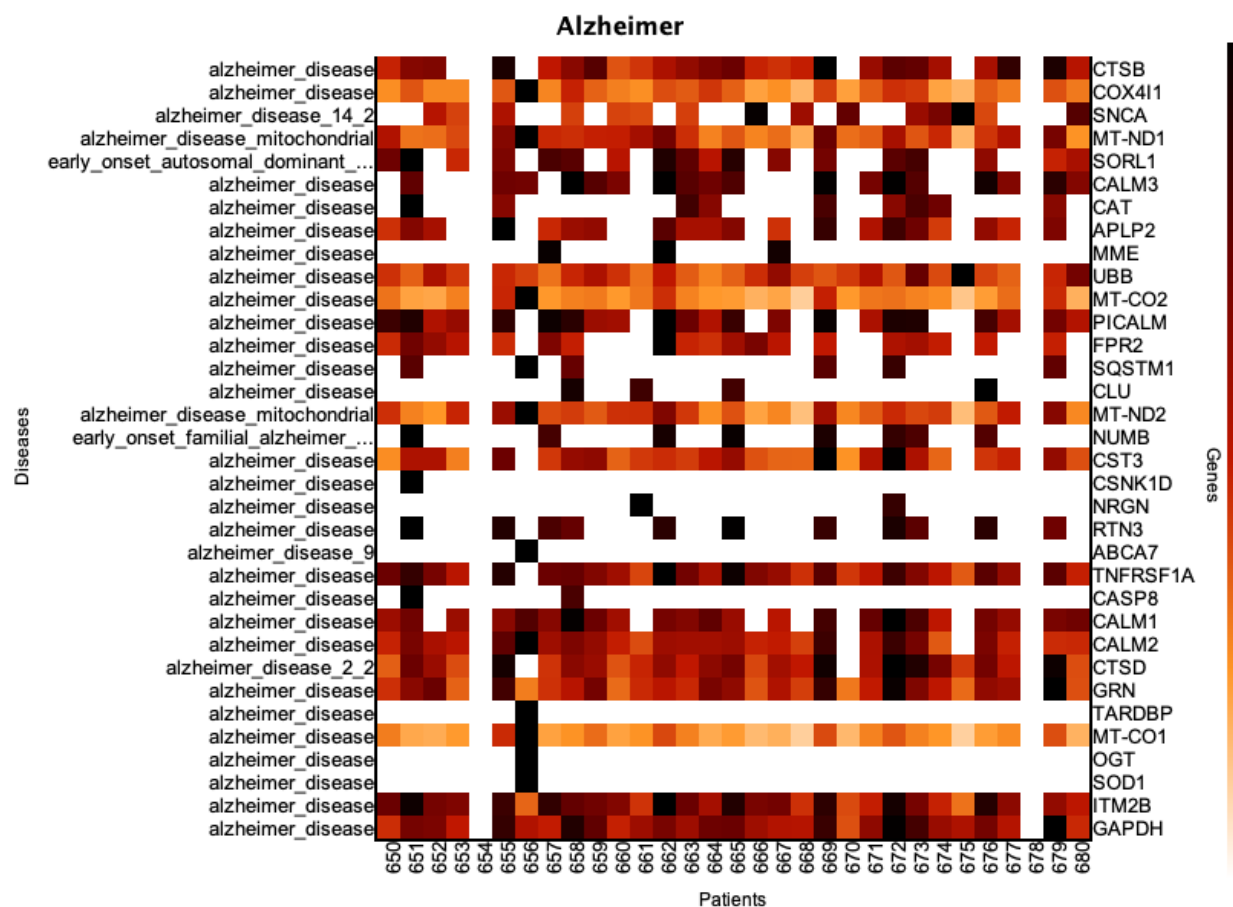

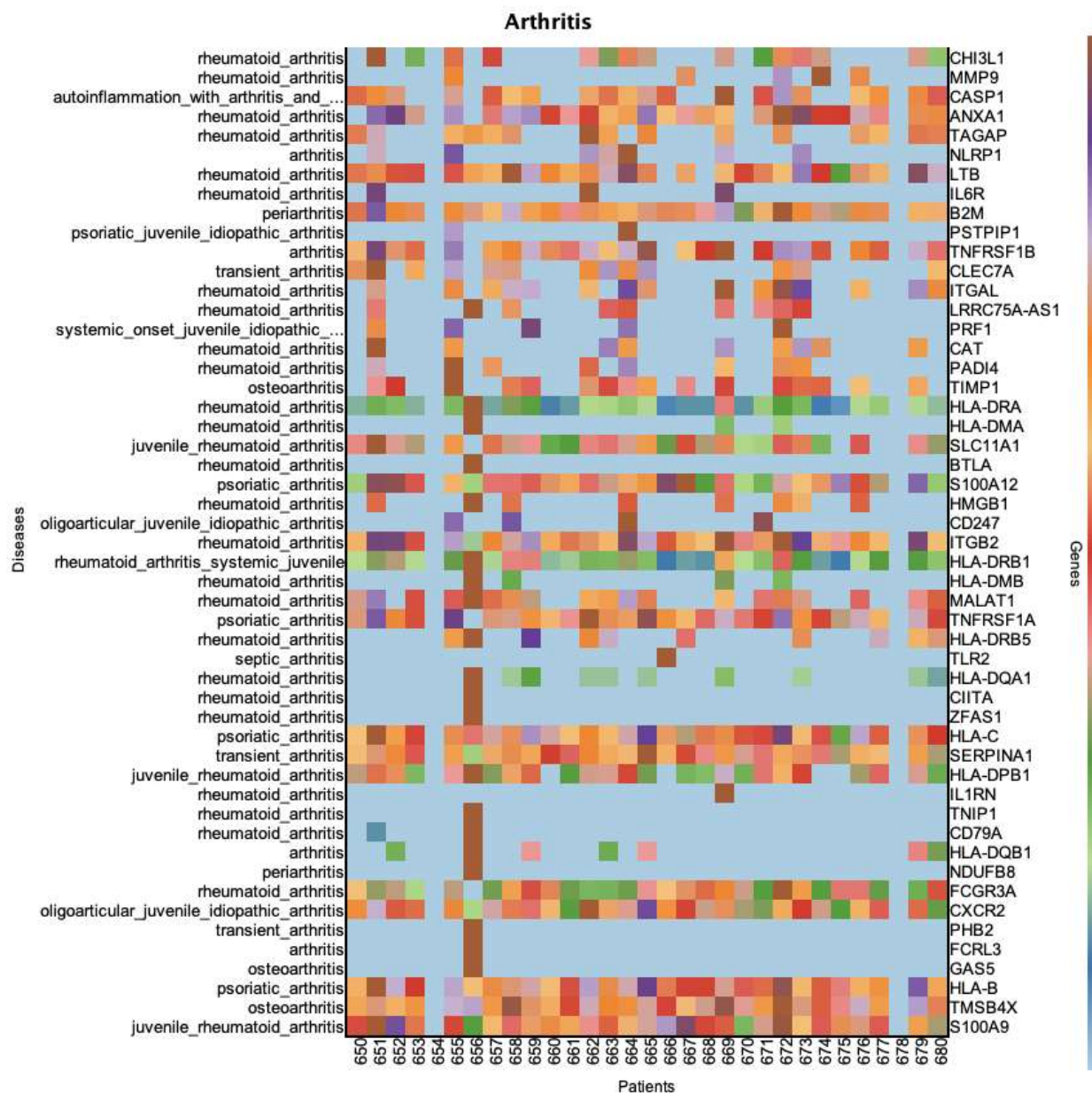
