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## **Supplementary figure 1: Comparison of PrP immunoreactivity between healthy and scrapie-infected primate**

A) Absence of detection of PrP<sup>C</sup> in the brain of a healthy primate (x3.6, 3F4 monoclonal antibody). B) Strong PrP<sup>Sc</sup> immunoreactivity in the brain of scrapie-infected primate (x3.6, 3F4). It must be noted that the scrapie-infected primate brain is smaller due to atrophy.
