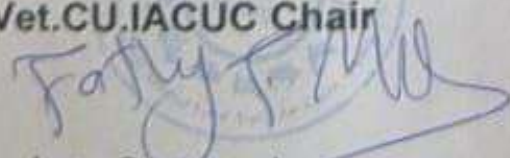

It is very important that these deadlines are not missed. Failure to submit an Annual Review on time will result in the termination of the protocol.

To continue this research beyond the three years approval period, a new protocol submission will be required. To avoid a lapse in IACUC approval, it is essential that the completed renewal protocol be submitted and approved by the IACUC prior to its expiration date.

Any activities conducted under the protocol after expiration will be in direct violation of IACUC policies. It is the responsibility of the Principal Investigator to notify the IACUC of any proposed changes regarding the work described within this protocol. The Principal Investigator agrees that no such changes will be implemented until approved by the IACUC, except where necessary to eliminate apparent immediate hazards to person(s) and/or animal(s).