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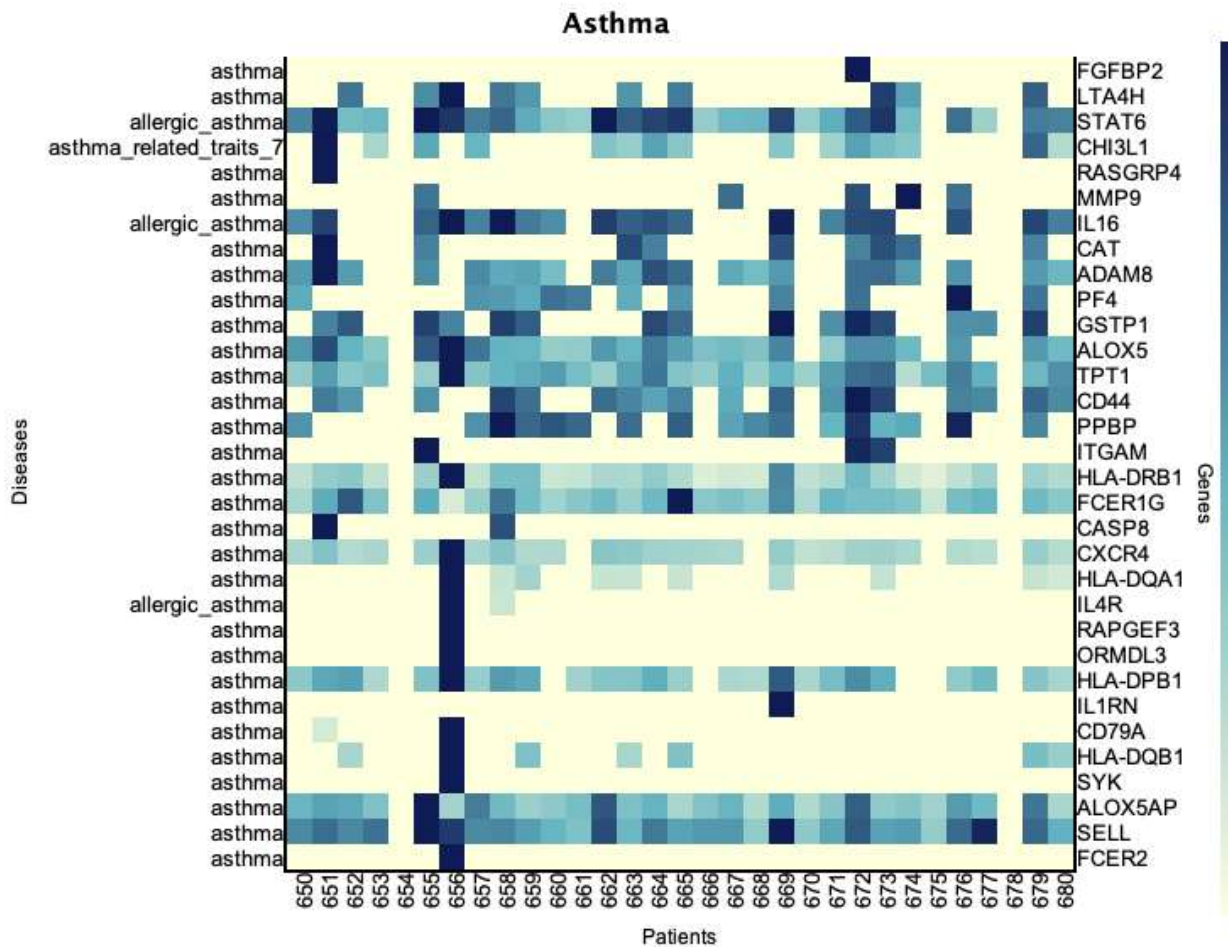

