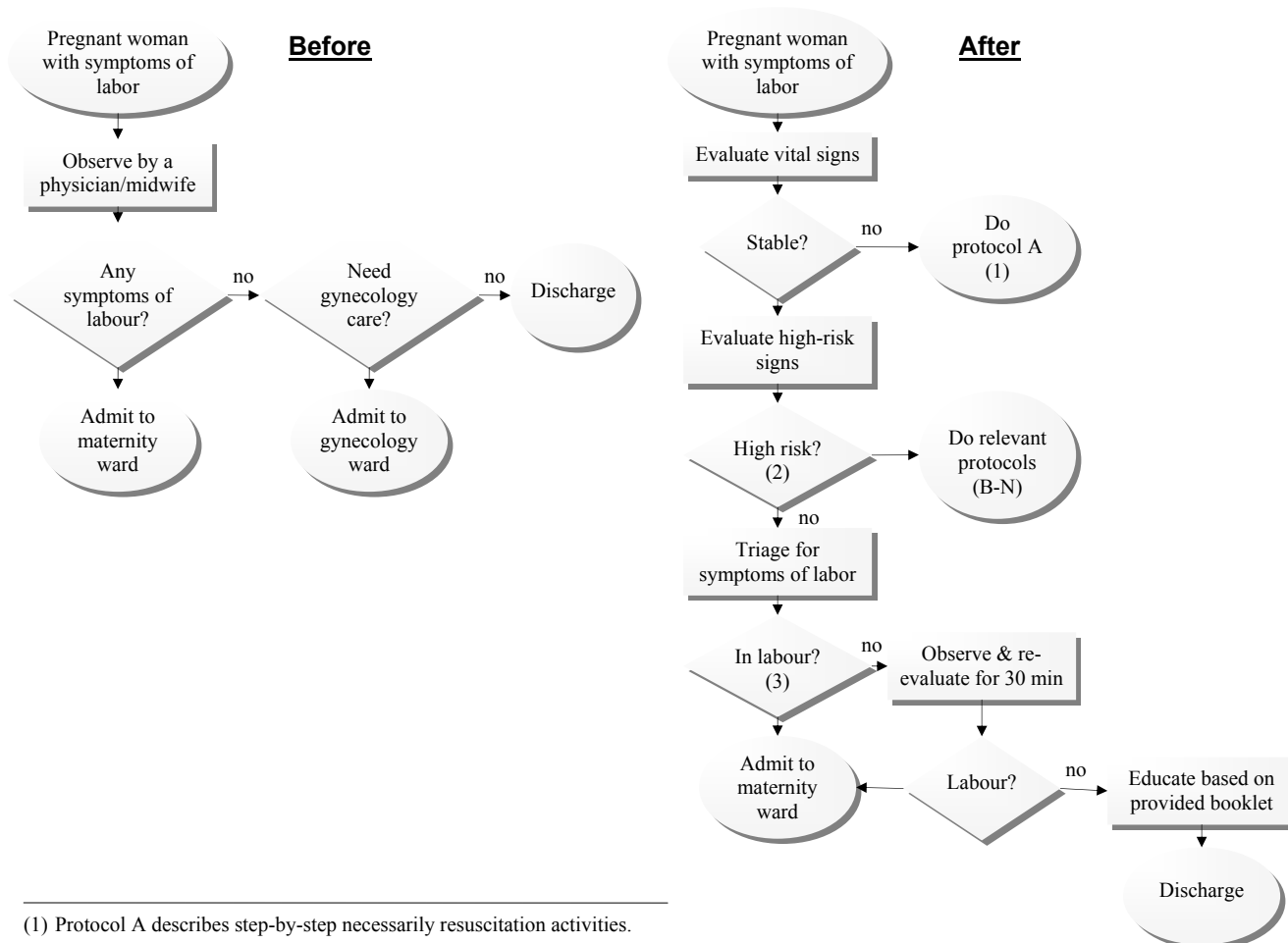




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- (1) Protocol A describes step-by-step necessarily resuscitation activities.
- (2) High-risk situations B-N and relevant protocols respectively explain the management of following conditions:
Vaginal bleeding, Breech presentation, multiple gestation, > 42 weeks, <30 weeks, FHR non-assurance, thick meconium, gestational diabetes, hypertension, oligohydramnios, fetal congenital diseases, IUGR (Intrauterine growth retardation), and underlying diseases
- (3) Spontaneous contractions at least 2 per 15 minutes and at least two of the following:
- Complete effacement of cervix
 - Cervical dilation 3 cm or greater
 - Spontaneous rupturing of membrane (SROM)

In the new model an evidence-based recommendation, admission in labor phase, as well as some of the maternal requirements, mother and baby well-being, frequent monitoring, and labor education, have been introduced into the process.
