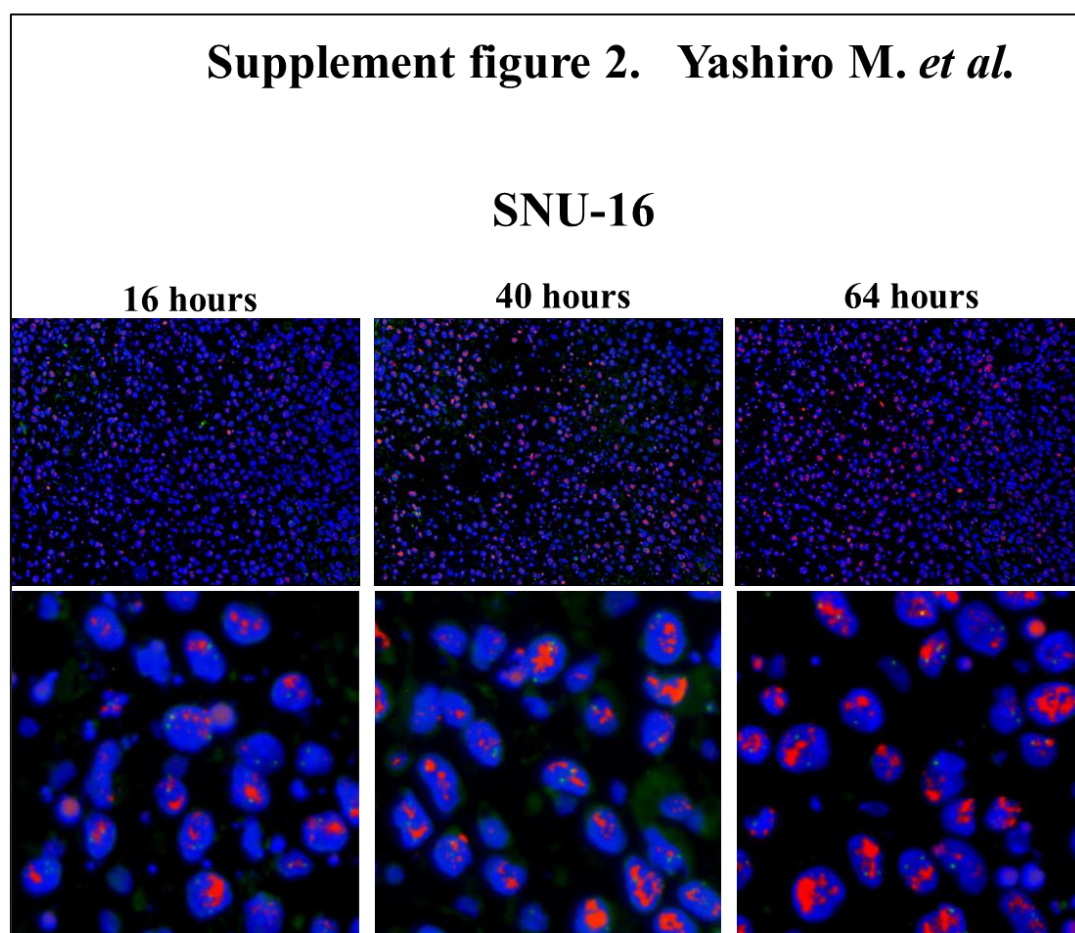


Clinical Difference Between Fibroblast Growth Factor Receptor 2 Subclass, Type IIIb and Type IIIc, in Gastric Cancer

Probe FGFR2/CEN10p Dual Probe conjugated with Texas Red/FITC were hybridized on SNU-16 cells for 16, 40, and 64 hours. Hybridization time for 40 hours was determined to be adequate.
