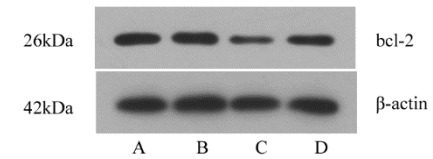
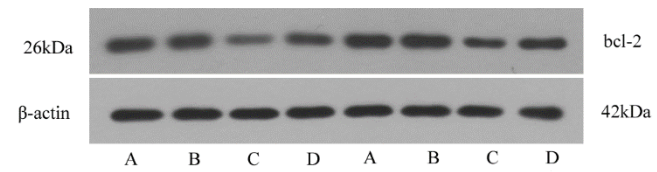
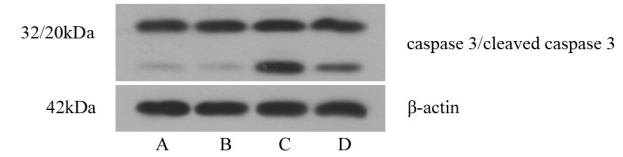
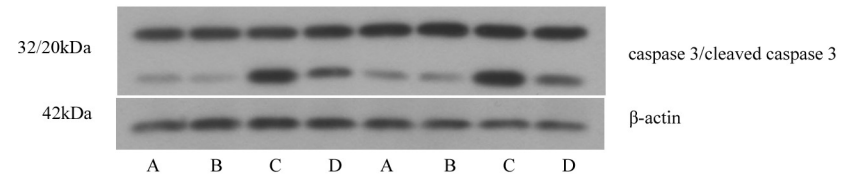

