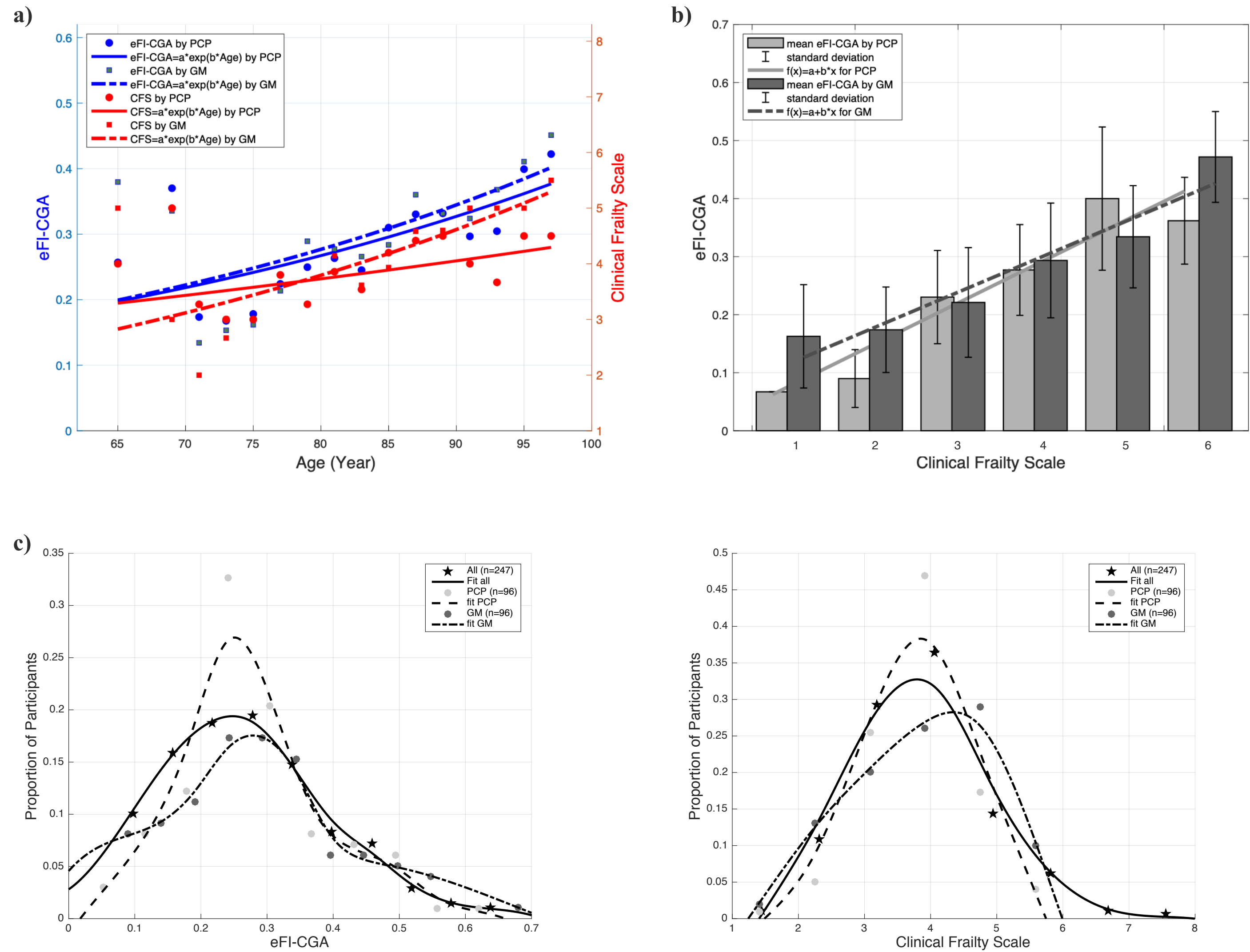




Supplementary Figure S2. Relationships between age, eFI-CGA and CFS assigned by geriatricians and primary care providers.

- a) eFI-CGA (blue) and CFS (red) as a function of age. Symbols show observation data; lines show exponential for PCP (solid) and geriatricians (dashed).
- b) eFI-CGA in relation to CFS. Bars show eFI-CGA scores assessed by geriatricians (dark gray) and PCPs (light gray) averaged by each CFS level with linear fitting; vertical bars show values of the standard deviation.
- c) Proportional distribution of the eFI-CGA scores for all participants (black) and those in the subgroup assessed by both geriatricians (dark gray) and PCPs (light gray).
- d) Proportional distribution of the CFS scores for all participants (black) and those in the subgroup assessed by both geriatricians (dark gray) and PCPs (light gray).
