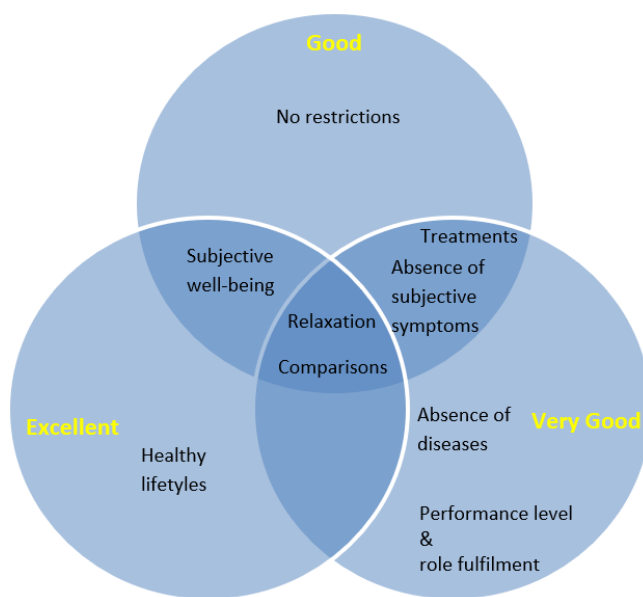


Figure 1A Definitions for excellent, very good and good health among the German study group

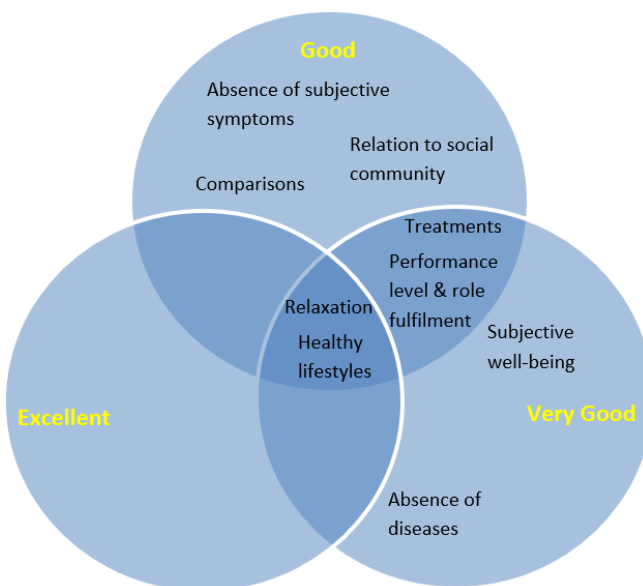


Figure 2A Definitions for excellent, very good and good health among the Turkish study group

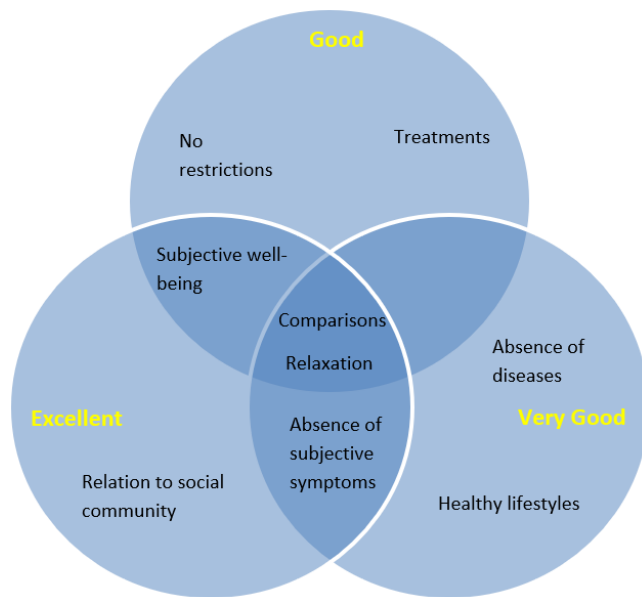


Figure 3A Definitions for excellent, very good and good health among the Bosnian study group

