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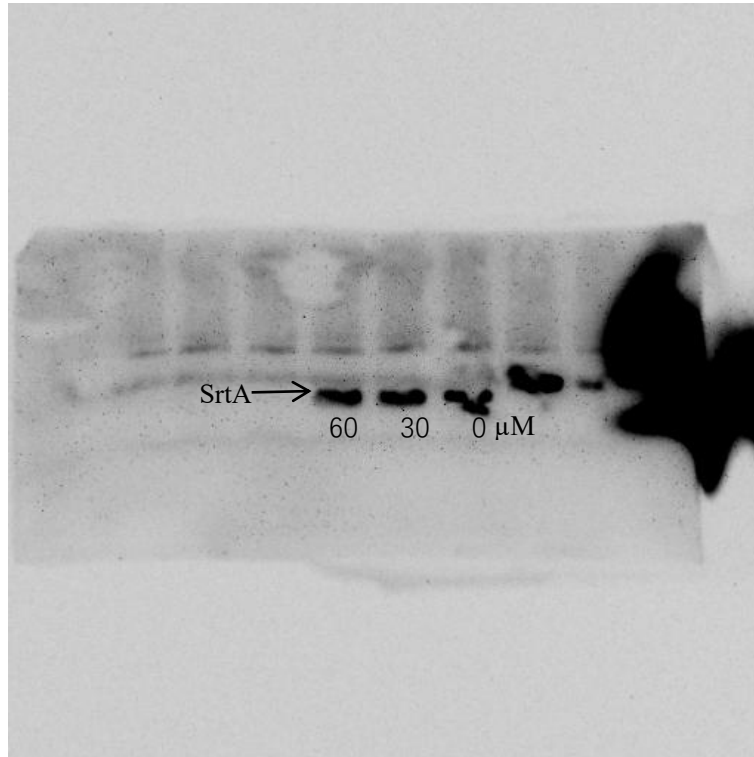
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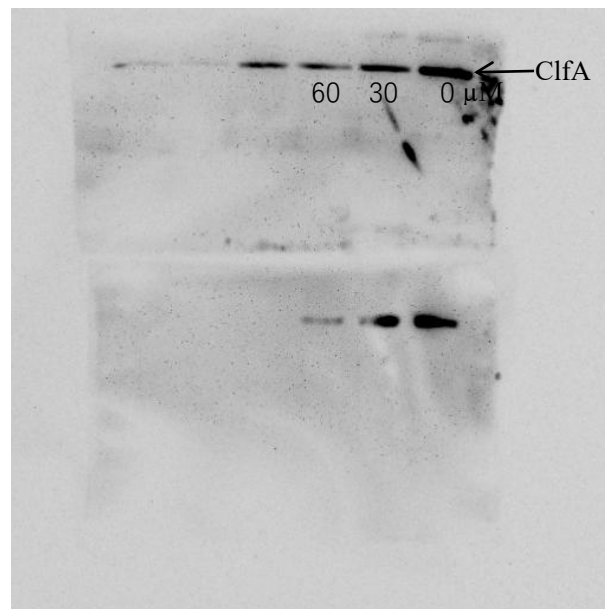
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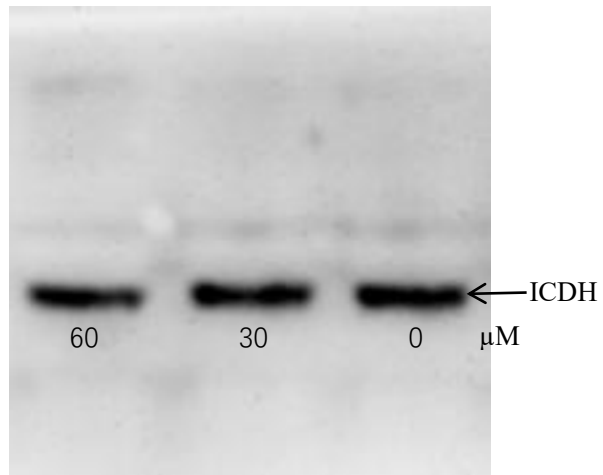
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The original image of SrtA expression in *S. aureus* when treated with different concentrations of Hyperin.
