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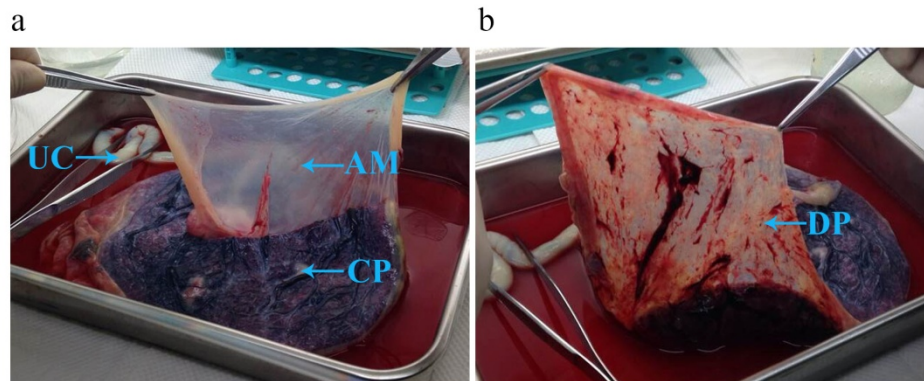

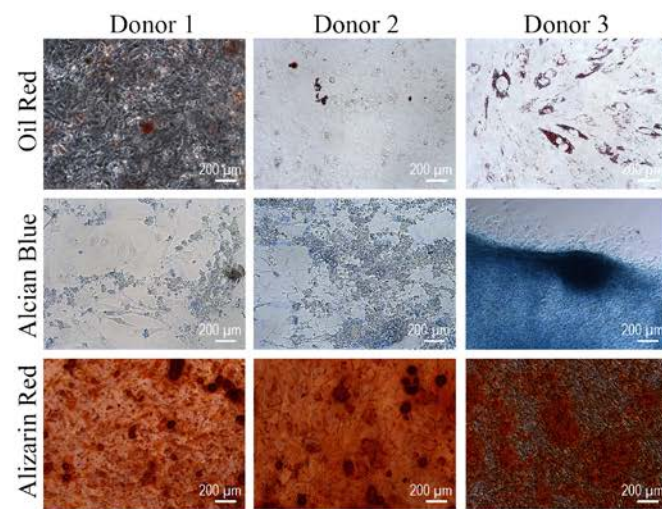


Figure S2. Trilineage differentiation potential of AM-MSCs (n=3). Related to Figure 1.

