Legend: Participants indicated whether they are aware of fragrance-free regulations in four sectors:

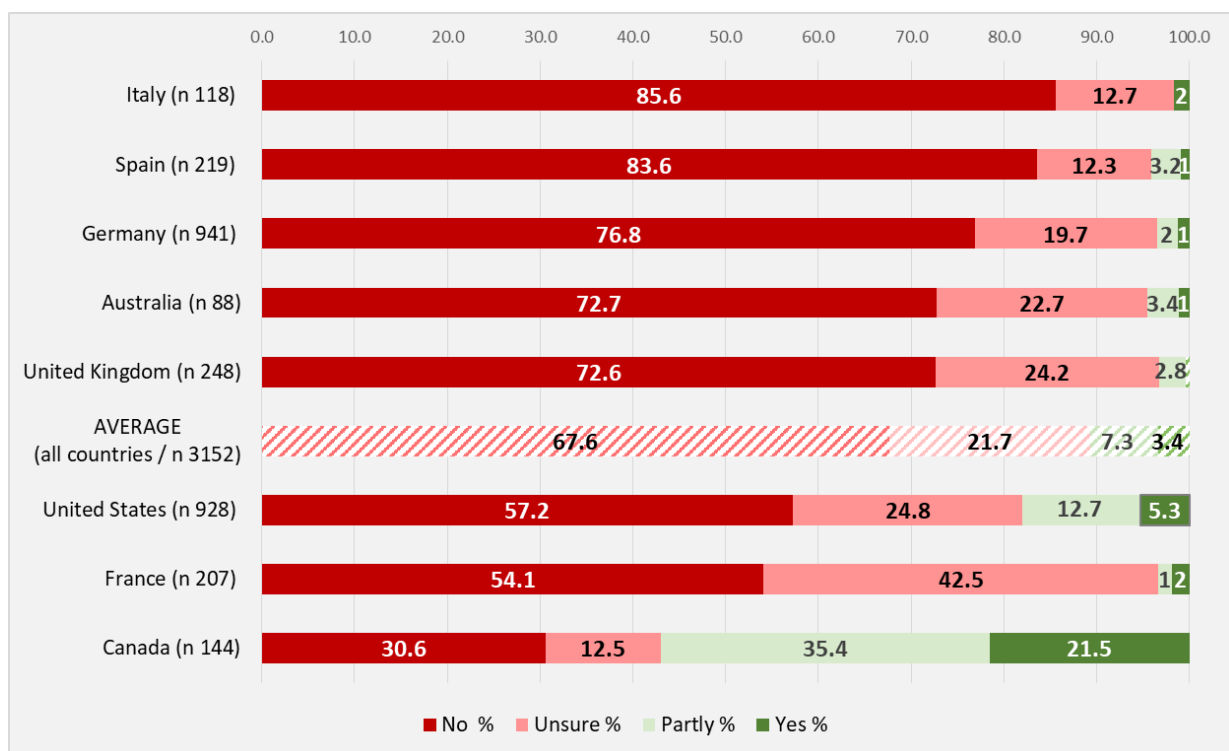
- a) public buildings

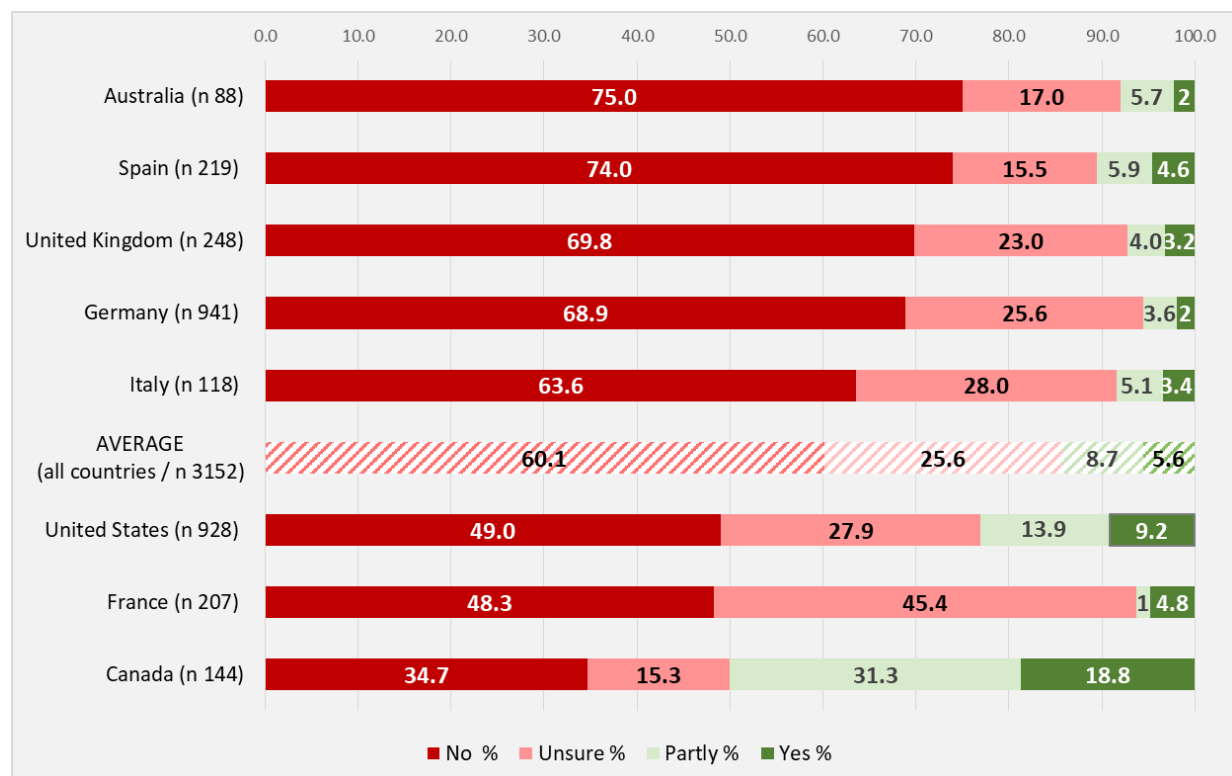
a) Experience of fragrance-free regulations at public buildings
