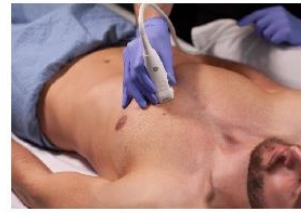


Sample question 8

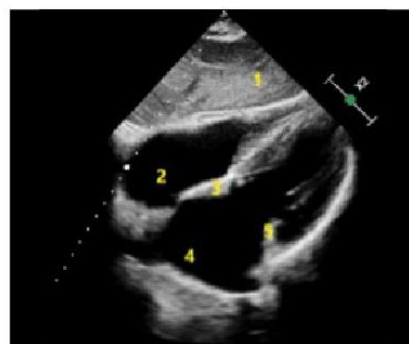
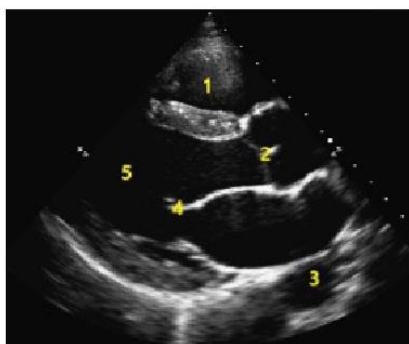

Supplement 5 Sample Questions of the Theory Test (The “Assignment Tasks” and “Normal Findings/ Identifying Structures in Orientational Section Planes” Areas of Competency)