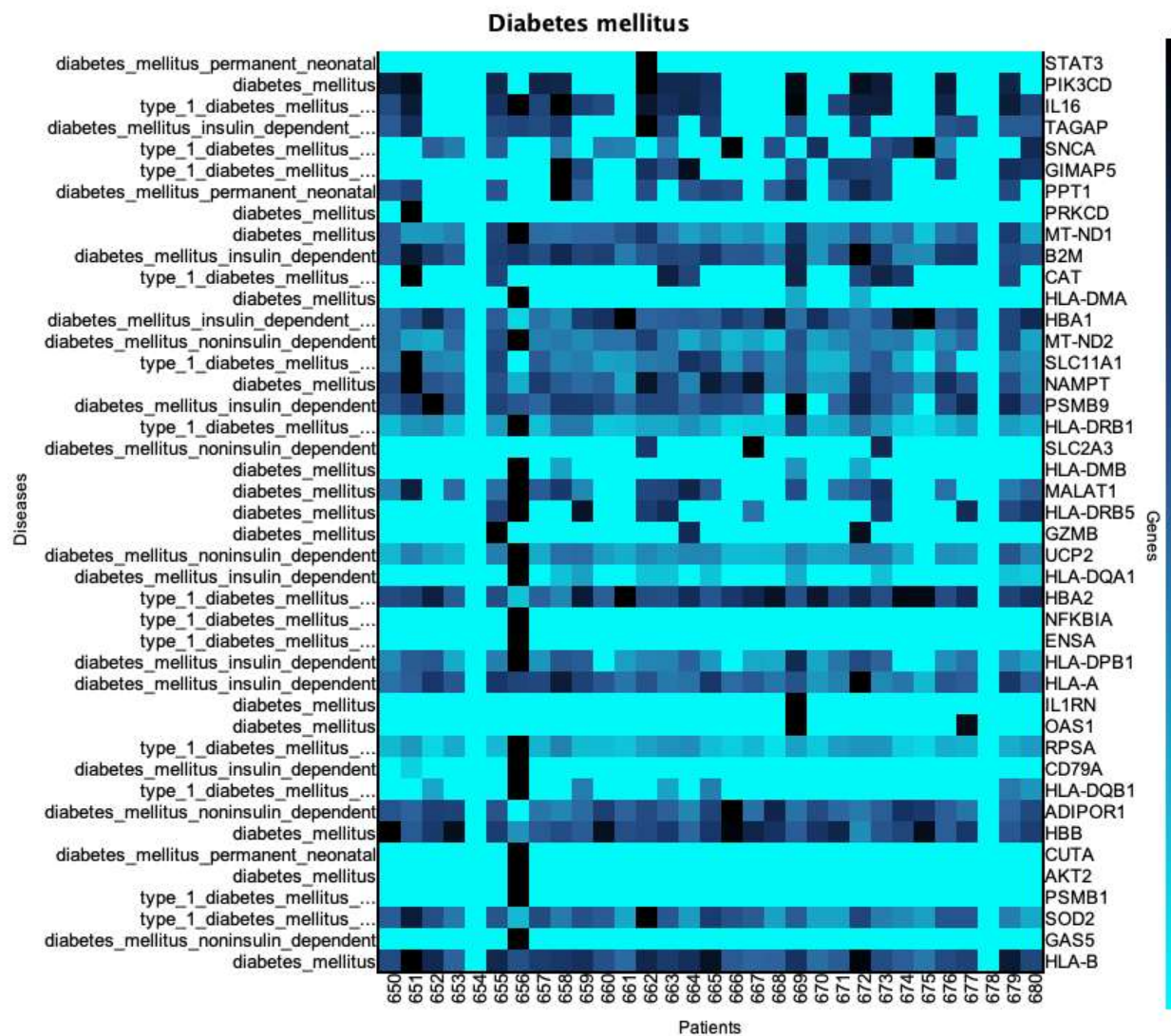
S. Figure 1. Alzheimer



