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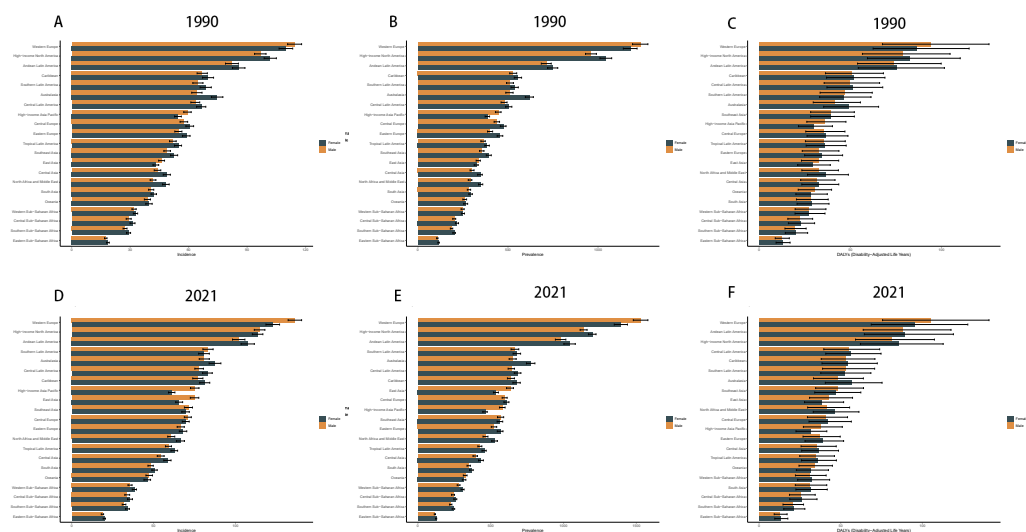


Fig. S1 Gender and Regional Differences in Global Incidence, Prevalence, and DALYs of Psoriasis in 1990 and 2021.

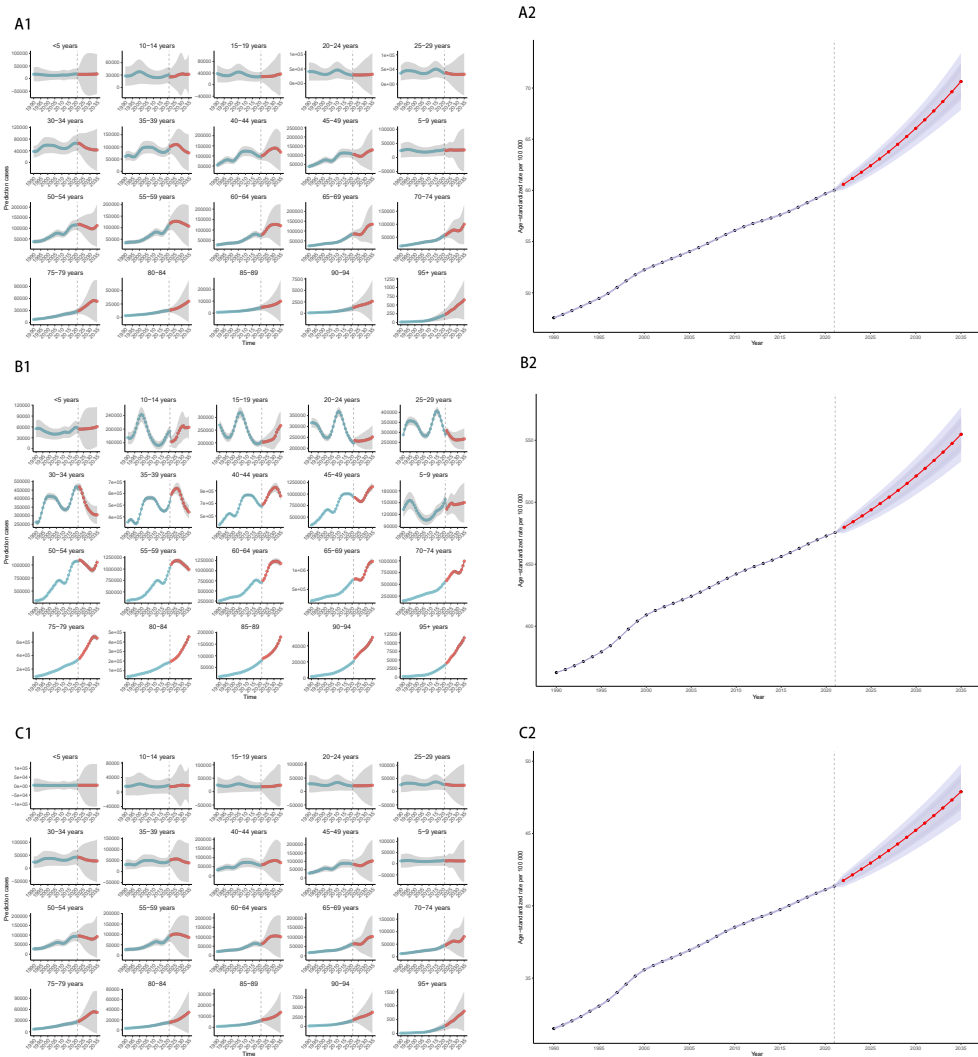


Fig. S2 Projected Trends in Psoriasis Incidence, Prevalence, and DALYs by Age Group in China
