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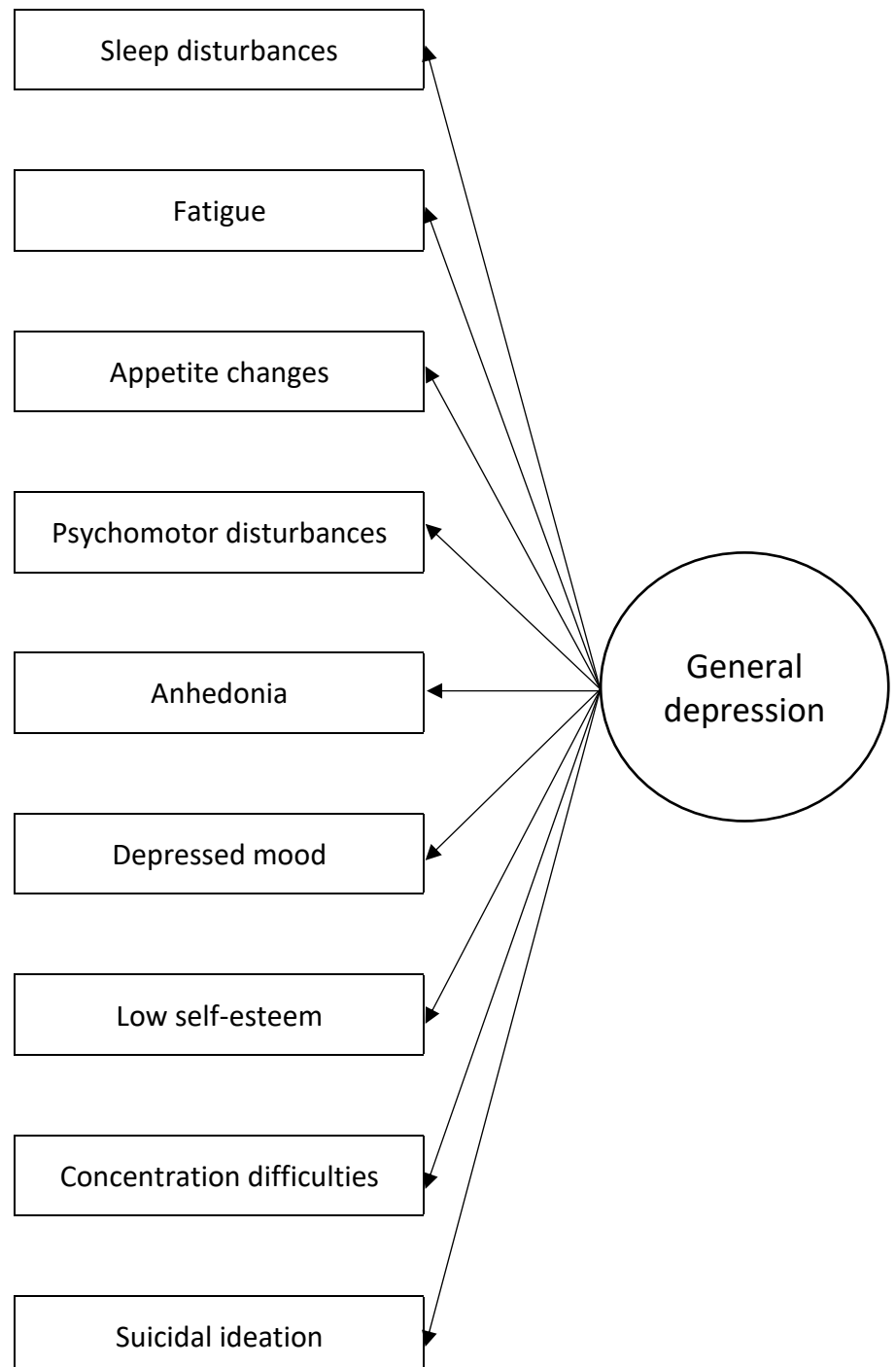
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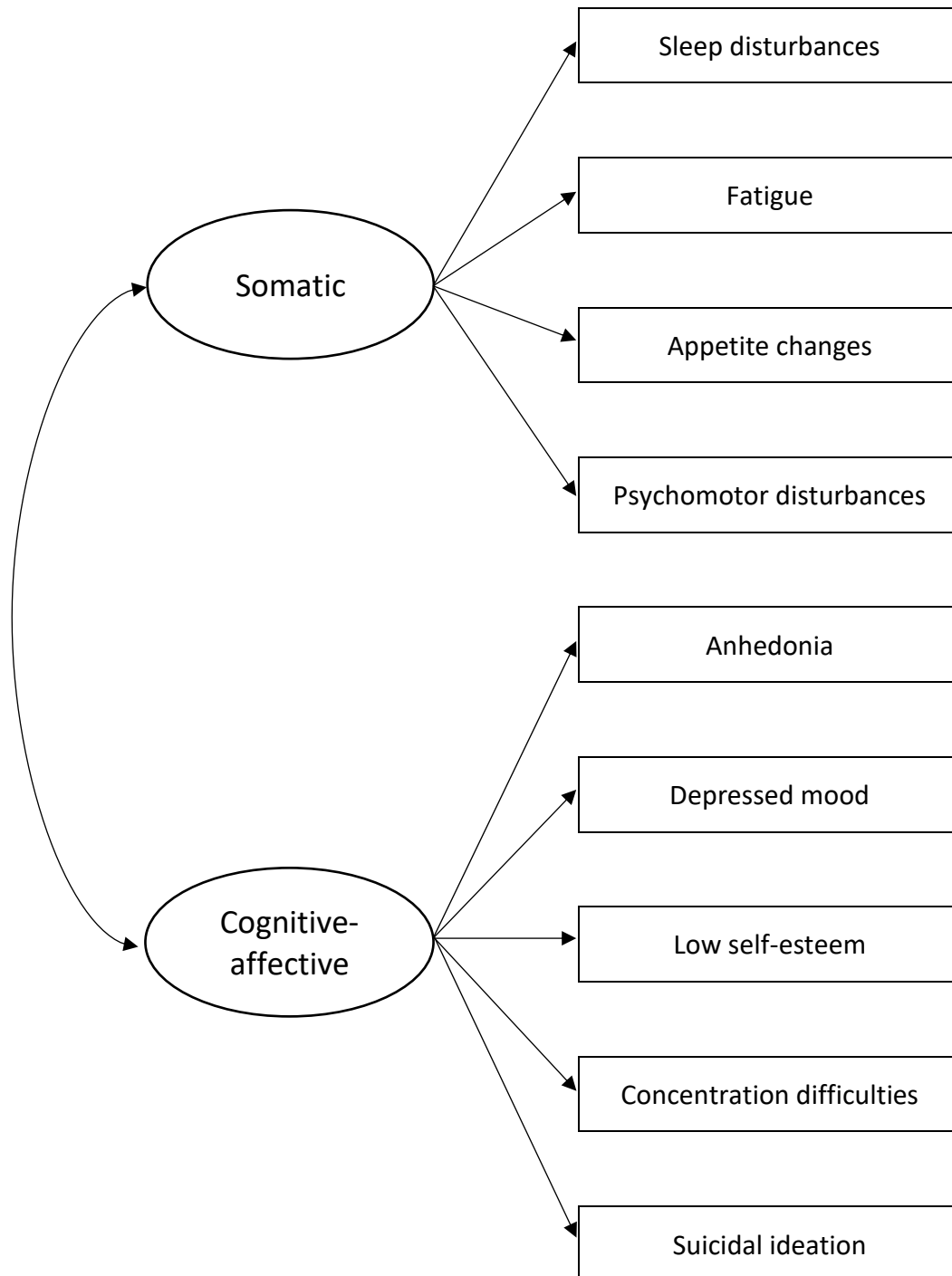
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Additional Figure 1. Overview of the Patient Health Questionnaire-9 (PHQ-9) models tested