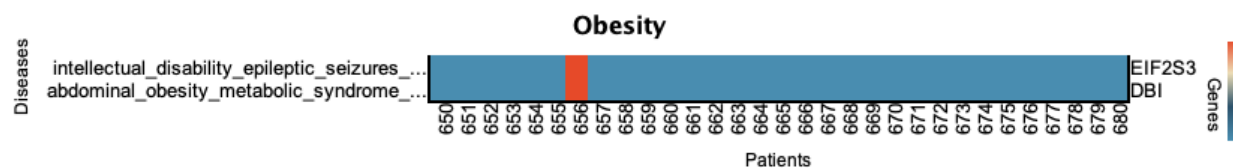
S. Figure 2. Arthritis



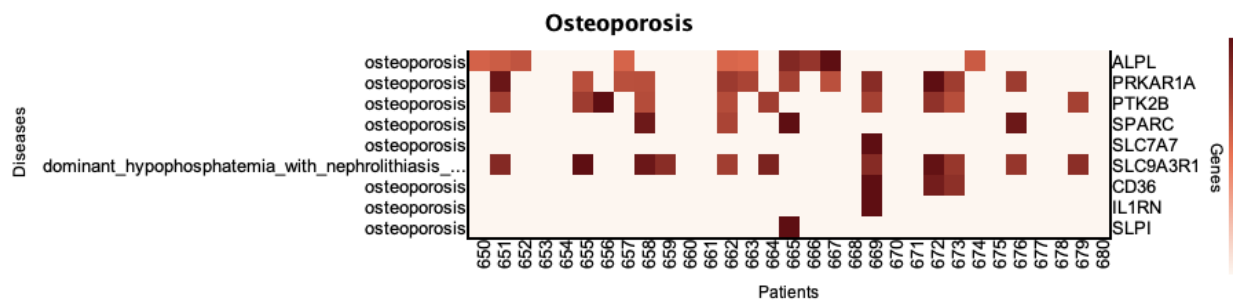

