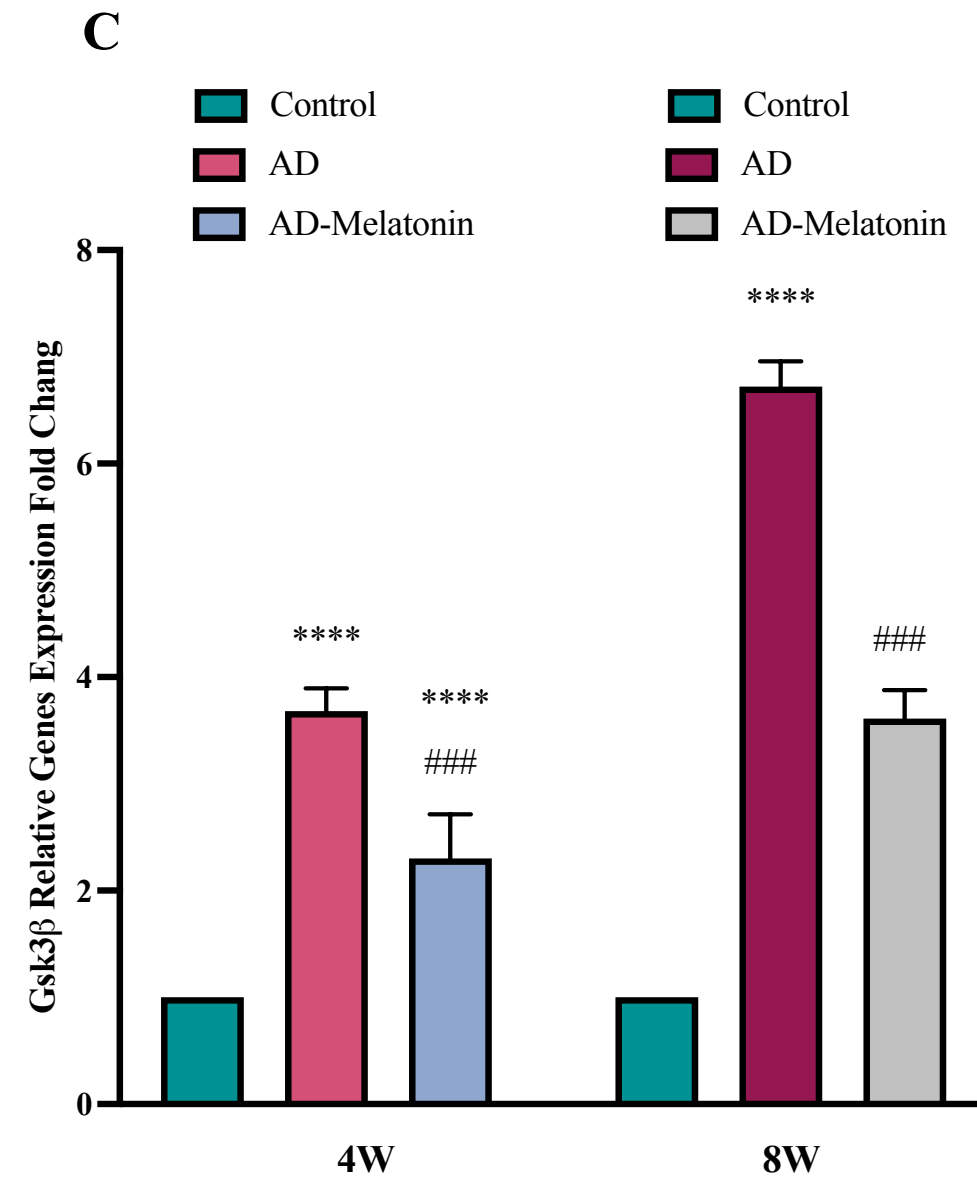
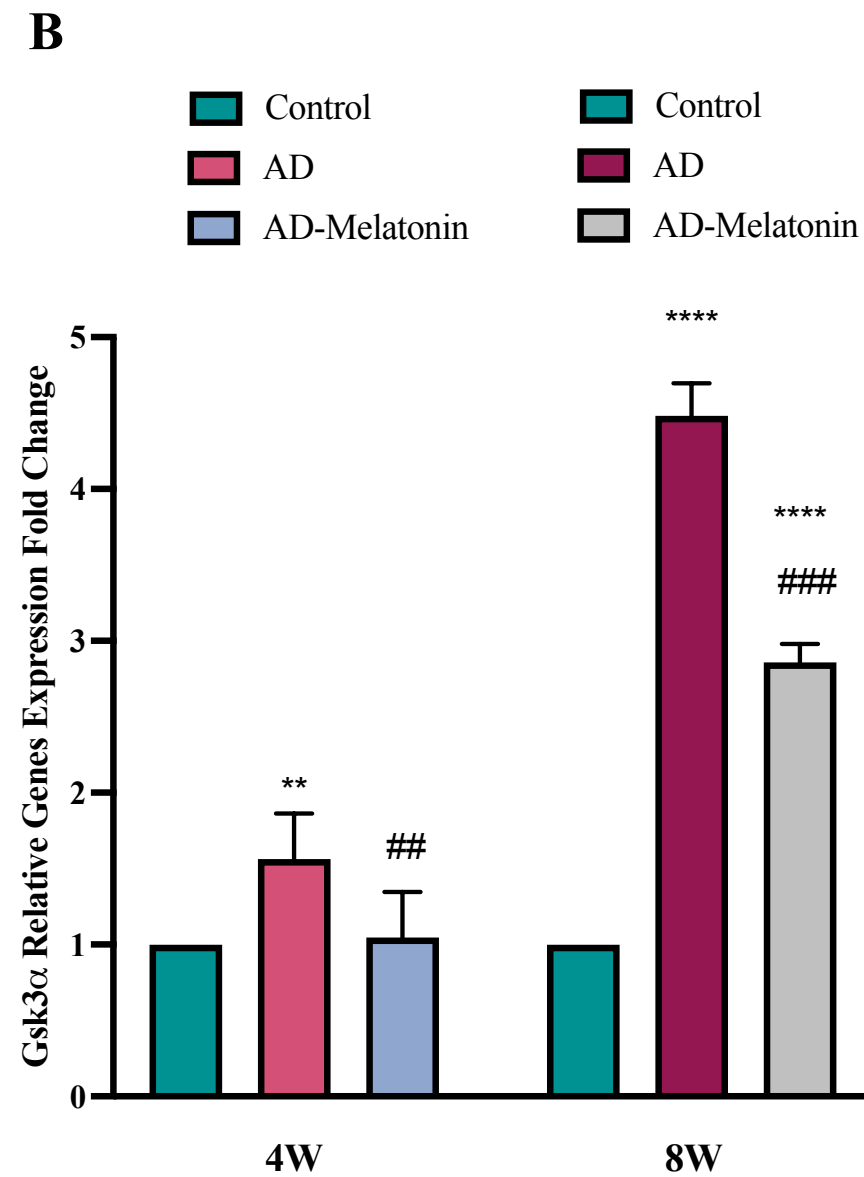
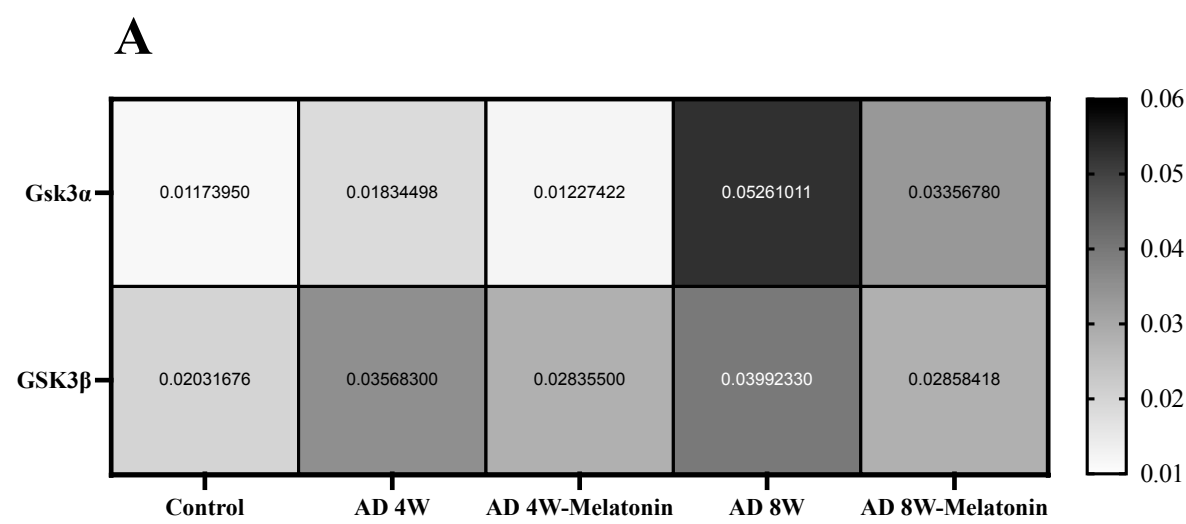

Asterisks (*) denote statistically significant differences compared to Control, and hashtags (#) denote significant differences compared to untreated model animals.