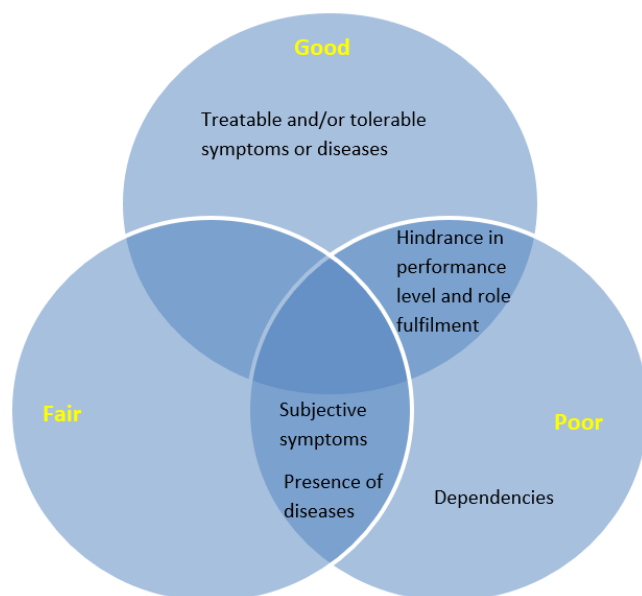


Figure 1B Definitions for good, fair and poor health status among the German study group

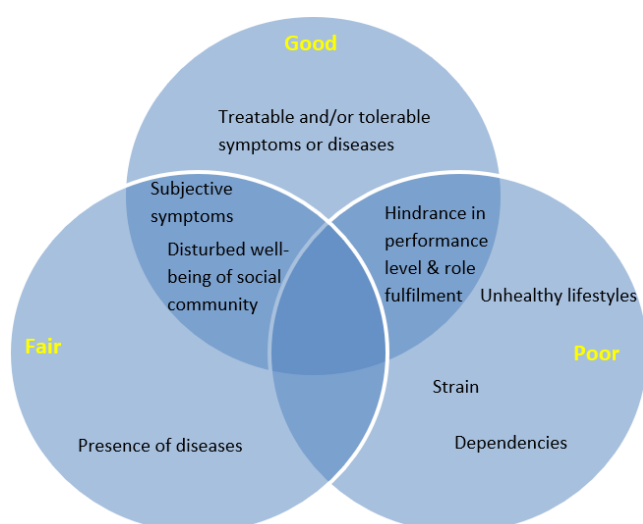


Figure 2B Definitions for good, fair and poor health status among the Turkish study group

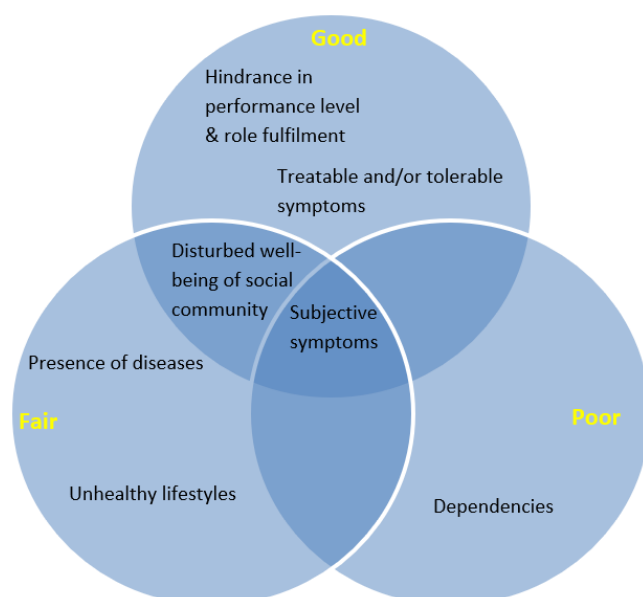


Figure 3B Definitions for good, fair and poor health status among the Bosnian study group
