

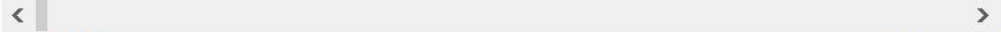

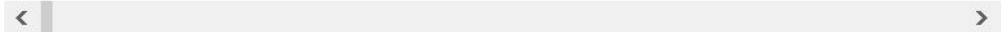

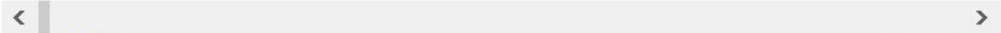

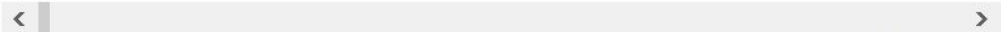

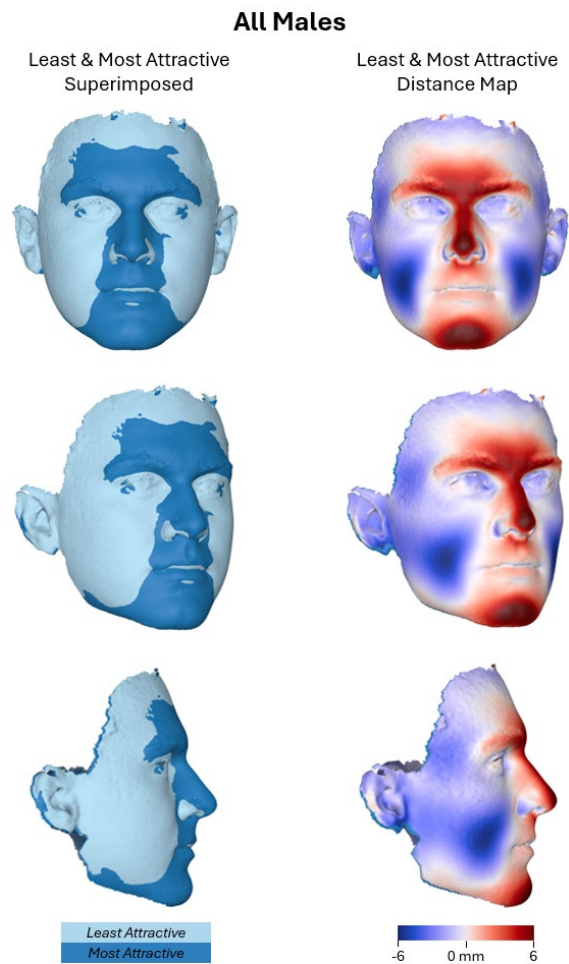

Supplementary Figure 1. Questionnaire used by the six evaluators for the assessment of facial attractiveness of the 601 participants.



Supplementary Figure 2. Best-fit superimpositions of warped facial images representing the least and most attractive male faces ($n = 208$). A color-coded distance map illustrates the surface differences between these two extremes, with colour intensity reflecting both the magnitude and direction of displacement. This figure uses an increased displacement scale to enhance the visualization of surface changes; a version with a reduced scale is shown in the main text for consistency with the female data.
