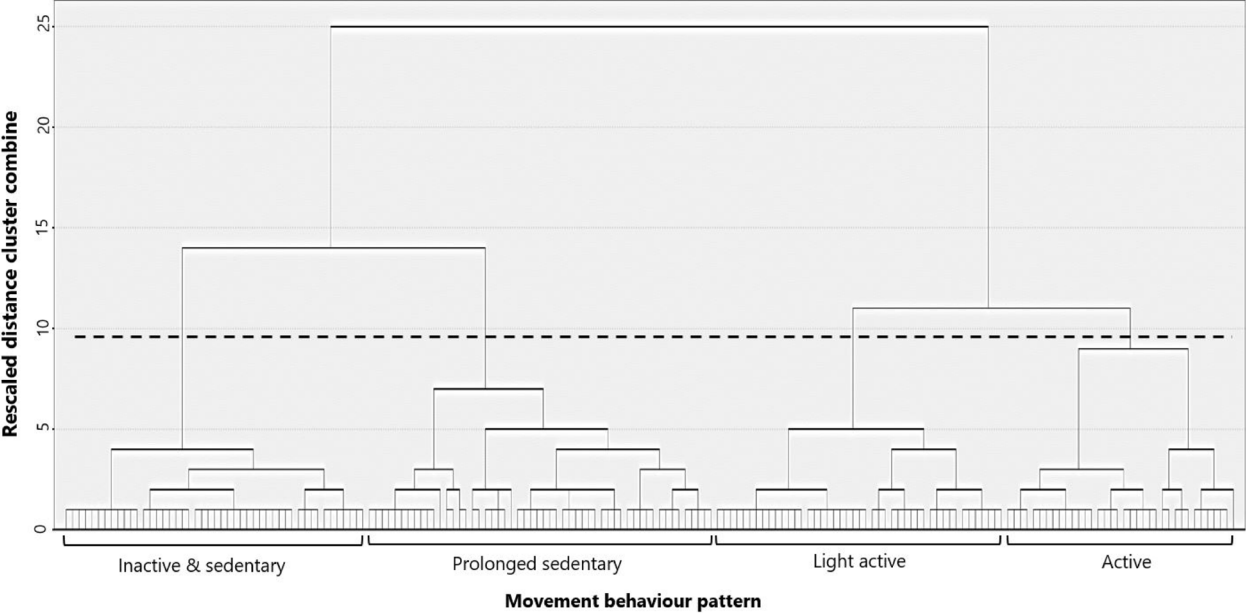




Note. Dendrogram illustrating the clustering of subjects, based on similarities in clustering variables. Cluster distance is expressed as Euclidean distance. The dashed line indicates the cutting level: the clustering procedure was stopped at the level where four subgroups were identified, later named “inactive & sedentary”, “prolonged sedentary”, “light active” and “active”.
