Key question	In patients with a history of an episode of stroke, does antihypertensive treatment reduce the risk of new episodes?
Recommendation	Depending on the patient's tolerance or concomitant pathologies, monotherapy treatment with diuretics, angiotensin converting enzyme inhibitors or angiotensin II antagonists should be considered.
