Interview guide

Introductory information

My name is I work at the Institute of In this study, we accompany patients with breast cancer and other gynecological cancers from the time they receive the cancer diagnosis to post-treatment follow-up. We are investigating two topics:

1. The topic of "Trust"
2. The collaboration between different professional groups such as physicians, nurses

Additionally, we want to find out what role the advanced practice nurse (APN) plays in relation to these topics.

The topic of "trust," as well as the collaboration between professional groups, can become significant in different ways throughout the course of the illness. To illustrate this, we are conducting several interviews with patients and professionals at different points in time – for example, after receiving the diagnosis, during the chemotherapy phase, and before/after surgery. [Briefly mention the current situation of the patient (e.g., surgery, chemo, etc.)]. We would like to conduct this interview with you because we want to understand a little better how you are currently feeling during your treatment.

It is important to me that you know there are no right or wrong answers. I am only interested in your experiences. I will handle the information from our conversation with absolute confidentiality. The conversation will be transcribed and analyzed afterward. Would you agree to me recording the conversation with this audio recorder for my reference? We can pause or stop the conversation at any time. Please let me know if anything makes you uncomfortable. I will not use parts of the conversation if you explicitly request it.

If you agree with this approach and have no further questions, I would now like to begin the interview.

Narrative stimulus

Based on your entries on Threema and the completed questionnaire, we have been able to get an initial impression of your current situation. We would now like to gain a deeper insight into your experiences through this conversation. I have prepared some questions, but I would mainly like to give you the opportunity to speak. In this sense, I would like to start the interview by asking you where you stand today in relation to your illness and what is on your mind?

Addressing data collection through digital storytelling/questionnaire

You mentioned on Threema/in the questionnaire that Can you tell me more about how that is/was for you?

- How did you feel?
- What were your thoughts/needs?
- What was helpful for you?
- What might you have wished for?
- What happened before/after?
- Have you experienced such a situation before/again?

Possible follow-up questions on the topic of trust

- What role does trust play (in this situation)?
- What is needed for trust to develop?
- To what extent did you trust the specialist XY when XY was performed?

Possible follow-up questions on the topic of interprofessionalism

- How did you experience the collaboration between XY and XY?
- How did you experience the collaboration between the different professional groups?
- How would you describe your contact with the individual professional groups?
 - With which professional groups did you have/have had closer contact?
 - With which professional groups would you have liked to have closer contact?
 - How did you experience the transition from XY to XY (e.g., from chemotherapy to radiotherapy)?

Possible follow-up questions on the topic of the role of the advanced practice nurse

- How did you experience your contact with the advanced practice nurse?
- What was helpful, what was less helpful, and what was missing?

Closing

- Would you like to add anything else that we haven't discussed so far?
- Do you have any more questions or uncertainties?
