

68-yo male patient
Situs inversus is known from the age of 10

February 2018 obstructive jaundice,
pruritus and subcutaneous haematomas

CT

unsuccessful ERCP

MRCP

March 2018: EUS

ERCP

PTD and biliary stent placement

surgical consultation &
multidisciplinary oncological team

elevated liver enzymes, bilirubin and
alkaline phosphatase levels

normal size liver on the left side, dilated
intra- and extrahepatic bile ducts,
vascular abnormalities

dilatation of the extra- and intrahepatic
bile ducts, without exact diagnosis

no clear sign of malignancy

duplex stenosis of the CBD affecting
both the intrapancreatic and hilar
section
brush cytology: malignancy could not
be proven

bilirubin level decreased

assumed a Bismuth-Corlette stage II
Klatskin tumour (cholangiocarcinoma)
and suggested surgery

April, 2018: resection of the common bile duct, cholecystectomy
and hilar lymphadenectomy with hepaticojejunostomy
Histology: **did not prove malignancy, only dysplasia**
