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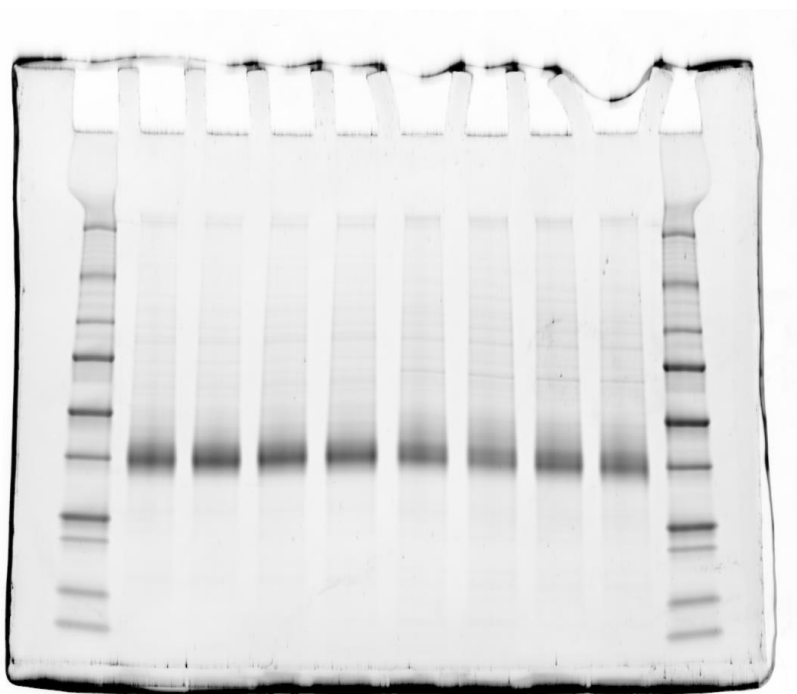


Figure S11: Uncropped and unlabeled protein gel image from main text Figure 4A

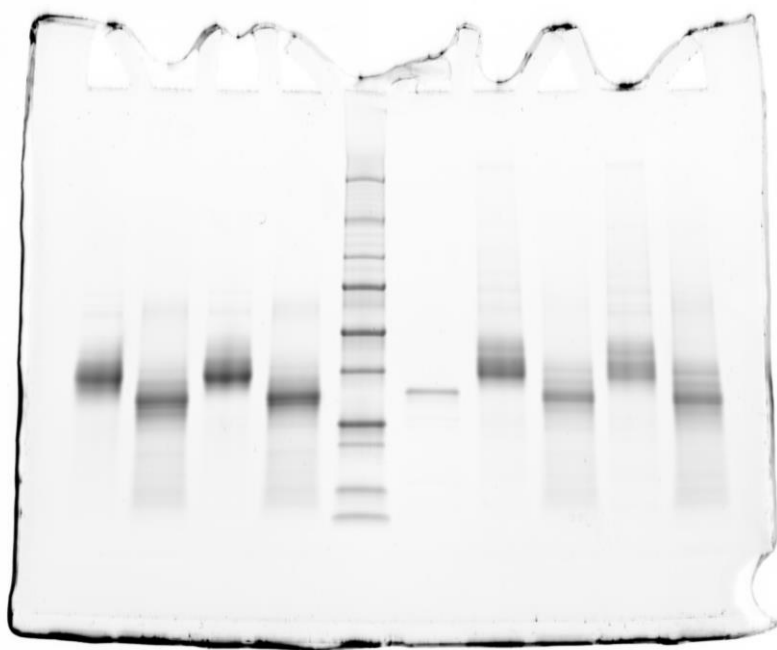


Figure S12: Uncropped and unlabeled protein gel image from main text Figure 4B

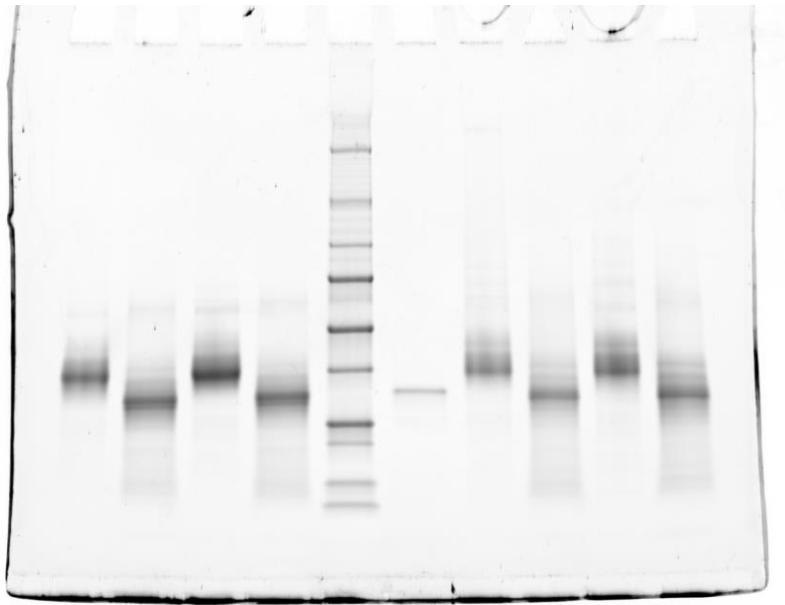


Figure S13: Uncropped and unlabeled protein gel image from main text Figure 4C
