

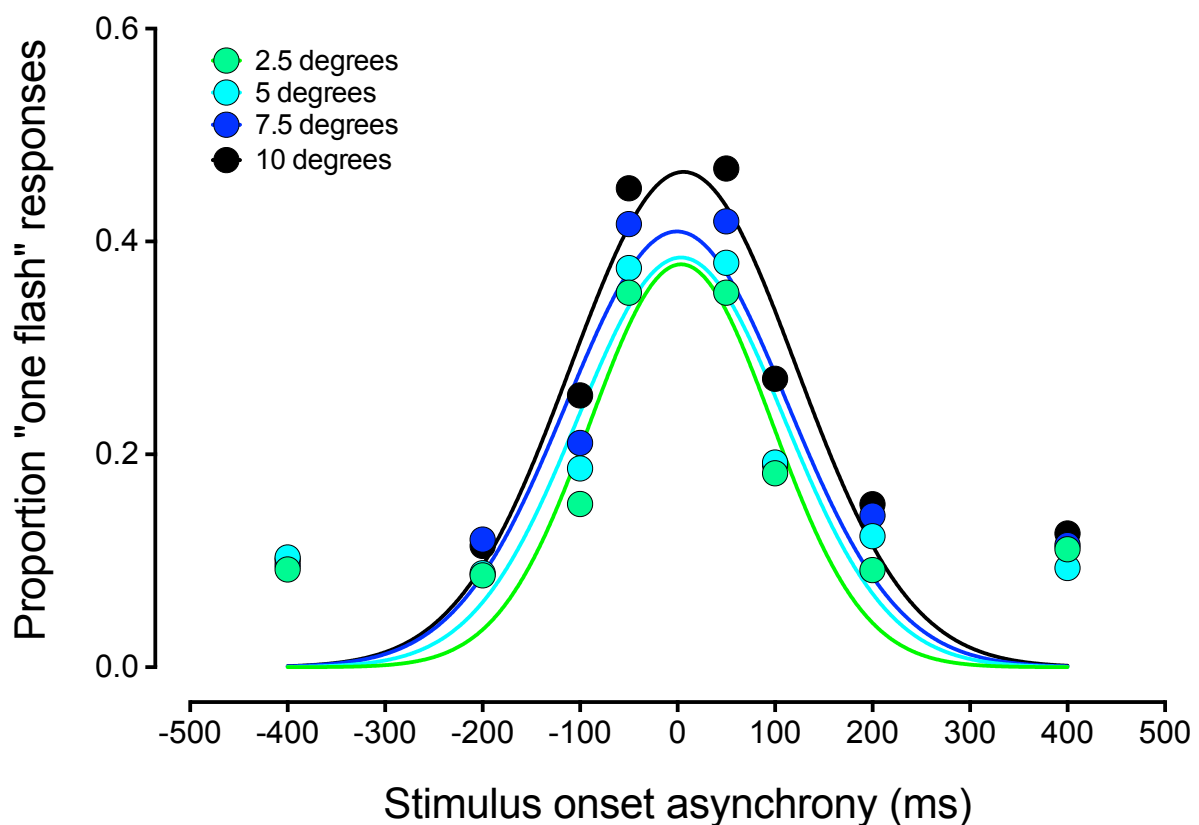
Supplementary information: The Magnitude of the Sound-Induced Flash Illusion Does Not Increase Monotonically as a Function of Visual Stimulus Eccentricity

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Supplementary Figure 1: Data for two flash, visual-only trials. Participants erroneously reported one flash for a high proportion of trials with short SOAs, with the number of errors increasing as a function of the eccentricity of the visual stimuli.
