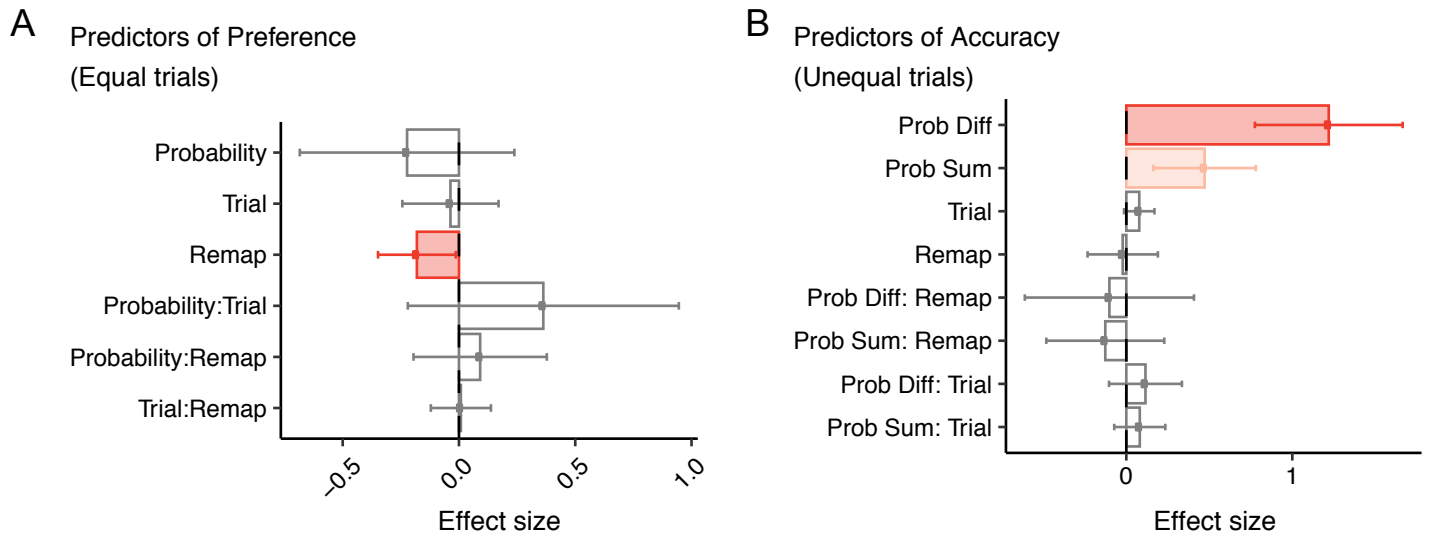

Supplementary Figure S1. Effects of trial order and cue remapping on (A) preference in equal trials and (B) accuracy in unequal trials. Preference and accuracy were coded as binary dependent variables (i.e., whether the choice trial was preferred / associated with a higher reward probability). Rows represent tested fixed effects in each linear mixed-effects model. Remapping was coded as a binary variable (whether the trial occurred pre or post remapping). Trial order was defined with respect to each block (from 1 to 64). Both models contain varying individual intercepts as random effects. Dark red bars represent significant effects with $p < 0.001$. Light red bars represent significant effects with $p < 0.05$. Grey bars represent nonsignificant predictors. Error bars represent 95% confidence intervals.