Original image western blot for three repeats

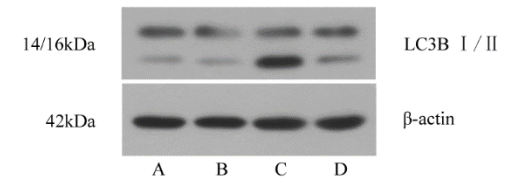
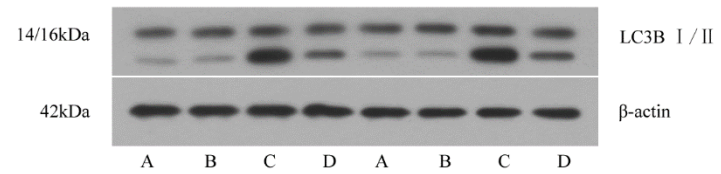
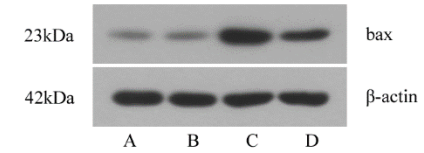
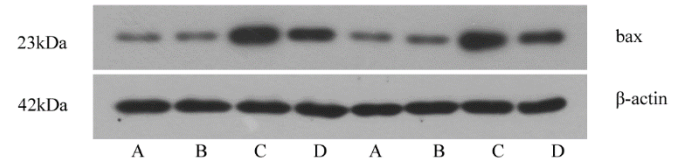
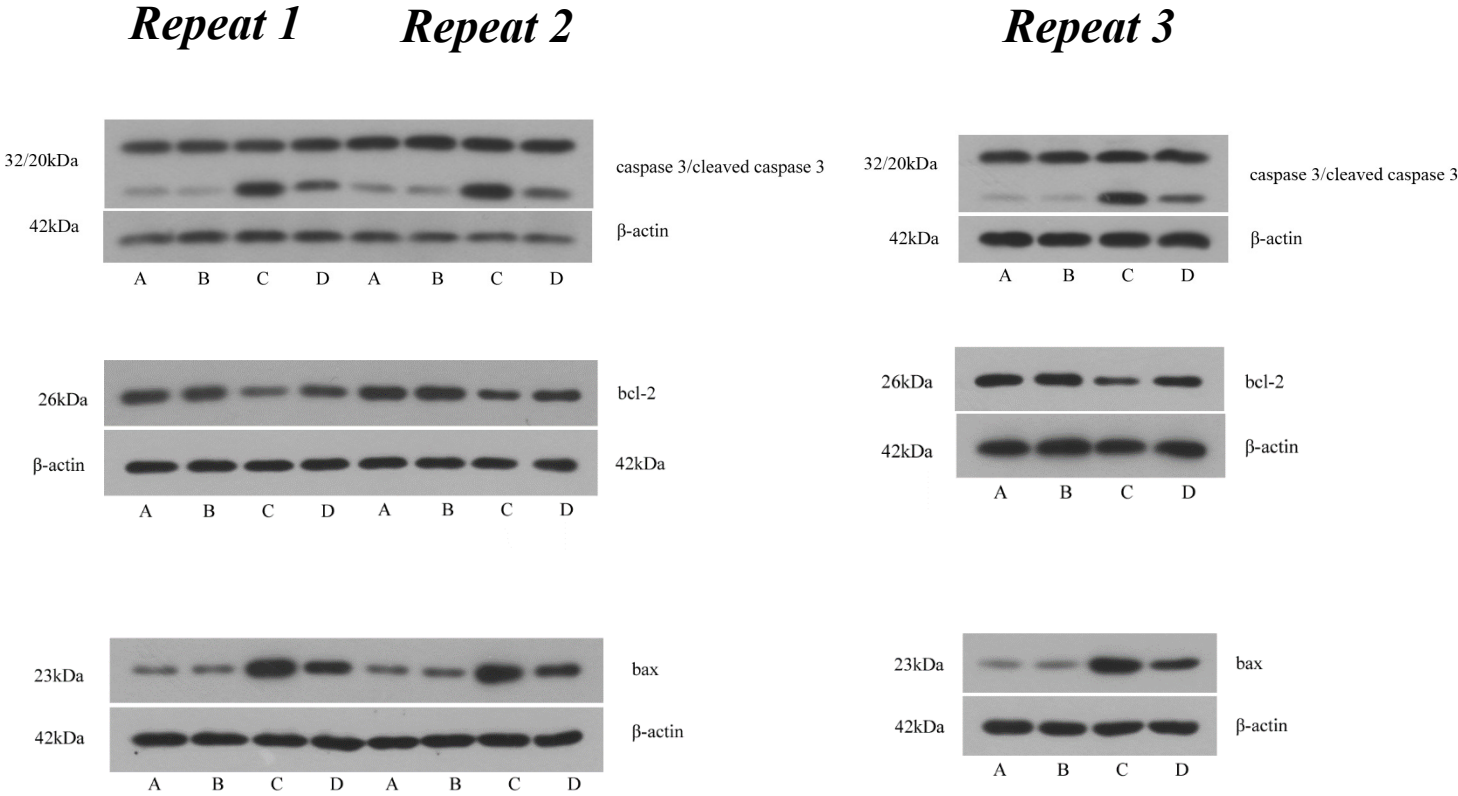
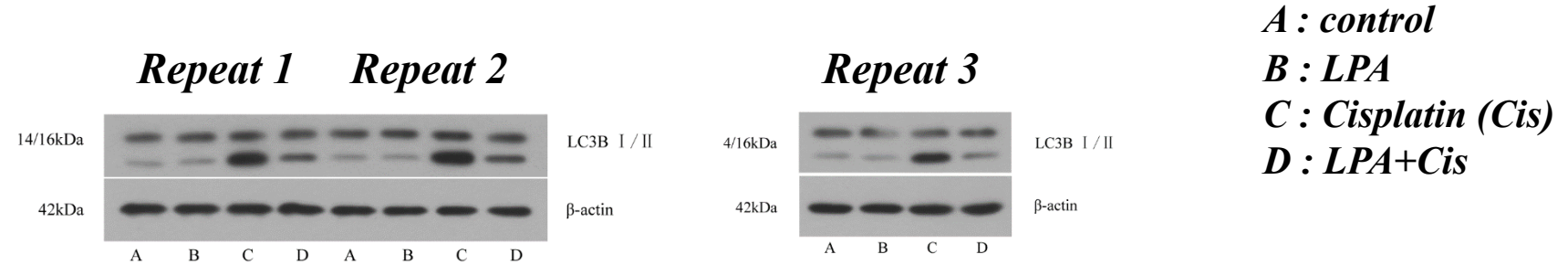


Figure 2(C-I). Original western blot for three repeats
