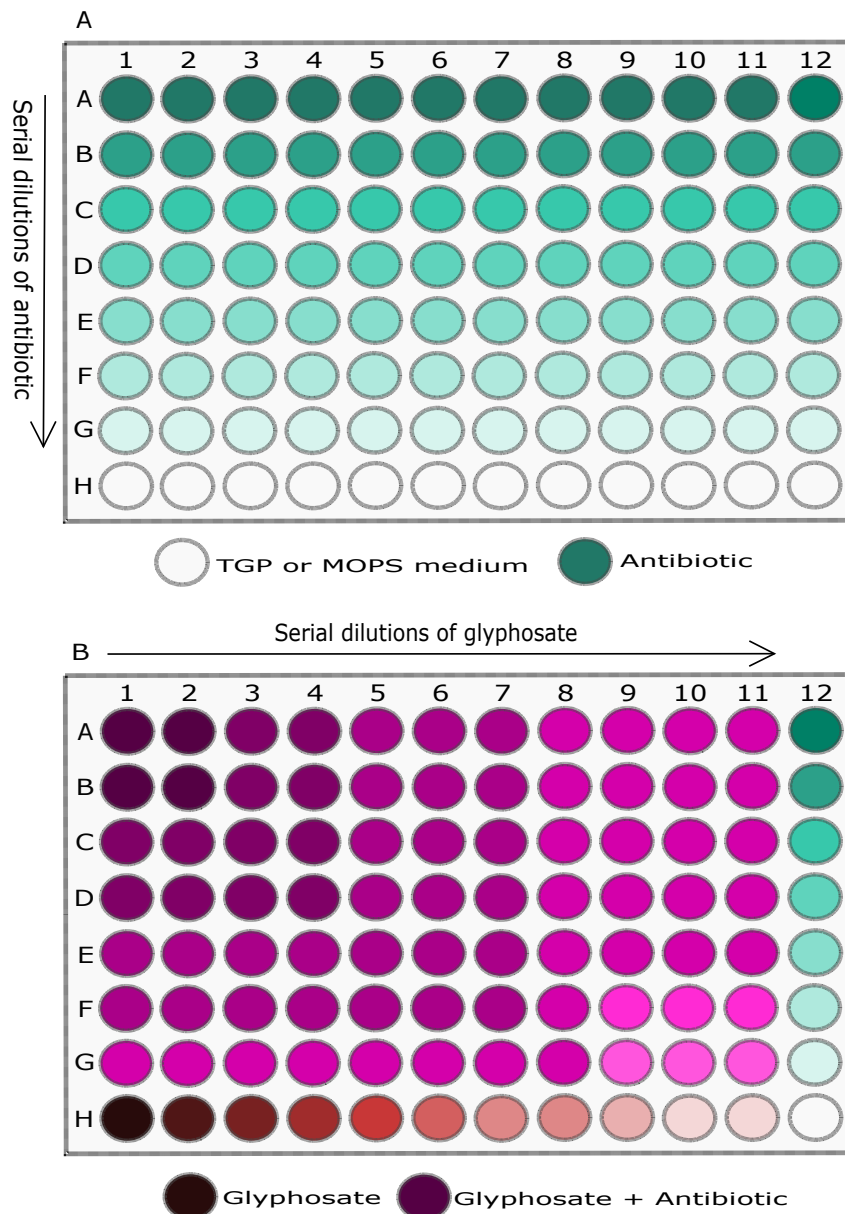


Fig S1: Chequerboard of antibiotic + glyphosate. The dilutions of glyphosate and antibiotics were performed on the same plate, but are shown here in separate plates for the sake of clarity. Figure A shows serial dilutions of an antibiotic from row A to G as indicated by the arrow. Row H is empty. Figure B shows serial dilutions of glyphosate from columns 1 to 11. Glyphosate dilutions are made on the 96-well plate in which antibiotics dilutions have been previously added. The result is a microplate containing combinations of different concentrations of glyphosate and antibiotics. Row H contains only glyphosate and column 12 contains only antibiotic.
