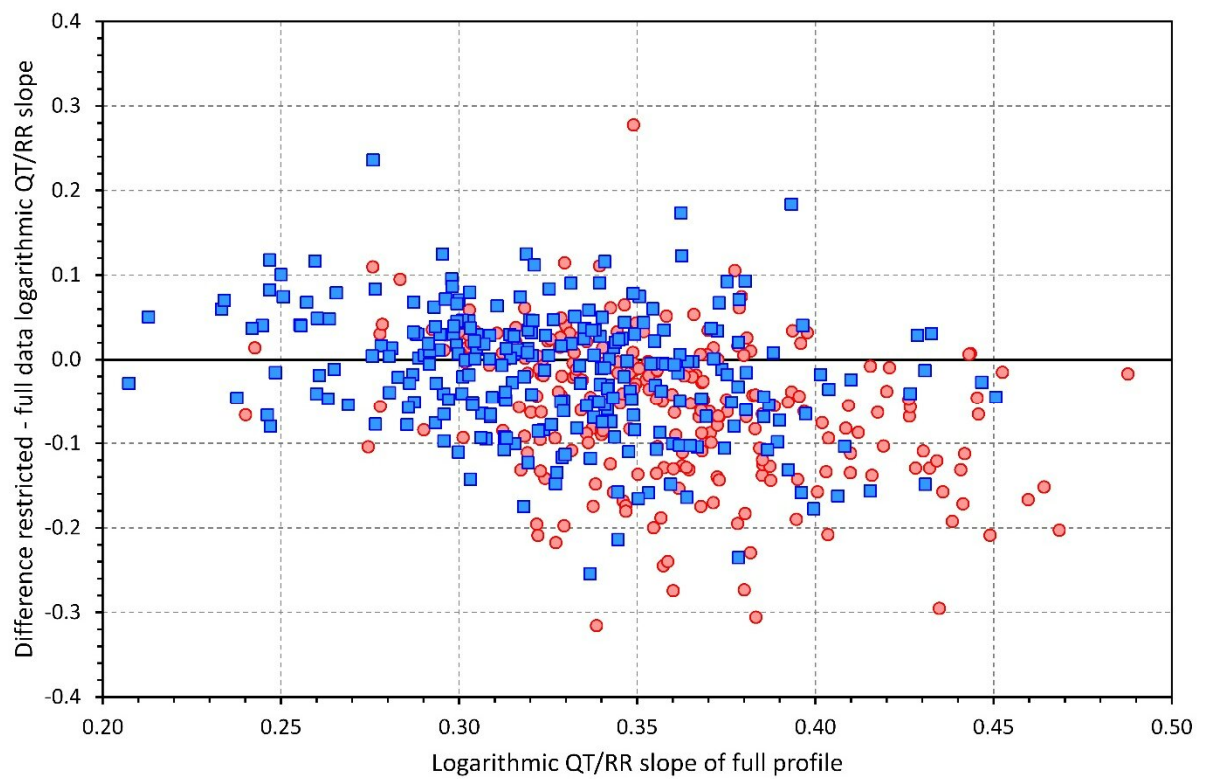
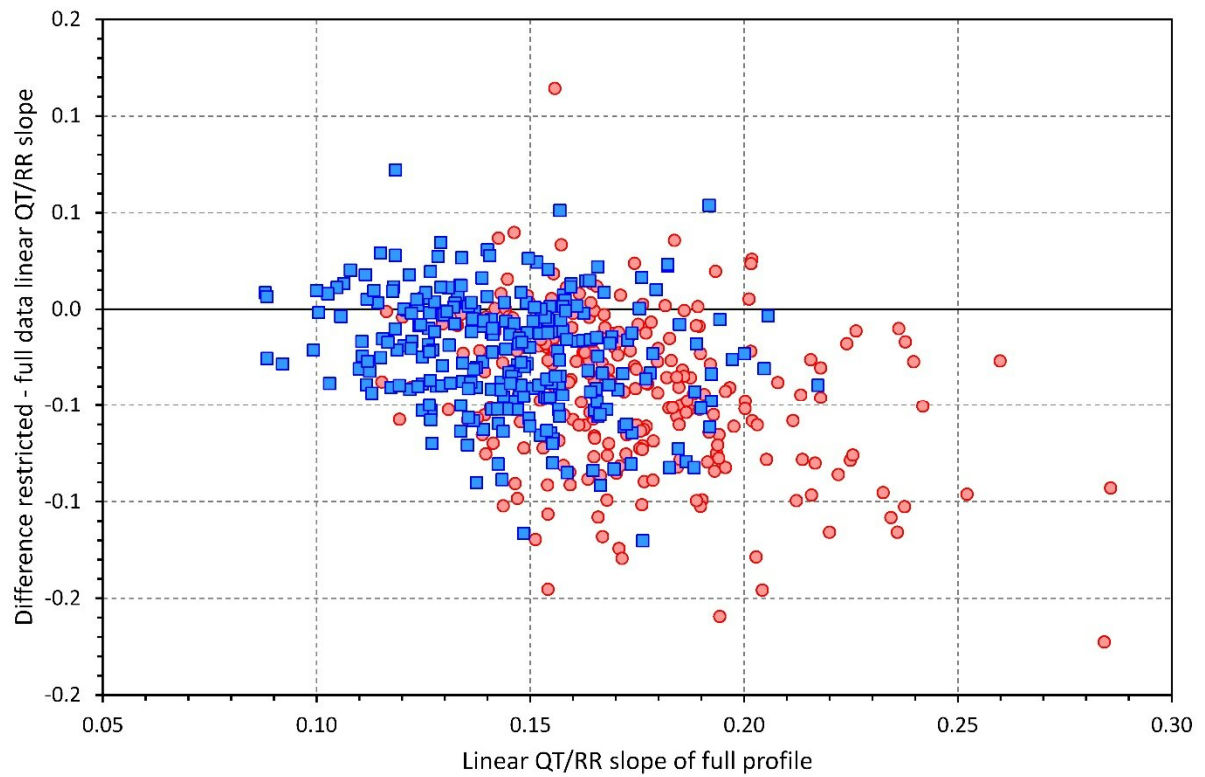

The top panel shows the intra-subject differences between the linear QT/RR slopes assessed from the data restricted to the selected baseline time points and the full profile data (vertical axis) versus the full profile linear QT/RR slopes (horizontal axis). The bottom panel shows the same for the log-linear slopes. In both panels, red circles and blue squares correspond to female and male subjects, respectively.
