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## **Appendix 1. Search Strategy**

The search strategy was in English for the PubMed, Embase, PsycINFO and Web of Science databases and the corresponding search strategy was in Chinese for the China National Knowledge Infrastructure, VIP, WANFANG DATA, and China Science Periodical databases. The search strategies included at least one search item from four search fragments shown as below:

- 1) "attention deficit disorders with hyperactivity" OR "attention deficit hyperactivity disorders" OR "hyperkinetic syndrome" OR "minimal brain dysfunction" OR ADD OR ADHD OR "hyperkinetic disorder";
- 2) child\* OR adolescen\* OR teen\* OR youth\* OR preschooler\*;
- 3) prevalence\* OR survey\* OR epidemi\* OR investigat\* OR surveillance;
- 4) China OR Chinese OR "People's Republic of China" OR PRC OR "Mainland China" OR Taiwan OR "Republic of China" OR ROC OR Formosa OR Taiwanese OR "Taiwanese people" OR "Hong Kong" OR "Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China" OR "Hong Kong people" OR Hong Kongers OR "Hong Kongese" OR "Hong Kongers" OR Hong Kongese.

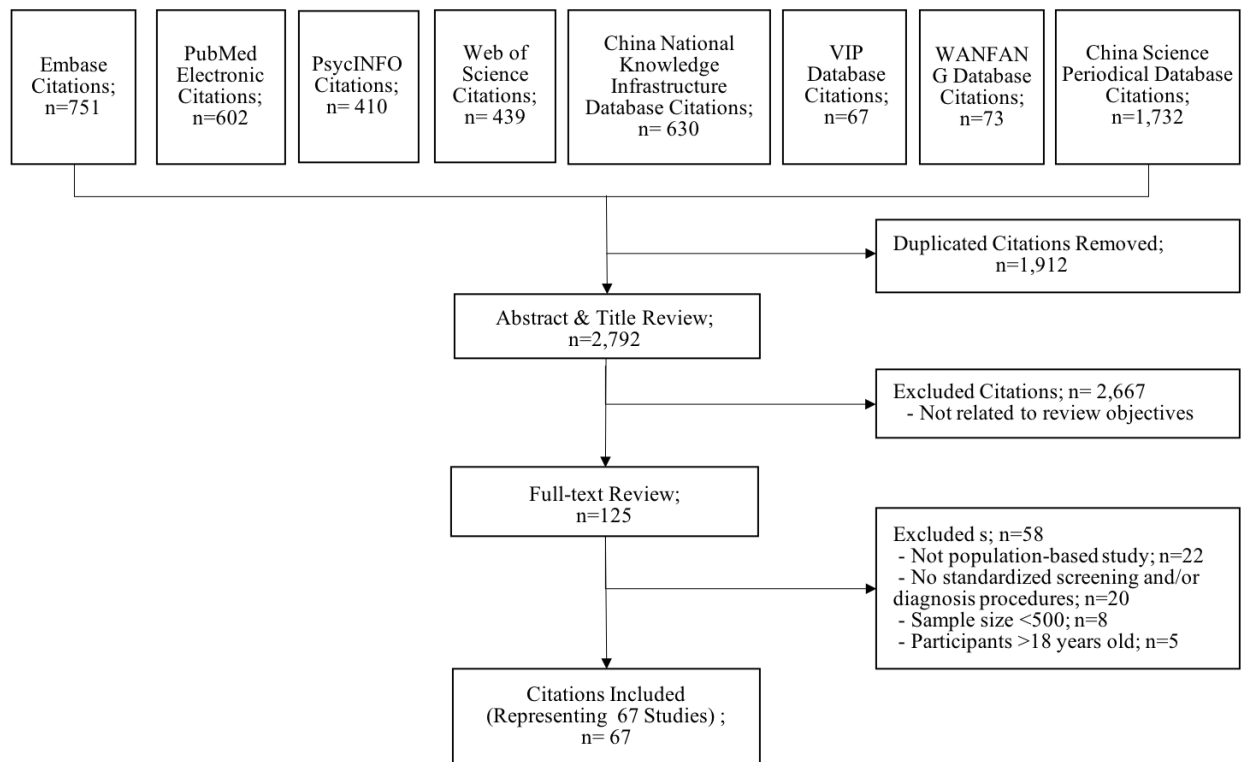


Figure 1. PRISMA Flowchart
