RESEARCHER 1: RELIEF AT DIAGNOSIS (NON-MALIGNANT) BUT ALSO A BURDEN. SUSPICION AND SCEPTICISM ALSO A BURDEN OF FM DIAGNOSIS.

RESEARCHER 2: DIAGNOSIS OF FIBROMYALGIA A RELIEF (AS NOT A FATAL DISEASE) AS WELL AS A BURDEN (AS NOT ROOTED IN FULLY TREATABLE BIOLOGICAL SIGNS AND VIEWED WITH MUCH SCEPTICISM)

RESEARCHER 3: UNHAPPY TO HAVE A DIAGNOSIS BASED ON SUBJECTIVE CRITERIA, ALTHOUGH THEY WERE RELIEVED TO HAVE A DIAGNOSIS OF FM RATHER THAN A FATAL DISEASE. THE DIAGNOSIS WAS A RELIEF AND BURDEN.

COLLABORATIVE INTERPRETATION: PATIENTS WANT A BIOMEDICAL DIAGNOSIS AND ARE UNHAPPY TO HAVE A DIAGNOSIS BASED ON SUBJECTIVE CRITERIA. DIAGNOSIS OF FIBROMYALGIA A RELIEF (AS NOT A FATAL DISEASE) AS WELL AS A BURDEN (AS NOT ROOTED IN FULLY TREATABLE BIOLOGICAL SIGNS AND VIEWED WITH MUCH SCEPTICISM)