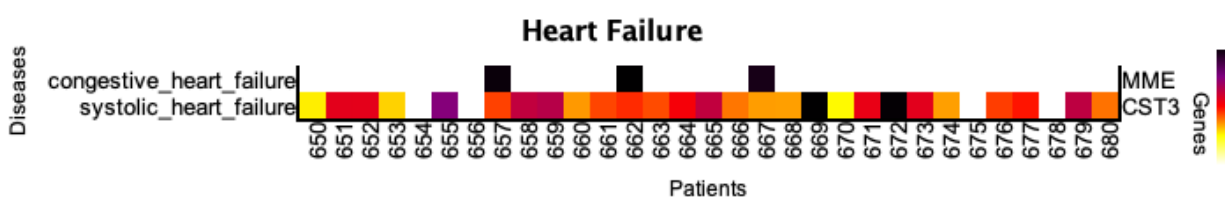
S. Figure 4. Diabetes mellitus



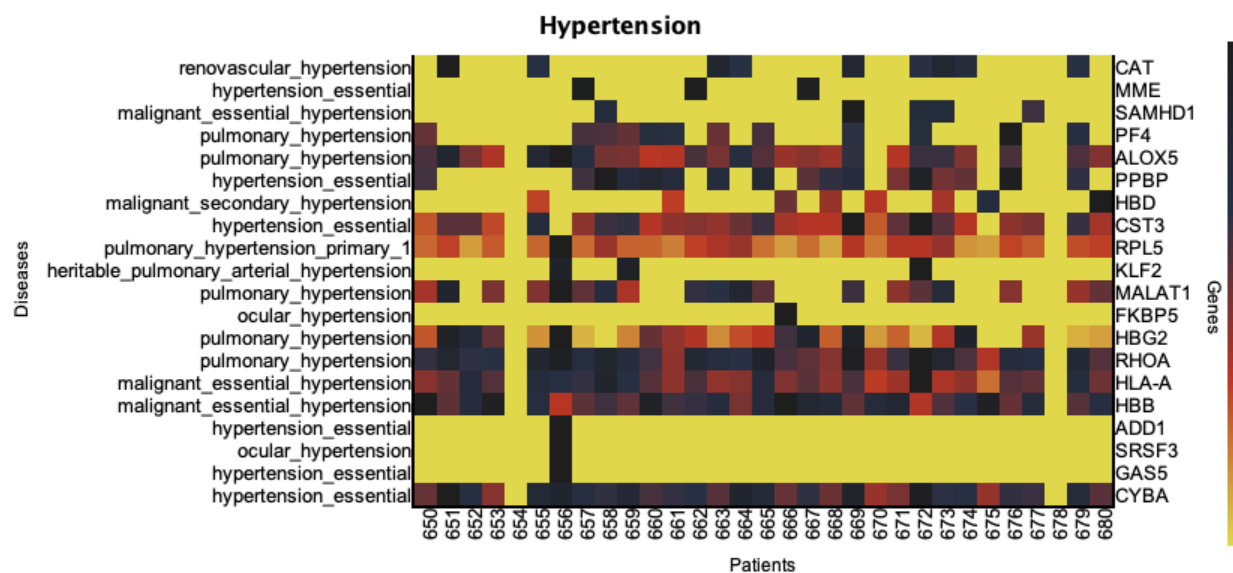

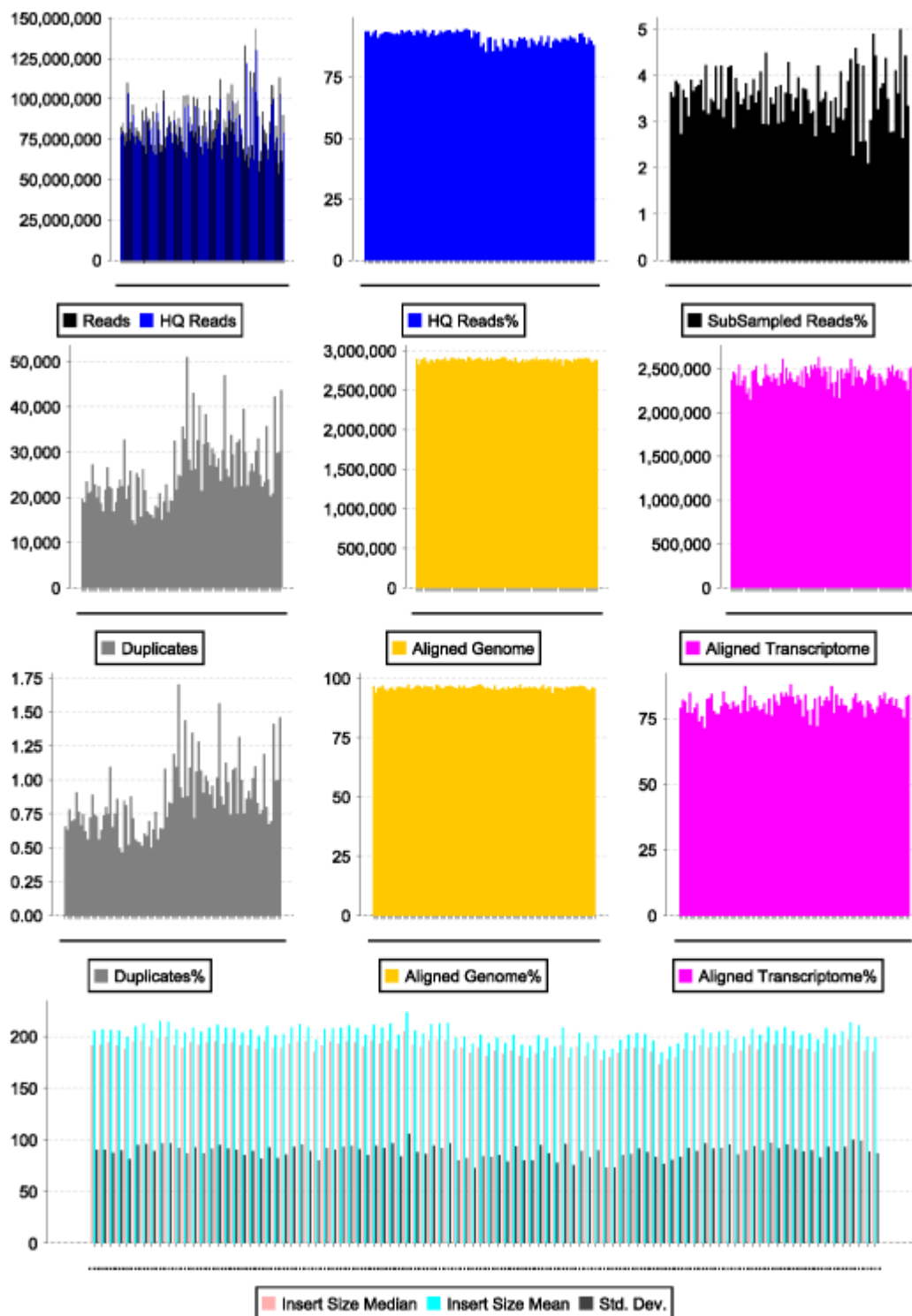
