

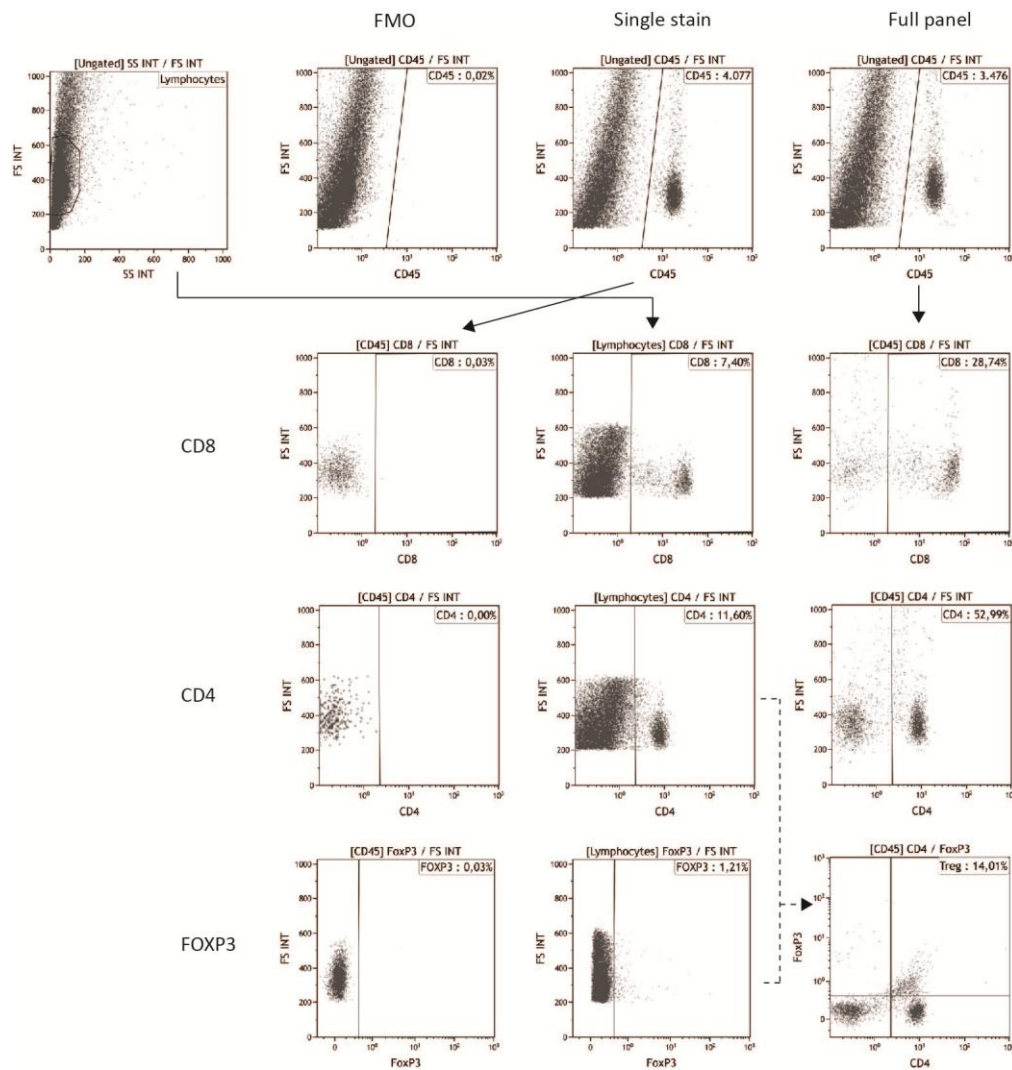
Intradermal injection of low dose human regulatory T cells inhibits skin inflammation in a humanized mouse model.
