Withdrawn Statements

1. The clinical use of clopidogrel with omeprazole has shown significant risk reduction for upper gastrointestinal adverse bleeding events relative to clopidogrel treatment.
 - Withdrawn because this topic is unrelated to the use of OTC PPIs; however, it was felt that this issue warranted mention in the manuscript
 - Level of agreement to withdraw statement (**Agree**: 100%; **Disagree**: 0%)
2. The resolution of gastroesophageal reflux-related sleep impairment with PPIs has significant beneficial effects on quality of life, functionality, and work productivity.
 - Withdrawn because this topic is not directly applicable to OTC PPIs
