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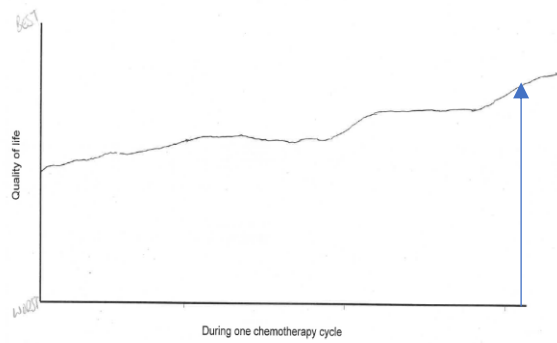
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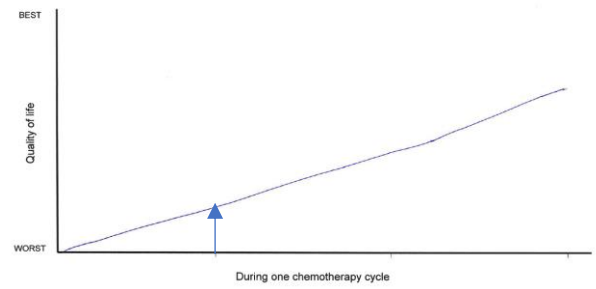
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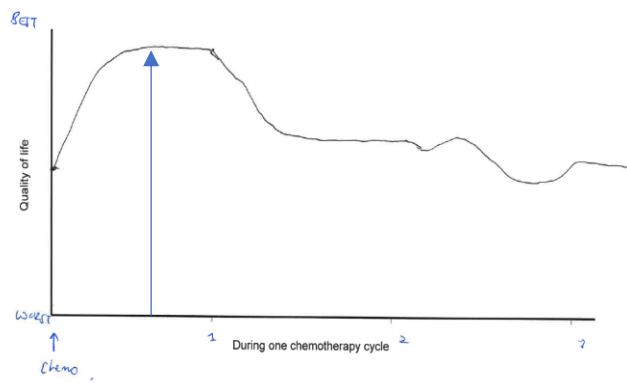
Figure S2. Patients who focused on the best part of their cycle.



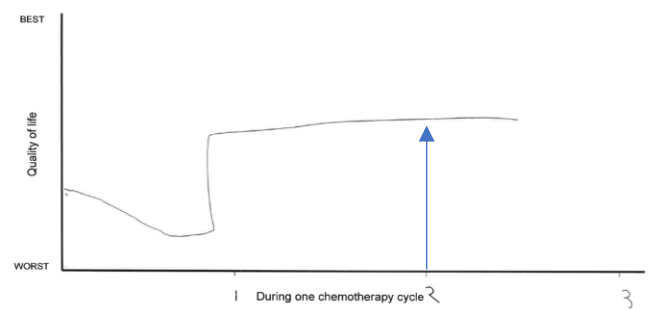
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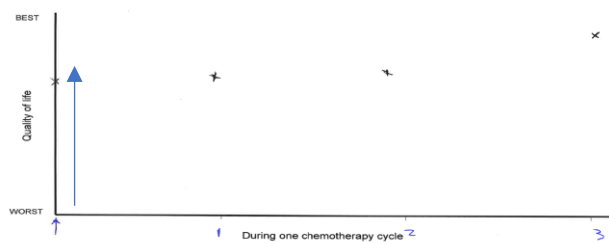
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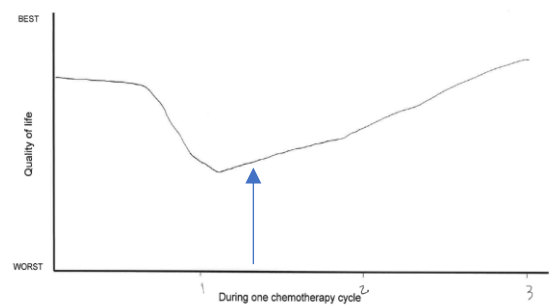
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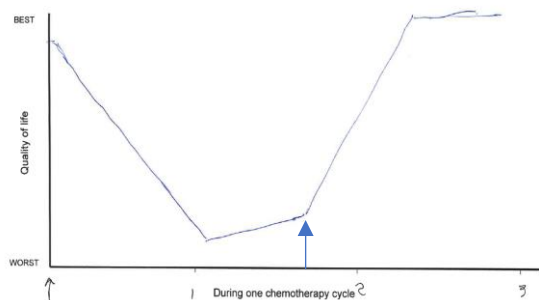
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
