

Clinical reasoning workshop

Syllabus

- Concepts and frameworks of clinical reasoning
- Case presentation
- Think about case individually and in group
- Case discussion considering clinical reasoning framework

Instructions for facilitators

- The instructor should present the first syllabus, including concept and framework of clinical reasoning to the students.
- After the first syllabus, students should be divided into small groups (each group consists of 10-12 people).
- The instructor should present the scenario of the case to all of the students. Then for each question, give 5 minutes to students to think about the case individually. Afterward, give 10 minutes to each group to discuss about their thoughts and provide their answers. It's better for each group to write their answers on a piece of paper. Then each group reports their answers and the instructor write the answers on the board.
- At the next step, the instructor should report the full answers to each question. After completing all of the questions, the instructor should summarize the framework of clinical reasoning.
