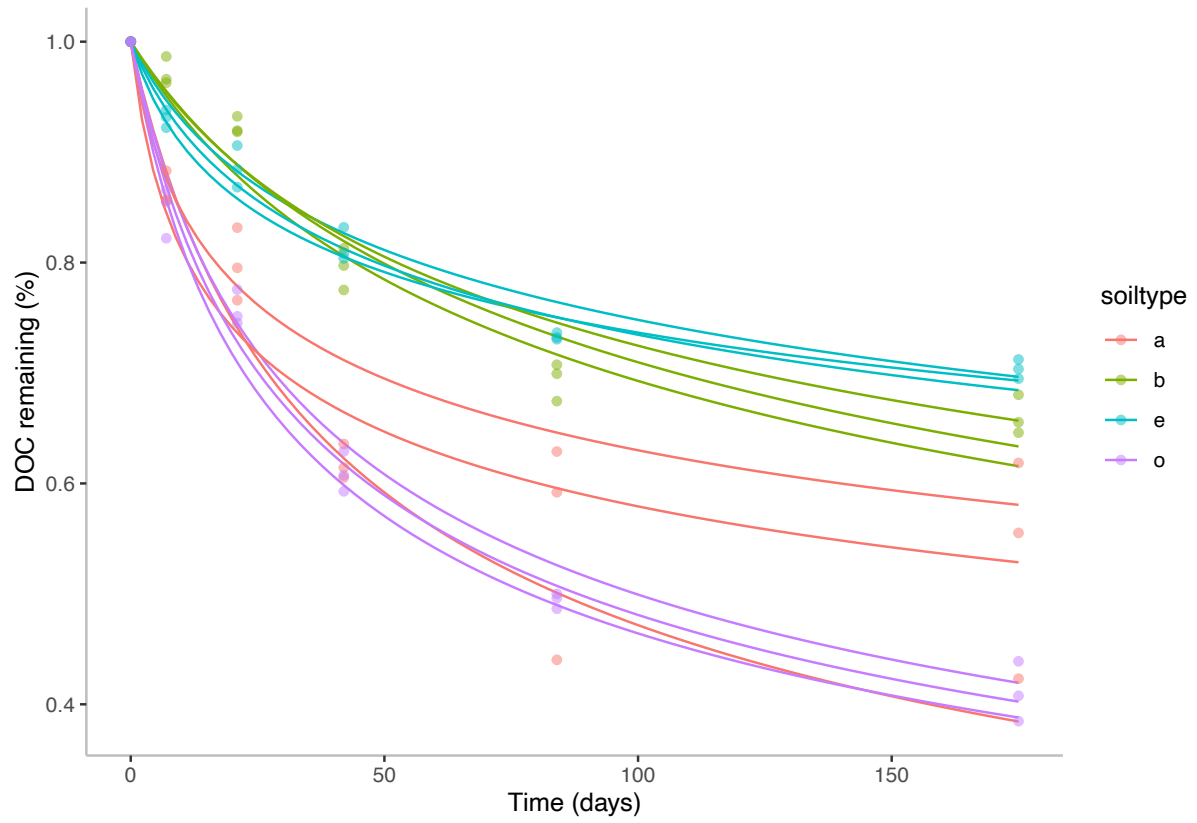

Supp. Fig. 1: DOC remaining (%) during the incubation of the WEOC from the soil horizons. Shown are the individual incubations with the lines representing the reactivity continuum model: $\frac{DOC_t}{DOC_0} = \left(\frac{a}{a+t}\right)^v$, where a is a rate parameter and v is related to the shape of the distribution of decay rates at different times.
