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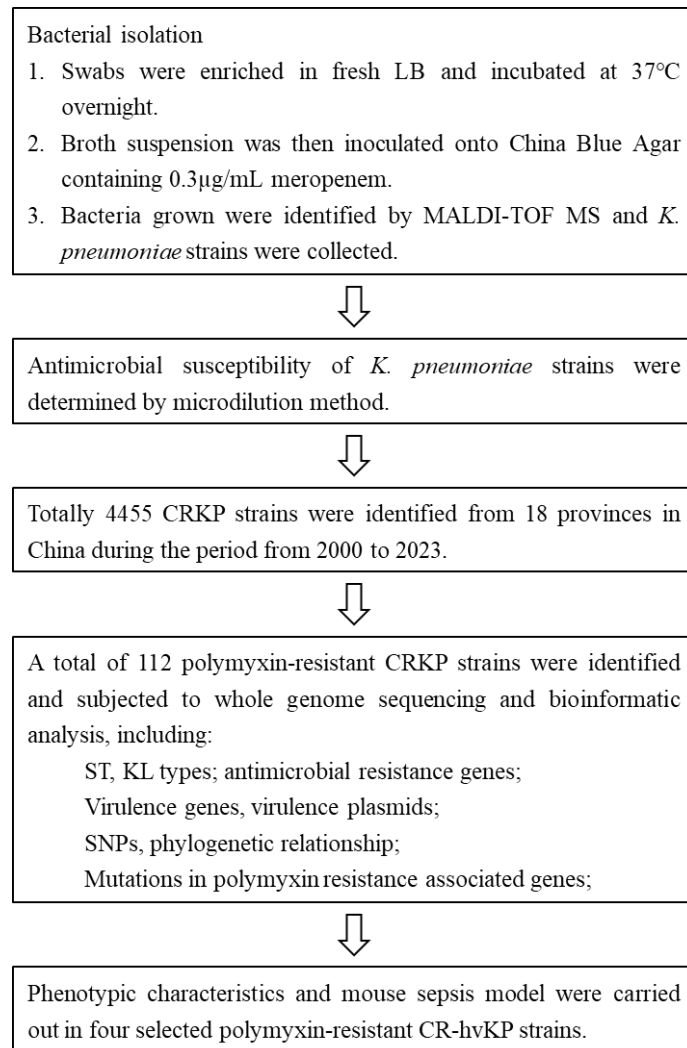
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Supplementary Fig. 1 Flow chart diagram showing the isolation and analysis of polymyxin-resistant CRKP strains in this study.
