CHIEF COMPLAINT

"Shortness of breath."

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS

This 41-year-old male presents with severe shortness of breath and increasing fatigue. On 01/13/2002, the patient came to the emergency room complaining of fever and generalized malaise. He was treated with fluids and Lortab and told to follow up if symptoms worsened.

The next night, he returned to the emergency room with a headache which was focused on his left side, and he had nasal drainage. He was treated for sinusitis and was sent home with Percocet and Biaxin 500 mg. He was rehydrated by IV and given 1 gram of Rocephin. The following day, he returned to the emergency room for a followup visit and felt much better.
