Domain 1: Instructional Content Quality (Weight: 40%)

Assessment Focus: Content Clarity, Organization, and Practical Relevance

Evaluation Standards:

Level 1: Content exhibits minimal logical structure, poor organization, and limited practical value

Level 2: Content demonstrates basic logical flow with moderate organization and practicality

Level 3: Content shows clear logical progression with satisfactory organization and practical application

Level 4: Content displays strong logical coherence with effective organization and practical utility

Level 5: Content exemplifies exceptional logical structure, systematic organization, and high practical value

Score Calculation: Domain Score = (Assessment Level ÷ 5) × 40

Domain 2: Pedagogical Engagement (Weight: 30%)

Assessment Focus: Interactive Learning Environment and Teaching Methodology

Evaluation Standards:

Level 1: Demonstrates minimal interaction and limited methodological diversity

Level 2: Shows basic interaction with conventional teaching approaches

Level 3: Exhibits moderate interaction with varied methodological implementation

Level 4: Displays effective interaction with diverse and engaging teaching methods

Level 5: Demonstrates exceptional interaction with innovative and highly engaging approaches

Score Calculation: Domain Score = (Assessment Level ÷ 5) × 30

Domain 3: Overall Educational Effectiveness (Weight: 30%)

Assessment Focus: Learning Outcomes and Objective Achievement

Evaluation Standards:

Level 1: Shows minimal achievement of learning objectives and intended outcomes

Level 2: Demonstrates partial achievement of learning objectives with basic outcomes

Level 3: Exhibits substantial achievement of learning objectives with satisfactory outcomes

Level 4: Displays comprehensive achievement of learning objectives with strong outcomes

Level 5: Demonstrates exceptional achievement of learning objectives with outstanding outcomes

Score Calculation: Domain Score = (Assessment Level ÷ 5) × 30

Final Satisfaction Score: Cumulative sum of all domain scores (Maximum: 100 points)

Methodological Note: This assessment framework employs a standardized 5-point evaluation scale for each domain. Domain scores are calculated using weight-adjusted formulas, with the final satisfaction score representing the sum of all weighted domain scores.
