

Definition of teaching evolution

In this study, we used the following definition to clarify what we meant by “teaching evolution”:

Teaching evolution describes the practice of teaching about the theory of evolution, respectively, about the scientific and intrinsically consistent description of the origin and change of biological units and biodiversity of life. The teaching of evolution summarizes continuous, natural development processes in the earth’s history. The underlying evolutionary theory represents a product of time and reflects the current scientific understanding of evolution (Council of Europe, 2007; Darwin, 1859; Leopoldina, 2017; KMK, 2020).
