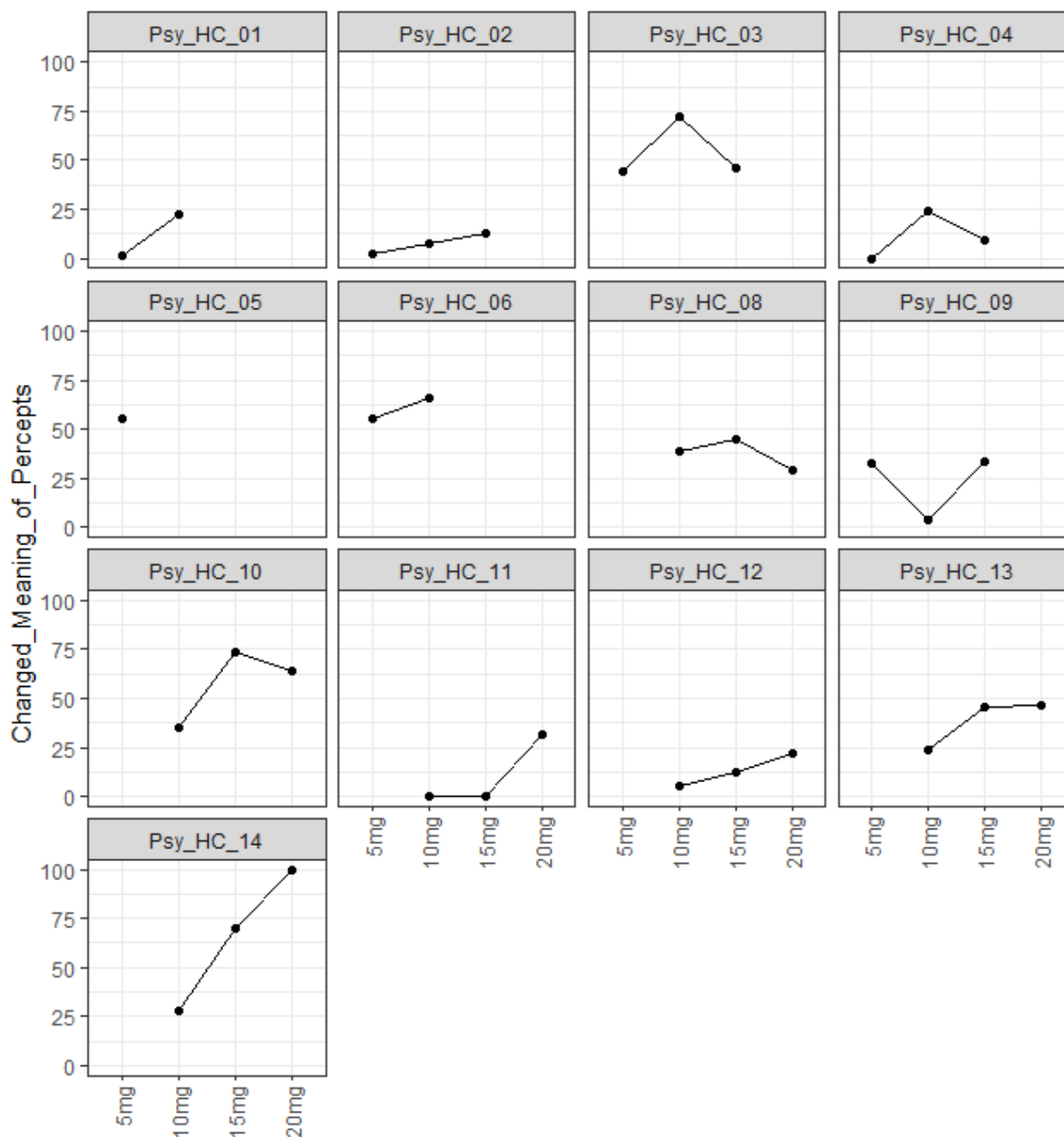


Figure S3.27: Individual profiles for *Changed_Meaning_of_Percepts*.