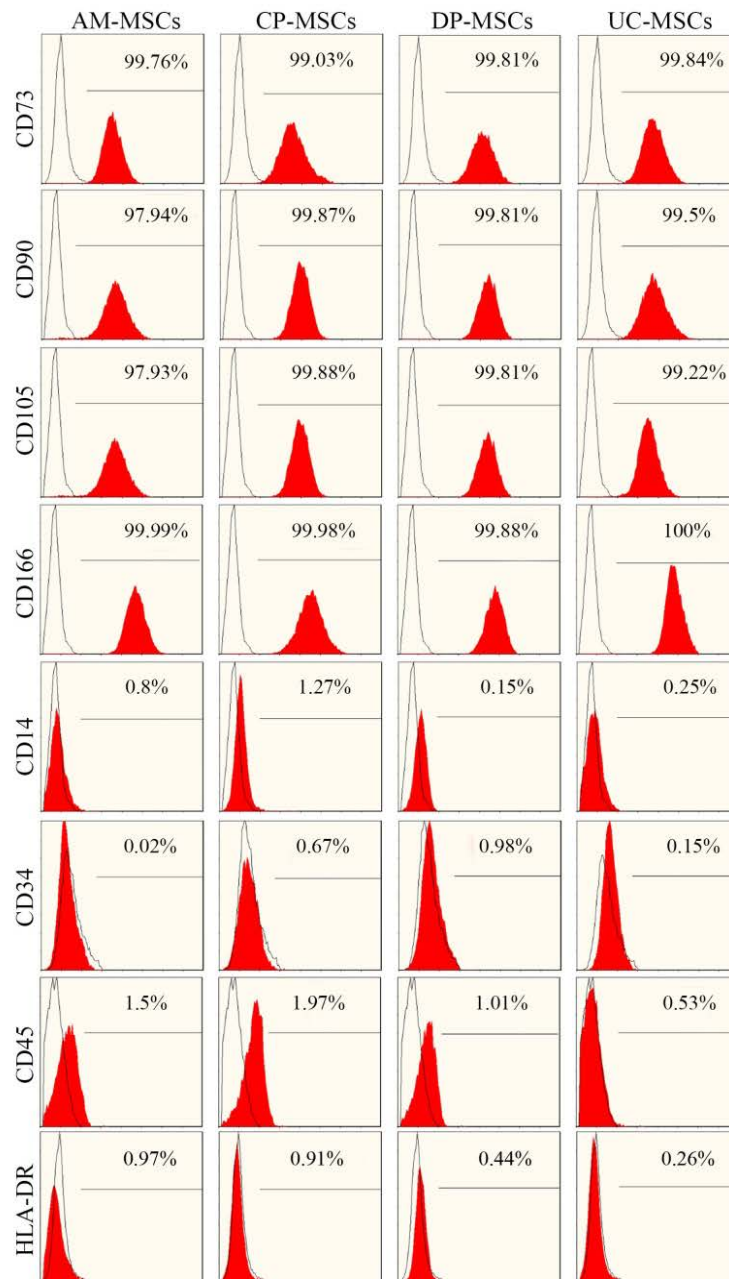


Figure S3. Flow cytometric analysis of typical MSCs markers. Related to Figure 1.

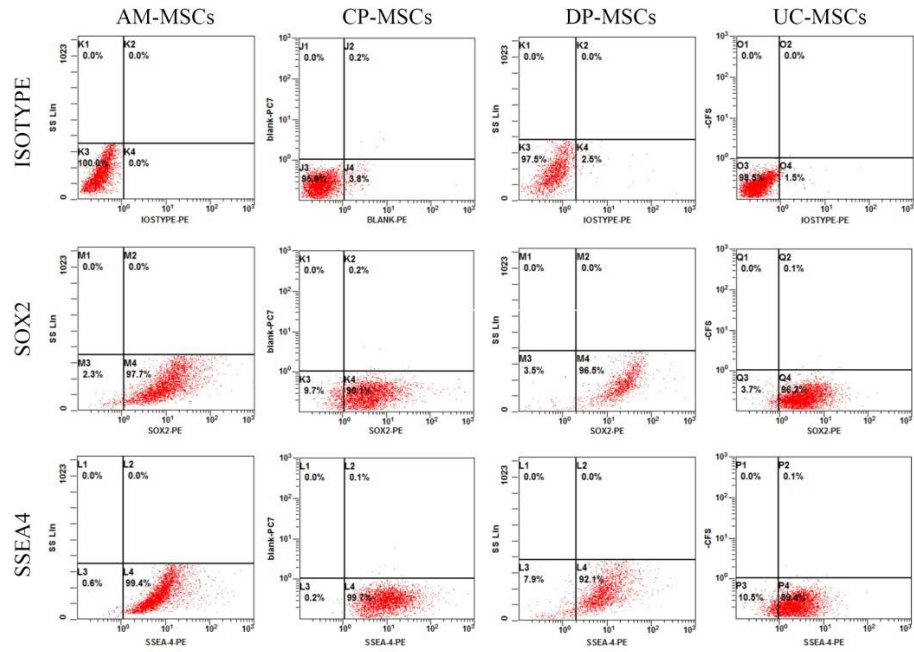


Figure S4. Flow cytometric analysis of embryonic stem cell markers. Related to Figure 1.
